

# RAISING CANE'S INGLEWOOD FLAGSHIP RESTAURANT FACT SHEET



## KEY DESIGN FACTS

- A massive 106-by-108-foot oval halo, larger than a professional basketball court, wraps the Restaurant exterior. Constructed from steel and more than 200 perforated aluminum panels, the feature incorporates a 10-by-92-foot LED display that illuminates Hollywood Park.
- Just inside the entrance, a 308-square-foot oval video display visually connects the Restaurant's first and second floors, while a 19-by-22-foot digital screen at the rear showcases immersive 3D content.
- A custom Disco Dog sculpture crafted from more than 185,000 mirrored tiles and created in collaboration with California artist Sofie Berarducci greets Customers on the first floor.
- A kinetic chandelier featuring 23 rotating disco balls sparkles throughout the day, including four spheres that can be lowered into the dining room.
- A custom DJ booth serves as a focal point on the first floor, complete with an oversized Cane's Sauce cup appearing to spill down its side. DJs can also control lighting effects throughout the Restaurant.
- The second-floor Broken Brick Mural reimagines a signature Raising Cane's design element with more than 300 reflective glass bricks inspired by the lights and energy of Hollywood Park.
- An oversized 8-foot-plus Raising Cane's cup doubles as a high-top table and appears to float above the stairwell below.
- Two illuminated ceiling installations spanning 360 square feet feature custom artwork inspired by Raising Cane's iconic brand imagery.
- Interactive art installations throughout the Restaurant celebrate Raising Cane's history and feature owner and founder Todd Graves and Cane I, the Brand's beloved yellow Labrador mascot and namesake.
- The Restaurant seats 85 Customers indoors and features expansive outdoor amphitheater-style seating.
- A dedicated walk-up ordering window offers Customers a convenient way to enjoy Chicken Finger Meals while visiting Hollywood Park.
- The Restaurant's multi-level design, metal paneling and glass exterior draw inspiration from neighboring sports and entertainment venues while creating a distinctive architectural identity within Hollywood Park.
