

Costa Rica - Junio 2025

Who

Spanish students currently in 9th, 10th & 11th grade, levels III or above.

What

A 14-day trip of a lifetime to Costa Rica! This language and cultural immersion experience in Costa Rica will provide our students with a unique and enriching experience as they explore the rich and diverse natural resources, and unique geographical sites and biodiversity. Students will also have the unique opportunity to live with a host family for six days.

Where

The program includes travel to **San Jose**, the capital of Costa Rica, exploration of the local market, waterfall, hot springs, and volcano in **Arenal**, participation in a reforestation project, visit to the **Monteverde Reserve** and **Manuel Antonio National Park**, where students will be able to zipline through the clouds, enjoy time at the beach and get up-close views of a variety of wildlife.

Why

- To understand and respect a culture different from their own; the cultural practices, products, and perspectives of Costa Rica.
- To use Spanish as the only possible language of communication, to be truly immersed in the language.
- To recognize and enjoy the rich natural resources of Costa Rica, particularly agriculture, sustainable practices, the rainforest, geography, and biodiversity.

Cost

Approximately **\$3,814**, depending on the final registration number. This cost is based on a group size of 24 students.

Included: Airfare and in-country transportation (air, motorcoach, van as applicable), overnight accommodations (air, motorcoach, van as applicable), entrance fees, most meals, local Spanish-speaking guide, insurance for accidents or illnesses, and trip cancellation coverage due to medical reasons

Not Included: Airline baggage fees, dinner during the tour portion of the itinerary, spending money, and passport fees.
