Lettering Criteria and Eligibility

Eligibility

- Enrollment in Advanced level course Advanced Theatre or Advanced Technical Theater or Honors Theatre Ensemble (Technician/Performer) *AND*
- Active participant in PHS Thespian Troupe #8944 OR PHS Cappies Team.

Criteria

- Meet enrollment and participation requirements above
- Have participated in a minimum of 4 MainStage productions (Fall Play, Spring Musical) technician, performer, or designer.
- Must receive an "A(+/-)" for all eligible semesters in theatre courses
- Remain in good standing with the department for all eligible semesters
- Demonstrate Bulldog PRIDE values consistently through all eligible semesters

Bar Pin Eligibility and Criteria

Learners will be eligible to earn a bar letter pin for each subsequent year of enrollment in theatre courses after earning a letter. To earn a bar, learners must meet the following criteria:

- Have previously lettered in Theatre (see above requirements)
- Receive an "A(+/-)" for both semesters of the theatre course for the pin-eligible year
- Remain in good standing with the department throughout the pin-eligible year
- Demonstrate Bulldog PRIDE values consistently throughout the pin-eligible year
