Dr. Krug started with recapping the timeline of the bleacher project and the different options. Nick Nemechek with GMCN Architects from Garden City, KS reviewed the engineer reports that have been conducted on the stadium. Nick shared a PowerPoint for each option and thoroughly reviewed them all. He included a great deal of information on each option. The Construction Manager at Risk, Andy Fahrmeier with Hutton Construction from Garden City, KS, also spoke about the different options. They shared the budget and timelines for all options. The total onsite construction schedule is anticipated for 4 months. 2 months for construction after bleacher materials have been delivered. There are known issues with supply shortage and delays. If a decision is made soon, it is a possibility for project to be finished for the next fall football season. When the drawings are completed, they would start the bidding process for any contractors interested in the sub work. Will solicit publicly for all jobs and then conducted an onsite job walk through. Dr. Krug reviewed the Capital Fund balance of 4 million dollars. He shared all the other needs that the district is facing in the future. The track replacement is project would not interfere with bleacher project. Bleacher project would be entering from the south side.
