For Pre-Approved Courses.

If you are taking a course that is offered "by petition" it will not automatically show up your degree audit You will need to [submit a petition](#) or send a message in the Virtual Advising Center asking for the following:

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For Transfer, Study Abroad and non-pre-approved courses.

- Complete an [Undergraduate Student Petition](#) - Fill out a separate petition for each course that you are petitioning. Attach course syllabus.
- Submit completed petition(s) & syllabus to the Global Health Advisor (The form can be scanned and sent via email to ghpadvising@ucsd.edu or dropped off in the [GHP Office](#))
- You will be notified via the Virtual Advising Center (<http://vac.ucsd.edu>) once your petition has been approved (please allow 2 weeks before contacting advisor)
