Crochet Bonnet - One Size Fits Most





Main body:

chain 16, then chain 1 more.

slip stitch 16 into all of the chain spaces. You should now have a long "U" shaped stack of chains.

chain 1 and turn your work.

row 1: single crochet in the first 16 stitches on one side, then follow the curve and crochet 16 on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should have 32 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work. You should be working in a "U" shape.

row 2: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. then follow the curve and crochet 16 on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 33 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 3: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. then increase in the 17th stitch as well. follow the curve and crochet 16 on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 35 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 4: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. single crochet normally in 2 stitches, the increase in the third. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 37 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 5: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. single crochet normally in one stitch then increase in the 18th stitch. single crochet normally in one stitch then increase in the 20th stitch. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 39 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 6: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. single crochet normally in one stitch then increase in the 18th stitch. single crochet normally in one stitch then increase in the 20th stitch. single crochet normally in one stitch then increase in the 22nd stitch. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 43 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 7: single crochet in the first 15 stitches on one side, then increase in the 16th stitch. single crochet normally in two stitches then increase in the 19th stitch. single crochet normally in two stitches then increase in the 21st stitch. single crochet normally in two stitches then increase in the 23rd stitch. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 47 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 8: single crochet in the first 17 stitches, then increase in the 18th stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase in the 22nd stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase in the 26th stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase

in the 30th stitch. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch. you should now have 51 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 9: single crochet in the first 17 stitches, then increase in the 18th stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase in the 22nd stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase in the 26th stitch. single crochet normally in three stitches then increase in the 30th stitch. follow the curve and crochet on the other side. do not join your last stitch to your first stitch, you should now have 55 stitches, chain 1 and turn your work.

row 10: single crochet in all 55 stitches, with no increases.

row 11: single crochet for 23 stitches, then decrease in the 24th and 25th stitch. continue single crocheting for 5 stitches then decrease in the 31st and 32nd stitch. single crochet until the end. you should have 53 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 12: single crochet for 22 stitches, then decrease in the 23rd and 24th stitch. continue single crocheting for 5 stitches then decrease in the 30th and 31st stitch. single crochet until the end. you should have 51 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 13: single crochet for 26 stitches, then decrease in the 27th and 28th stitch. continue single crocheting until the end. you should have 50 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

row 14-22: single crochet in all 50 stitches. chain 1 and turn your work.

Cast off, pull through, and cut your yarn.



bottom ribbing:

chain 4.

single crochet in the 2nd stitch. single crochet in all 3 stitches, chain 1 and turn your work. single crochet in the back loops of every single crochet.


46 rows

top ribbing:

chain 4.

single crochet in the 2nd stitch. single crochet in all 3 stitches, chain 1 and turn your work. single crochet in the back loops of every single crochet.

51 rows



assemble:

attach the bottom ribbing along the bottom of the bonnet, and the top ribbing along the from opening.



fold the front ribbing back, and sew it down again.

bow:

chain 40 for each side

alternatively, you could make an i-cord out of a thinner yarn.



assemble:

attach each chain to each corner.
