Mixed Cricket League 2025:

Description:

- Mixed Cricket League is a casual tournament for entertainment purposes to cater to students who are currently in the campus and are enthusiastic in playing cricket.

Venue: Open air theatre (Old SAC), Opposite Hostel 1.

Logistics:

- The tournament will be conducted from **4th October, 2025 to 2nd November, 2025.**
- There will be a maximum of **64 teams** participating on a **first-come, first-serve basis.**
- One player can play for only one team.
- The google form for participation will be circulated. Students will have to register as a team of **8 players (max 5 boys and 3 girls)** and the **playing 7 should contain 5 boys and 2 girls**
- The registration fees for the tournament is **INR 350 per team.**
- Participation will be open for all students present on campus.
- A green tennis ball and 2 bats will be provided.
- The boundaries will be marked properly with lines.
- We will conduct the tournament in a **knockout format** consisting of round of 64
- The participating team will have to report at least **15 min prior** to the start of their match and toss will be conducted. **Failure to do so will result in disqualification.**
- **Wearing sports shoes will be mandatory** and there will be no need for any other equipment (like other guards).

Rules:

- The format of the tournament will be Knockout. Each Playing Team will have 7 Players (5 Boys + 2 Girls).
- The game will have two innings and each inning will comprise **6 Overs**.
- Bowling limit: Only **1 Bowler** can bowl a Maximum of **2 Overs** (either boy or girl).
- **Power Over:** The 4th over of the innings will be a power over. In it, the batting side will decide target runs to be scored in the power over. If the batsmen complete the given target, the batting side will be awarded double the target runs. If not, the batting side will be awarded 0 runs.
For ex: Suppose the target for power over is set as 12
if the team scores 12 runs (or more than 12), they will be awarded 24 runs
if the team scores 11 runs or less, they will be awarded 0 runs.
- If the bowler bowls a ball **above the batsman's chest** (after one bounce), it will be considered as a **no ball**.
- Decisions regarding the pace of the bowl will be under the umpire's discretion.
- The rules and boundary lines will be explained before every innings.

Bowling Rules (Boys):

- Boys will bowl **under-arm** to girls.
- In general, a boy has to bowl over the arm and **throwing is allowed but the pace will be judged by the umpire**.

Bowling Rules (Girls):

- Girls will bowl from **3/4th** of the Pitch.
- Total number of overs from girls should be **at least 2**.
- It is mandatory that a girl bowls **1 over in the first 3 overs**.
- The total bowling overs by girls can be more than 2.

Batting Rules (Girls):

- It is mandatory that **1 girl bats in the first three batters. A girl cannot be the last batsman**.
- The boy will bowl underarm while the girl is batting
- The boy will bowl from about half (or three fourths) of the crease while bowling to the girl.
- The **boundaries will be shortened** while the girl is batting.

Trophies and Prizes:

- Winners Cup
- Runners Cup
- Orange cap (Best Batsman of the tournament)
- Purple cap (Best Bowler of the tournament)
- Tourney MVP
- Best Female Player of the tournament

- MVP of top 4 matches

- Best shot of tourney

During the game:

- 1 Umpire(on field) and 1 more leg umpire(maintain the scoreboard and individual record of the players on the app Cricheros)
- Umpires decision will be final any sort of ruckus will not be entertained
