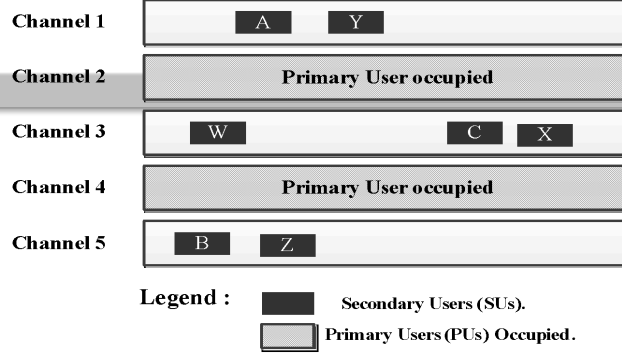


Fig. 1: Example of figure caption using center alignment.
