

Final 30 point paper

Your final paper (due on the day of your final exam) is worth 30 point and should be 4-5 pages in length (**not including title page and references**). For this paper, you are to choose a topic from one of the chapters—something that is relevant to you, because it is likely to come up in your practice, and “dig deeper”. Learn more about this topic—and write a paper sharing what you have learned. Be sure to address developmental issues that are relevant to your chosen topic.

You should use at least three references, which should be cited in the body of your paper, as well as listed, in APA format, on a reference page at the end of your paper.

--Your Psychology of Growth and Development text,
--a textbook from one of your nursing courses, and
--**at least** one scholarly article that you have read in full

One potential source is PubMed, which you can find here: <http://www.pubmed.gov/>

When you search for articles, make sure you choose the “Full Text Links”

For additional help finding full text scholarly articles, it would be a good idea to visit the library and see if Abbie has time to sit down with you and show you what online resources are available, and how you can access them.
