

The First Schism:

Newly promoted, Commander Ravater, and Major Tiranis start butting heads and it gets even more intense when Ravater disapproves of the way Tiranis handled the Balmorra situation. Soon after, Helve transfers offship and Ravater is promoted to Captain. The ship splits into two factions, those loyal to Ravater and those loyal to Tiranis. Meanwhile, Rebel Erik Vorst infiltrates the *Evictus* posing as an ISB agent.

Aquilarius:

Captain Ravater orders the massacre of Aquilarius hoping the rebels will intervene. While planetside, Tiranis and Ravater bicker constantly and eventually, Ravater punches Tiranis and Tiranis arrests Ravater before quickly releasing him. Bombers destroy the surface on Aquilarius and eventually leads to a reactor explosion destroying the capital. Meanwhile, a rebel scouting party is shot down on the planet and troops led by Lt. Carrinc arrest them. The 3 rebels are all interrogated but one is thought dead, and two escape.

Continuing Schism and Random Events:

After returning from Aquilarius, Ravater has Tiranis arrested for mutiny. High Colonel Tiranis and Moff Harkus arrive and release Tiranis, however. Soon after, Lt. Carrinc is promoted to Captain, Sgt. Fire-Slug to Lieutenant, and 2Lt. Typherrius to Lieutenant. ISB Lt. Sovereign joins the ship and starts searching for the rebel traitor aboard and Ravater has the ship placed on lockdown. A small Imperial force is attacked by rebels on Beheboth and the Imperials find a large rebel supply depot there. The rebels soon evacuate. Cpt. Ravater and Mjr. Tiranis finally form a truce and decide to dedicate their time to defeating the rebels.

Mutiny:

Lt. Sovereign decides that Ravater is unfit to be Captain so he stuns him and captures him. He has Fire-Slug, Carrinc, and Private Logan guard the door. However, Fire-Slug and Carrinc switch sides and overwhelm Sovereign's men. Inside, Ravater is released and he dukes it out with Sovereign. Carrinc leads the push and breaks through the door. He arrests Sovereign and Ravater regains control of the ship. Later, Sovereign is found guilty of treason but he is killed trying to escape before he faces justice.

Almost Caught Him:

After the mutiny, Logan is promoted to Lieutenant and placed in command of Ravater's personal guard. Rebel spy, Lt. Vorst, is placed in charge of the search for the rebel spy. Tiranis and Carrinc find proof the traitor is Vorst but an automated message sent throughout the ship by Vorst leads Ravater to believe the traitor is Carrinc. Both Carrinc and Vorst are arrested but Carrinc commits suicide in his cell before he can stand trial. Carrinc's former squad, led by Bettin, defects to the rebels.

Rebel Doings:

During the mutiny, on the *Patience*, Admiral Freel is killed by Ettan Tiranis after Freel sleeps with Ettan's girlfriend, Lya Tasale. Ettan is arrested but only sentenced to probation. Meanwhile, newly defected, Captain Bettin and Commander Bralor, lead an attack on an Imperial supply ship. They massacre the Imperials and steal all their supplies. Down the line, Relais jai Dummak joins the *Patience* as its new Admiral.

The Second Schism:

When Ravater begins his iron grip as CO on the *Evictus*, Security Captain Markov plots to have him removed from power. Ravater and Battalion Captain Coulter arrange for 6 Imperials to be “kidnapped and killed by rebels” to raise willingness to fight. Ravater pins the murder on Commander Koro who transfers offship. Markov finds out about the kidnapping but only suspects Coulter. While under fire from the others, Coulter frames Ravater, Tiranis, and Lieutenant Treska (Fire-Slug’s replacement) to Markov. The 3 being framed plan to kill Markov to stop the investigation. Coulter, Tiranis, Ravater, and Treska are freed from all charges but Coulter is furious at the 3 for not backing him up against Markov. The civil war ends when Markov transfers offship but there is still bad blood between Coulter and Ravater.

Operation: Lancer:

Lt. Typherrius starts this to capture the rebels who are attacking the Imperial supply ships. Com. Bralor and Lt. Lance Typherrius of the rebels attack the supply ship but the trap is sprung and the Imperials attack. Lance is captured and brought back to the *Evictus*.

Also Happening: Ravater and his assistant, Tara Krendol, get engaged.

Empire Day Invasion:

To rescue Lance, the rebels launch an attack on the *Evictus* on Empire Day. Cpt. Bettin and Mjr. Gamut lead the attack on two fronts. Gamut’s main goal is to get Lance while Bettin is to distract. When Gamut is injured, Bettin takes control of the whole force towards the brig where they rescue Lance. The rebels make one last push to the bridge but are overwhelmed and forced to retreat. During the battle, Tiranis is captured by the rebels and the rebels escape with their goals accomplished. Soon after, Lt. Typherrius and Mjr. Coulter start an investigation into the location of the rebel ship.

The End of Ravater

Lt. Logan calls out Ravater for ruling with too much of an iron grip. This gets him demoted and sent offship. ISB Lt. Saht’ries (and Tiranis’ girlfriend) attacks Mjr. Coulter for his framing of Tiranis earlier and attempts to frame Coulter for attacking her. This prompts ISB Commander Wittlins to start an investigation into Ravater and Coulter. Treska leaves the ship and Fire-Slug returns under the command of Wittlins. Finally, Ravater is arrested for corruption and Wittlins takes control of the ship. Coulter transfers offship, Shat’ries is placed on the *Patience* as a spy, and Ravater escapes to the rebels with Tara Krendol. Ravater is given a trial by the rebels but is found guilty. Tara kills Ravater in his cell and escapes the *Patience*.

Rebel Doings pt.2

While Ravater is being ousted, Sgt. Blackjack retires from the Imperials but is persuaded to join the Sanbra cell. Cpt. Bettin also completes the first incarnation of the Rebel Spec Ops Team. Treska goes and joins the rebels as well. While refueling, the rebel ship is found and tracked by Imperials, they finally found the rebel base. Cpt. Bettin is captured on Cartve during a spec ops mission and he is imprisoned on Lola Sayu.

New Leadership:

Captain Hess is transferred to the *Evictus* as their new CO, while interim leader, Lt. Wittlins, transfers offship. The *Evictus* takes shore leave on Sanbra and many of the crew go shopping, get drinks, or go swoop biking. The Imperials find out about Ravater’s death and that the rebels still have Tiranis in captivity. Naval Intelligence is opened onboard under the command of

Captain Omnigor. Hess announces the end of shore leave as the *Evictus* joins a strike group to take out the Sanbra cell.

Vengeful Fist:

Imperial attack group under command of Cpt. Hess attacks the Rebel fleet. A boarding group enters the ship and rescues Tiranis and Saht'ries. The rebel fleet is almost completely decimated but some rebels manage to escape in escape pods. Several rebels are captured as well. Mjr. Gamut escapes and starts a new cell on Ilum while Lance, Lt. Ainn and their crew crash land on Shilia. After rescue Mjr. Tiranis is promoted to Col. Tiranis and the 451st Battalion is stationed on the *Evictus* along with the 348th.

Rebuilding the Rebellion:

Lance and his small band of rebels send out a transmission for any surviving rebels to come to Shilia. Over the next days, many rebels make it to the small scavenger camp. Soon after, the group of rebels find a crashed Venator cruiser thanks to Vonge Graak. The rebels get rid of a spider infestation inside the crashed ship and Lance names it the *Redemption*. The Rebel High Command meets for the first time since vengeful fist and the rebels manage to fix the hyperdrive and update the shields and weapons by Engineer Maydar.

Imperial Doings:

After Vengeful Fist, Lt. Vorst is finally released from prison but Cpt. Hess starts an investigation on him soon after. Tiranis and Saht'ries rekindle their relationship. Intense interrogation of rebel prisoners occur and many are killed. Meanwhile, because of the *Evictus* meddling in their business, Cartve is plunged into civil war and the capital is destroyed.

Redemption Takeoff:

The Rebels are attacked by a roaming band of pirates, resulting in several major injuries. Gold squadron bombs the absolute crap out of the raiding gang. The rebels lick their wounds and repair the *Redemption* in the meantime. Maydar contracts radiation poisoning due to his work on getting the reactor working again. *Redemption* finally takes flight. Soon after, Gen. Talki'na and Adm. Dummak leave the ship to deal with business. Soon after, Dummak is killed on Eriadu after attempting to assassinate Col. Tiranis. The living rebel prisoners are released off the *Evictus* by rebel spy, Lcpl. Zerga. Ettan Tiranis finds his way back to the rebels as well.

Attack on Luxury Liner and Imperial Doings

After an attack on a luxury cruiser by pirates led by Gen. Talki'na, the crew of the *Evictus* is dispatched to save the personnel and eliminate the pirate scum on Alzoc IV. Unbeknownst to the Empire, the pirates ended up actually being rebels, resulting in the first battle between the two sides since Operation Vengeful Fist. The hostages are successfully rescued, with Tiranis' father among them. Gen. Talki'na returns to the *Redemption* and starts a plan to free Imperial slaves in the Outer Rim. Meanwhile, the *Evictus*'s patrol zone is expanded and stormtroopers clash with dissidents on Cartve. The Imperials recover an artifact and an Inquisitor comes to the ship and destroys it.

Battle of Yuga 2:

ISB Lt. Dar'yaim was sent to a scouting mission to Yuga 2 where he was captured by the rebel cell there. Subsequently, Cmdr. Typherrius sends Imperials to rescue him. The *Redemption* arrives and Lt. Ainn of the rebels captures Dar'yaim and Pvt. Falconer. The Imperials completely

destroy the Yuga 2 rebel cell and the captured Imperials are placed in the brig but they escape soon afterwards. After that, the *Redemption* rescues the rebel cell led by Mjr. Gamut over Ilum and Gamut rejoins the Sanbra cell. Cmdr. Typherrius is also promoted to captain after Cpt. Hess transfers offship.

Fire-Slug Incident:

Tech Sgt. Ceres attempts to reveal Tiranis' corruption but is kidnapped by Lt. Kord and Lt. Fire-Slug. As they are torturing Ceres, they are found. Fire-Slug transfers offship and Kord is arrested. Kord goes to trial but during it, Dar'yaim and Falconer set off a bomb and proceed to try and escape. Both are expelled from the ship and both are taken in the the Sanbra cell but Dar'yaim is imprisoned along with Vonge for fighting. The *Redemption* picks up a 14-year old force sensitive named Jassa and the Spec Ops Team rescue 300 slaves on a jungle moon

Caf Crisis and Rogue Moff:

The *Evictus* isn't resupplied as normal and the ship is sent into a frenzy after it runs out of caf. The ship travels to De'eta but is chased off. They next travel to the Sharlissia system where they are refused supplies by Moff Eltbrunn. They soon learn the moff has gone rogue and begin to hunt him down. Meanwhile, the ship resupplies and the crisis ends. The *Evictus* engages the flagship of Eltbrunn's nephew. They quickly disable the ship and a boarding party finds the crew already dead. Soon after, the *Evictus* joins Task Force: Magnus which begins to hunt down the rogue moff who has amassed his fleet over Jutrand.

Battle of Jutrand:

Task Force: Magnus jumps out of hyperspace and engages the moff's fleet. TF:M does enough damage to cause most of the moff's forces to heavily bomb Jutrand before jumping away. Col. Shol and Lt. Col. Tiranis led the ground invasion but their forces were swept into a sinkhole after a trap was sprung. Tiranis, upset with Shol's decisions, kills him and takes command. Eltbrunn crashes the last remaining ISD into the capital, causing a huge dust storm. Tiranis orders blind firing and artillery strikes which end up killing many Imperials. The Imperials capture Jutrand but at a heavy cost. After the battle, NI begins an investigation into possible treason by Lt. Col. Tiranis

More Rebel Doings:

The Special Operations team is officially reorganized into the Republic Dogs led by Captain Lance Typherrius (It includes Eagles, Vonge, and Cathal). Meanwhile, Jassa begins flying lessons and during one, she accidentally jumps into hyperspace and gets captured by Imperials. Defected Imperial, Dar'yaim, is put on trial and assigned to a penal battalion. Soon after, Vonge kills Dar'yaim and Vonge is given kitchen duty. Also, Ettan and Silseen rescue the mysterious Sister from outer space and bring her back to the *Redemption*. She meets spookily with members of the crew before leaving suddenly.

After Jutrand:

Flight Lt. Drow attempts to defect but he is shot down and he commits suicide by slamming his ship into the *Evictus*. As Drow is a Chiss, the Ascendancy send Cir'gi to investigate what has

happened. After seeing what has happened, Cir'gi stuns Lt. Malric and defects to the rebels.. Lt. Col. Tiranis is arrested by NI for treason and thrown in a cell and Lt. malric interrogates him harshly. Lt. Malric also attempts to arrest Lt. Mert for continually overstepping his bounds but Mert calls in a Mandalorian attack fleet. Mert is killed, the Mandos are destroyed, and Mandalorians are banned from the *Evictus*.

Lead Up to Darkknell:

TF:M receives word that the moff has amassed his fleet over Darkknell and begins to plan an assault. Anvil takes place and Stormtroopers destroy the Moff's droid factories on Delta IV. Stormtroopers also attack and destroy the Moff's communications facility on Darkknell. On the *Redemption*, Ettan Tiranis starts planning the rescue of Jassa. It is decided that the Republic Dogs will attack the *Evictus* the day they invade Darkknell. The Dogs also receive new armor and Cir'gi joins them at the behest of the Ascendancy.

Assault on Darkknell:

TF:M jumps out of hyperspace and takes the moff's forces by surprise. Tanks and bombers roll through the planet, taking out thousands of droids and rogue troops. Meanwhile, ISB Lt. Jastra leads a boarding party to Eltbrunn's flagship. The team faces tons of problems but eventually make it to the bridge where they find all naval personnel already dead and Eltbrunn gone. TF:M manages to destroy pretty much the entirety of Eltbrunn's fleet and the ground forces capture the capital. With the moff's forces destroyed, TF:M leaves.

Operation: Bring Her Home and Aftermath:

Concurrent to Darkknell, the Republic Dogs attack the *Evictus*. They manage to breach a hole in the hull and enter the ship. The team makes their way to the cells where Pvt. Falconer kills ISB Lt. Kord and the team gets Jassa. During the escape, Lance is punctured with debris and severely injured. He falls into a coma as they reach the ship. The ship takes off and Jassa is saved. After returning, Falconer leaves to find a drug to heal Lance. With Lance out of commission, Vonge becomes Captain of the Dogs.

Change in Rebel Leadership:

Falconer successfully retrieves medicine from Kamino and returns to the rebels. Lance wakes up from his coma and retires from military service. Flight Cpt. Ettan Tiranis also awakens from coma with amnesia. Rebel High Command call for Gen. Talki'na to resign. Talki'na agrees and steps down. Lance is promoted to general and becomes the new leader of the Sanbra cell. Soon after, Cpt. Bettin returns from Imperial custody and joins with Vonge to lead the Republic Dogs.

Leadup to Cartve:

ISB receives word that Moff Elbtrunn is holed up in a facility somewhere on Cartve. This prompts Cpt. Typherrius to cancel shore leave and announce the *Evictus* will be pacifying Cartve. Meanwhile, Col. Tiranis' trial is held and he is demoted to Major. ISB Lt. Jastra is promoted to Commander and given control of all ISB. ISB Lt. Cmdr. Novarin and Lt. Malric go ahead to find the moff's facility on cartve but they are ambushed. Novarin is captured and dies in his cell while Malric escapes with the location of the moff's fortress. Lt. Fire-Slug has one last mental breakdown and is killed by security troopers.

Second Pacification of Cartve:

The *Evictus* comes to Cartve and stormtroopers land in the southern continent and begin cleansing it. Courage Company leads the front assault, taking large villages and casualties. The *Redemption* arrives and manages to keep an Imperial battalion busy before retreating. Eventually, most of the Imperial force converges on the capital, Oppido, and Mjr. Arniak leads the Imperials to a swift and great victory. Mjr. Arniak is given the new Col. position and he and Cpt. Typherrius begin to focus on the north. Meanwhile, Cmdr. Jastr leads a small raiding party to the moff's fortress and kills Elbtrunn. Finally, Typherrius orders a BDZ of the northern continent which ends the battle.

Various Rebel Missions:

After Cartve, Ven, Cir'gi, and K3 go on flight lessons but are attacked by pirates. They crash land on D'Qar but manage to find a new ship, an E-9, and return to the *Redemption*. Mirsh and, newly promoted, Chief Medical Officer Falconer find freelance work on Sanbra to assassinate a mob boss which nets them tons of credits. Hirra and Braun lead a team to Beheboth to find a new refueling station for the *Redemption* however it fails. Bettin leads the Dogs to steal Imperial hyperdrives so the rebels can attack an Imperial comms base. The Dogs successfully steal the hyperdrives and an Imperial Gozanti, which joins the fleet.

Battle of Rugosa:

Soon after the end of Cartve, Admiral Sol Kohout arrived on the *Evictus* to perform loyalty review on Captain Typherrius. However, the ship had to spring into action when the rebels attacked the comms station on Rugosa. Cpt. Bettin and Lt. Ainn led a strike force to the surface that successfully broadcasted rebel propaganda throughout the holonet. The Imperials arrived soon afterwards and attacked the surface as well as sent a boarding team led by Col. Arniak to the *Redemption*. The boarding team managed to hide a tracker on the ship after Cpl. Ron blew himself up to take out the rebel security team. However, Tech Sgt. Ceres defected to the rebels and the Imperials kills Gundark Leader Locke on their way off the ship. The *Redemption* jumped out of the system, escaping the attack.

The Chase:

As the *Redemption* jumped out of hyperspace, an engine blew up which led the *Evictus* to being much faster than the escaping rebel cruiser. The *Redemption* sailed into the Alui sector on a course towards Enarc with the *Evictus* following. Meanwhile, K-3SO malfunctioned on the *Redemption* and Vonge Graak shot him down. Cir'gi managed to put him together however and remove all Imperial programming. Ceres was allowed to roam the rebel ship and eventually joined engineering. Imperial, Col. Arniak and rebel, Lance, both respectively sent Lt. Veles and Cpt. Bettin on scouting missions to Enarc. Both sides recuperated from the battle as Cpl. Settcha of the Imperials found the rebel ship and the *Evictus* jumped into attack.

Naval Superiority:

The *Evictus* surprised the *Redemption* in the south Alui and went into a naval battle. Fighters were launched and the *Evictus* engineering decks were ripped open. Both captains pulled numerous maneuvers which led to both ships being very damaged. Eventually, the *Redemption* managed to escape into a nearby nebula and escaped the Empire. Chief Engineer Ceres began the repairs on the *Redemption* and the *Evictus* went for repairs on Draik 4.

Shore Leave:

The Evictus went for repairs over Draik 4 and the crew was given shore leave. The Lieutenant's club met among other things. Col. Arniak also developed PTSD and fell and hit his head blaming Com. Farve for poisoning him. He eventually broke up a wedding but was convinced to seek treatment which he did. Rebel spy Zerga also destroyed the Evictus Interceptor complement and was killed by Lt. Malric. The ships were replaced with normal TIE's. NI was also reassigned off the ship and Lt. Tibby went to Lt. Cmdr and Gilid to Chief Engineer. Arniak also set up a large simulation for the corps on the planet.

Hidden at the Moment:

The Redemption hid in the nebula and a team of Vonge, Bettin, and Rykan went to Enarc and found out they would be able to repair there. They returned and Ceres managed to get some of the main engines up and running. Bettin also reformed the Dogs, making Eagles 2IC. The ship recieved a new naval captain by the name of Keel Surilani and the intelligence division grew rapidly. Unfortunately, Bettin and Vonge confronted each other in the training room and fought, leaving both injured and Bettin arrested. With the help of Ceres and K3, Bettin escaped to join Treska in starting a new rebel cell. Ven also attempted to commit suicide but he was saved by Vonge, being placed in the medbay.

Black Sun Incident:

While attending a podrace on Draik 4, Colonel Arniak is shot by a Black Sun thug and the Black Sun also attempt to kill him once again outside the arena. Arniak began a campaign to find their base, sending Kaykal and Baize to hunt them down. While this was occurring, Lt. Riggs was arrested for theft and breaking into Cmdr. Tiberiusolis' quarters. He was arrested and his trial took place soon after. A small squad of troopers would soon find the HQ and the Evictus would decimate the HQ and shore leave would end

Salvage:

New rebel arrival, Kardue Tagoon would soon find information about a salvage site ripe for the pickings on Devaron. He gathered a team of Ceres, Mirshkot, Willaume, Rykan, and Renee and set of to the planet. Two groups split with Ceres's team successfully retrieving hyperdrive parts for the Redemption. Kardue's team met Sister who forced them to receive a holocron for them. They did so and took a number of weapons and ammo from the downed Venator they were salvaging. All men escaped the planet safely. They returned and the Redemption's repairs were completed, leading them to leave the nebula and enter the space in the Alui system

Battle of Haruun Kal:

The Evictus received a distress call from a garrison on Haruun Kal and quickly deployed there. Colonel Arniak led a small incursion planetside that was ambushed. Arniak discovered a large terrorist organization there and the Evictus deployed a large number of troopers to fight. The battle raged on for months with heavy casualties, as the ISB provided little to no intel. While the battle raged, an inquisitor on an ISB mission searched for a force-sensitive girl in a nearby village, stumbled upon by one Cadet Ralle Tarsson, leading to his defection. Major Tiranis (RIP smut master Lex) was killed after he was launched out of a breach in the Evictus hull. A scout

squad located the base of the insurgents and the Evictus BDZ'd the planet. All personnel returned to the Evictus and the ship went for repairs, allowing the crew to rest.

Battle of Enarc:

While the Imperials dealt with the aftermath of Haruun Kal, the Rebel cell received a distress signal from the planet Enarc. The call came from another Rebel cell, asking for assistance against a radical terrorist organization based on their planet led by Bettin and Treska. Upon arriving, the Rebels faced fierce fighting, finding the Enarc rebel fighters to be ill-prepared and under poor leadership. Eventually, the Rebels made it to Bettin and Treska's headquarter: the presidential palace. There, Lance Typherrius and Bettin dueled one-on-one to the death in an effort to prevent any more loss of life, eventually ending in a narrow victory for Lance. With Bettin killed, the radicalist cell dissolved, with the fate of Treska unknown

Strange Circumstances:

After viewing the reports for the casualties on Haruun Kal, Colonel Arniak became frustrated and contacted Captain Typherrius. As the two began to investigate the causes of the investigation, they realized that much of the evidence that had led to the operation seemed coincidental, strange, or out-of-place. This led to ISB Commander Jastra and Lieutenant Malric to open up their file on the case as well, further realizing that much of the information they had was non-existent. Despite their best efforts, the questions from the operation remained in the dark.

Mental Check-Up

Following the aftermath of Haruun Kal, Colonel Arniak was interviewed by one General Takinson for an annual performance review. The General made note of the Colonel's continued mental health issues as mentioned by Thrayce Typherrius in his field reports, stating that it would "be a shame if Arniak had to be replaced due to being incapable of dealing with his mind"- a direct threat against Arniak's digging into the Haruun Kal operation. The General then assigned Arniak and the rest of the 1065th Legion to put down a local mining strike on the Karlinus System. Arniak then promoted logistics Lieutenant Kolzaar to the position of Major in preparation for the operation, codenamed Operation Danger Zone. Kolzaar was the first Major to fill the position since the demise of Lex Tiranis some months prior.

Thrayce Typherrius' Wild Ride (Shore Leave)

Following the battle of Haruun Kaal, another shore leave was issued to the Evictus. During this shore leave, a large portion of the officer corps, including Captain Typherrius, ISB Commander Jastra, and others, partook in what can only be described as a drunken rampage through the outer rim. Most can not remember what happened, and those who do wish they didn't.

Strange Circumstances Part II:

Some time after the battle of Haruun Kal, Captain Typherrius, still dissatisfied with the overall conclusions drawn from the campaign, continued his own investigation. He reported his findings to his cohort Colonel Arniak, revealing that CommScan had detected a cloaked stealth-ship jumping in and out of the system with Imperial transponders, though no further data was given nor was any ship even catalogued as existing. After several hours of investigating, the two came to the conclusion that the ISB was somehow involved in a false-flag operation, though the exact details remained unseen.

Operation Jackal:

The definitive culmination of the Sanbra Cell, Operation Jackal was launched after discovering the *Evictus* and her crew had an extensive database that contained detailed information about nearly every aspect of the cell, including names, locations, schematics, etc. In an effort to both wipe this database and obtain an obtuse amount of counter-intelligence, Cathal of the Republic Dogs put together a mission that involved infiltrating the Imperial citadel on Rintonne, finding the files, deleting them, and exfil off the planet. General Lance Typherrius and Sergeant Kardue led a full-out assault outside of the base in an effort to cover the infiltration team, which included Cathal, K-3, Vonge Graak, Ryan Sagi, and Scane Rekkles. The assault drew all attention away from the team while they conducted their mission. During the infil, Vonge slipped away, instead looking for the identity of the Imperial that had captured him and stolen his honor years ago. He successfully identified this individual as Sergeant Baize, stationed on the *Evictus*.

Their Finest Hour:

After Operation Jackal had begun, the *Evictus* received a garbled transmission that was ultimately decoded as a distress signal from Rintonne. The ship quickly jumped in, meeting the *Redemption* in orbit over the planet and engaging in a deadly dual. Though hard-fought, the *Evictus* managed air-superiority, on the brink of destroying the Rebel ship once and for all. However, the assault was stopped after Colonel Arniak messaged the Captain, claiming he had identified Lance Typherrius on the ground. Seeing an opportunity to kill his father and destroy the Sanbra Cell by cutting the head off the snake, Thrayce left the *Evictus* for the ground, leaving the ship to ominously watch the *Redemption*. In the following counter attack, the Sanbra Cell was completely destroyed by Arniak's attack force- Lance and Vonge were both killed by Thrayce Typherrius, Scane Rekkles was killed during the assault, Ven Falconer was nearly killed and knocked unconscious, Major Per Gamut was slaughtered as he covered the other Rebel's retreat. On the Imperial side, dozens of soldiers were killed in the initial push, most notably Sergeant Baize after being mauled to death by Vonge. With their top brass all killed, their ship nearly wiped, and the overall mission a disaster, the Sanbra cell barely retreated, tattered and destroyed beyond repair.
