Required check in at your starting course from 7:30-8:30. If you do not sign in by 8:30 your spot may be given to someone on the waitlist. **Amateurs will pick up their player pack before their round at Triad Park (Patriot DGC).**

Please note Saturday is 18-holes at both courses. A & B are only in play on Sunday.

Shotgun start at 9:00.

75 minutes for lunch once the final card in your pool is turned in.

Shotgun start round 2 after lunch break is completed.

Sunday - Round 3:

Tee times at Triad Park. Tee Times will be posted on Saturday evening.

FA1, FA40, MA50, MA60, MA3, FA3: **Patriot Red Tees 20 holes*** (Tees marked by red flags)

MA40, MA2, MA1, FPO: **Patriot All-Star 20 holes** (Tees marked by yellow flags)

MPO, MP40: **Patriot Blue Tees 20 holes*** (Tees marked by blue flags)

*All divisions play from blue 9's teepad to temp basket, blue 10's teepad to temp basket, and red 11's teepad to normal basket.

Playoff Loop: Sudden death 1-5, 18 from the pads played during your Sunday round.

Please note that you may not warm up on the disc golf course once the first group has teed off. Additionally, the park is open to the public, so please be conscientious of this when warming up.

The Crossing is NOT available Sunday morning as a warmup course for your round at Triad. The course opens at 1pm on Sundays. There is a practice basket at Triad Park.

PDGA Live Scoring

Players must keep score using either PDGA Live (App or Site) or a paper scorecard provided by tournament staff. All players must keep score for the entire group.

Course OB*: Gravel paths and beyond, roads and/or paved walking paths and beyond, shelters. All water is casual. Paint and/or string may be used to define OB areas.

*OB on any hole unless otherwise noted.

Temp Holes

We will utilize two temp holes at Patriot on **Sunday** in place of the original 9 and 10, plus **Hole A and a modified Hole B.**

9 -682' plays from 9's blue pad to the basket in the field across from the normal basket location. Painted lines on green/fairway mark OB lines. Play from last in bounds.

10 – 636' plays from 10's blue pad as a dogleg left and follows the tree line to the basket. Keep following the tree line instead of walking down toward 10's original basket.

Hole A – 437' Turn left after 16's basket, plays down to tree line.

Hole B - 314' plays to a new location and is a par 3 this year. The basket is on the right side after the main gap.

The Crossing

Course OB* – Inside any fenced area, fences and beyond, roads and beyond defined by black asphalt, on top of or inside any building. All water is casual. **2-meter relief from barbed wire.** Paint and/or string may be used to define OB areas.

*Unless otherwise noted on the hole's listed OB

A **relief area** is an area designated by the Director from which a disc may not be played. A relief area is considered and played as an out-of-bounds area, but no penalty throw is applied.

A **casual area** is casual water, or any area specifically designated as a casual area by the Director before the round. Casual water is any body of water that is in-bounds and has not been explicitly declared by the Director to be in play. To obtain relief from a casual area, the player's lie may be relocated without penalty to the nearest lie which is farther from the target and is on the line of play, at the nearest point that provides relief (unless greater casual relief is announced by the Director).

1	Fenced in playground area is OB.	2	Wall and beyond on left is OB. (String line/construction fence is NOT OB.)
3	Course OB*	4	Creek is a casual area.

			If inside yellow stakes/paint on the hill/brush pile, play as a relief area. A relief area is played just like an OB area with no penalty.
5	Wall and beyond is OB (construction fence is NOT OB). Water is a Casual area.	6	Creek and beyond defined by white stakes/string is OB. Drop Zone is NOT for OB. If inside yellow stakes/paint on the hill/brush pile, play as a relief area. A relief area is played just like an OB area with no penalty, or you may proceed to the Drop Zone with no penalty.
7	Fence/string and beyond is OB	8	Fence(post with survey tape)/string and beyond is OB
9	Fence/string and beyond is OB	10	OB road and beyond on right defined by black asphalt (the string line near the basket defines the OB line between the concrete and asphalt.) The concrete after the string line is OB. Fence/string and beyond on left, stakes and beyond basket defined by string, inside garbage dumpster fence are all OB. If OB from your drive, you can play from where the disc was last inbounds, replay from the previous lie, or proceed to the 1st drop zone (white pad), all with a one-stroke penalty. If OB from your 2 nd + throw, you have the same three options but you may play from the Drop Zone closer to the green.
11	Road and beyond on right and beyond basket as defined by black asphalt is OB. Fence and beyond on left is OB. <i>Please walk on the road and around the caution tape to access the green.</i> If inside the white stringed area (new grass), play as a relief area. A relief area is played just like an OB area with no penalty, or you may proceed to the Drop Zone (white pad) with no penalty.	12	Fence and beyond on left and creek and beyond on left defined by string is OB. Inbounds side of creek is a Casual area.

13	Road and beyond on right defined by black asphalt is OB.. Mando left of marked tree. If Mando is missed, you may play from your previous lie or proceed to the drop zone (white pad) with a stroke penalty.	14	Road is OB and plays as a river defined by black asphalt. Hazard is in play and defined by string. If you land outside of the island defined by string, you play where it lies with a one-stroke penalty.
15	String and beyond is OB beyond basket.	16	String/fence and beyond is OB. Mud area marked by yellow paint near the basket is a relief area. All other water is a casual area. A relief area is played just like an OB area with no penalty.
17	Road and beyond as defined by black asphalt is OB.	18	Road is OB and defined by black asphalt. Road plays like a river, either side of the road is in bounds.

Both pools will compete for CTPs at The Crossing. Women's only CTPs are marked by a pink flag and labeled as such. All others are for all divisions (including women). If you finish on a hole with a CTP, please bring it to Tournament Central.

When you enter the park, turn right at the stop sign and follow the road past the memorial and tournament central will be located in the shelter at the top of the large parking lot.

Please park near Tournament Central to check-in. Once hole assignments are posted, feel free to drive to a parking lot closer to your starting hole. If you start on holes 8-15, consider parking in the lot across from 14/15's fairways. For holes 8-11, follow the gravel path until you arrive at 8's teepad.

Sunday - Please check in at the shelter near hole 1 at least 15 minutes before your tee time.
