- Why do you think the Bible emphasizes repentance and turning away from sin? How does this align with the concept of grace?

3. How can we ensure that we are not just seeking "a little Jesus" but fully committing to His lordship in our lives?

4. What are some practical steps you can take to stay on the narrow path that leads to life?

Closing Prayer (10 minutes)

Prayer Points:

- Pray for the strength and courage to choose the narrow path, even when it is difficult.
- Ask for forgiveness and the grace to repent from any sins that may be hindering your walk with Christ.
- Pray for a deeper understanding of what it means to live under the lordship of Jesus.
