WEDNESDAY, APRIL 23– [Chamber Orchestra Strings](#)

1. We will meet at MNHS, orchestra room for team dinner at 5:15 PM. We will load the buses at 6:00 PM.
2. We will arrive at **Millard West High School 5710 S. 176 Ave, Omaha, NE 68135** by 6:20 p.m.; leave instruments in the homeroom. We will transfer our warm-up room for precision tuning and warm-up at 6:50 PM. ***BRING YOUR TUNER/TUNING APP.**
3. **Our warm-up time is 6:55 P.M. in the band room and our performance time is 7:20 p.m. in the auditorium.**
4. We will load the bus after we perform and return to MNHS around 8:30 p.m.
5. ALL STUDENTS MUST RIDE THE BUS. If you need to arrive from or leave for an activity before/after we perform, Mrs. Martinez needs an email or note from your parent/legal guardian and you will need to provide your own transportation.
6. This is a required, graded, activity for first hour Chamber Orchestra students. Because Music does not have a state-level competition, District Music Contest *is our activity's equivalent of State!*

THURSDAY, APRIL 24 – Piano Soloists

Bring a clean, original score marked with measure numbers. If your piece is not memorized, you will need to bring an original part to play from as well. Arrive at **Millard West High School 5710 S. 176 Ave, Omaha, NE 68135** 20 minutes prior to your performance time. Check in at the registration table. Your warm-up space is in a practice room; performance space is **the Auditorium**.

1. Transportation is on your own.
2. You need to arrive at **Millard North High School, 1010 S. 144 St. Omaha, 68154** at least 20 minutes before your performance time.
3. You will need to bring your good instrument, music (remember – only ORIGINALS allowed), judge's score (unless I have it), and anything else needed for successful performance.
4. While you are waiting for your turn to perform, you can practice in the gym.
