PRESENT PERFECT SIMPLE VS. PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

Present Perfect Simple

☞ Formed by adding "have/has" to the **past participle**

S + have/has + V3

☞ Used with **finished** actions

The kids **have played** for 2 hours.



☞ Used for **permanent** actions

I **have taught** English for 12 years.

☞ Emphasis on the **result** of the action

He **has repaired** the car.



☞ Indicate **How much/How many** have been completed

It **has taken** six years to write this book.



Present Perfect Continuous

☞ Formed by adding "have/has been" to the **present participle**

S + have/has + been + V-ing

☞ Used with **unfinished** actions

The kids **have been playing** since morning.

☞ Used for **temporary** actions

I **have been teaching** this class for one hour.



☞ Emphasis on the **duration** of the action

He **has been repairing** the car for 2 hours.

☞ Indicates **How long** something has been happening

He **has been studying** English for two months.

NOTE

Always use the **present perfect simple** (not continuous) with the verbs **believe, know, understand, like/dislike, belong, own**:

We've **known** each other since we were kids.

I've **never understood** Math very well.

He's always **liked** sports.



PRESENT PERFECT TENSE

+

S + have/has + past participle

I have tried sushi.

-

S + have not (haven't)/has not (hasn't) + past participle

I have not tried sushi.

?

Have/Has + subject + past participle?

Have you tried sushi?

Particle	Structure	Translation	Where we place it	Examples
JUST	✓ × ?	<i>acabar de</i>	Between HAVE/HAS + main verb	We have <i>just</i> finished the film Has she <i>just</i> come in the room?
ALREADY	✓	<i>ya</i>	Between HAVE/HAS + main verb	Pete has <i>already</i> been to Italy
STILL	×	<i>todavía</i>	Before HAVE/HAS	Pete <i>still</i> hasn't been to Italy
YET	×	<i>todavía</i>	At the end	Pete hasn't been to Italy <i>yet</i>
	?	<i>ya</i>	At the end	Has Pete been to Italy <i>yet</i> ?
EVER	?	<i>alguna vez</i>	Between HAVE/HAS + main verb	Have you <i>ever</i> visited London?
NEVER	✓	<i>nunca</i>	Between HAVE/HAS + main verb	I have <i>never</i> visited London
FOR	✓ × ?	<i>durante, desde hace</i>	Before the period of time	I have lived in Santander <i>for</i> five years
SINCE	✓ × ?	<i>desde</i>	Before the specific moment in time	I have lived in Santander <i>since</i> 1999

Present Perfect Continuous Tense

+

S + have/has + been + V-ing

They have been learning English for 2 years.

-

S + have/has + not + been + V-ing

They have not been learning English for 2 years.

?

Have/has + S + been + V-ing

Have they been learning English for 2 years?
