

Article 2, Section 2 of the National Bar Association Act shall be amended from:

§2. Persons who achieve a score of eighty percent (80%) or higher on the certification exam shall pass; being granted the status of Certified Attorney.

To:

§2. Persons who achieve a score of eighty percent (80%) or higher on the certification exam, or if they complete a legal studies course approved by the Department of Education, shall be granted the status of Certified Attorney.
