Classroom Discipline Policy

Behavior:

- Repeated or extreme behavior will result in escalating consequences that may include but are not limited to suspension or expulsion.

Grading for 4th Grade Music is as follows:

- 50% Daily Work (Participation Points) - 5 pts/week
 - being an active participant in class
- 10% Classwork/Written Assignments
- 25% Tests (singing and written)
- 15% Final Exam/Performances

***Concert attendance is mandatory. Concerts are an important assessment of musical skills and a culmination of our hard work and preparation in class.**

Ukulele Resources:

- Most students play on a soprano size (smallest) or a concert size (slightly larger body and neck) ukulele.
- Recommended brands for beginners: Kala, Makala, Cordoba, Enya.
- If purchasing a ukulele consider buying a clip on tuner and a gig bag or hard case.
