Terms of Service

Welcome to GoOut4!

Intro

We have drafted these Terms of Service (which we call the "Terms") so you'll know the rules that govern our relationship with you.

Our relationship with you includes:

- (i) all your interactions with us,
- (ii) your access to and use of our services, including our various websites, SMS, APIs, email notifications, applications, buttons, widgets, ads, commerce services, and our other covered services that link to these Terms (collectively, the "Services"), and

(iii) any information, text, links, images, graphics, photos, audio, videos, or other materials or arrangements of materials uploaded, downloaded, or appearing on the Services (collectively referred to as “Content”).

Although we have tried our best to use clear and plain language and strip the legalese from the Terms, there are places where these Terms may still read like a traditional contract. There’s a good reason for that: These Terms do indeed form a legally binding contract between you and GoOut4.

By using the GoOut4 or any of our other products or services that link to these Terms (we refer to these simply as the “Services”), you agree to be bound by these Terms. Of course, if you don’t agree with them, then don’t use the Services.

So please read them carefully!

Our services

We agree to provide you with the Services described below to you:

- People you care about
- People you admire
- Brands and Locations that you like

Who may use our services

We want our Service to be as open and inclusive as possible, but we also want it to be safe, secure, and in accordance with the law. So, we need you to commit to a few restrictions in order to be part of the community.

- By using the Services, you state that you can form a binding contract with GoOut4;
- You must be at least 13 years old. Consequently, no one under 13 is allowed to create an account or use the Services. We may offer additional Services with additional terms that may require you to be even older to use them. For example, You must be at least 18 years old to purchase RCC. So please read all terms carefully;

- You must not be prohibited from receiving any aspect of our Service under applicable laws or engaging in payments related Services if you are on an applicable denied party listing;
- You must not be a person who is barred from receiving the Services under the laws of the United States, European Union, or any other applicable jurisdiction—meaning that you do not appear on the U.S. Treasury Department’s list of Specially Designated Nationals or face any other similar prohibition.
- We must not have previously disabled your account for violation of law or any of our policies.
- You must not be a convicted sex offender.
- You will comply with these Terms and all applicable local, state, national, and international laws, rules, and regulations.
- GoOut4 uses Google Places Autocomplete, to provide some of its features. Therefore, you must agree and accept to be bound by [Google’s Terms of Service](#).

The Service may be modified, updated, interrupted, suspended, or discontinued at any time without notice or liability.

If you are accepting these Terms and using the Services on behalf of a company, organization, or other legal entity, you represent and warrant that you are authorized to do so and have the authority to bind such entity to these Terms, in which case the words “you” and “your” as used in these Terms shall refer to such entity.

The country of incorporation of the Company shall have exclusive jurisdiction in all matters relating to this Agreement.

Rights We Grant You

GoOut4 grants you a personal, worldwide, royalty-free, non-assignable, nonexclusive, revocable, and non-sublicensable license to access and use the Services. This license is for the sole purpose of letting you use and enjoy the

Service's benefits in a way that these Terms and our usage policies, such as our Community Guidelines, allow.

Rights You Grant Us

Many of our Services let you create, upload, post, send, receive, and store content. When you do that, you retain whatever ownership rights in that content you had to begin with. But you grant us a license to use that content. How broad that license is depends on which Services you use and the Settings you have selected.

For all Services you irrevocably grant GoOut4 a worldwide, perpetual, royalty-free, assignable, sublicensable, and transferable license to host, store, use, publicly display, reproduce, modify, reformatate, adapt, incorporate into advertisements and other works, create derivative works, edit, publish, promote, distribute Your Content. This license is for the limited purpose of operating, developing, providing, promoting, improving the Services, and researching and developing new ones.

Because Public Posts are inherently public and matter of public interest, the license you grant us for content submitted to those Services is broader. In addition to the rights you grant us in connection with other Services, you also grant us a perpetual license to create derivative works from, promote, exhibit, broadcast, syndicate, publicly perform, and publicly display content submitted in any form and in any and all media or distribution methods (now known or later developed). To the extent it's necessary, you also grant GoOut4 and our business partners the unrestricted, worldwide, perpetual right and license to use your name, likeness, and voice solely in the content that you appear in, create, upload, post, or send. This means, among other things, that you will not be entitled to any compensation from GoOut4 or our business partners if your name, likeness, or voice is conveyed through the Public Content.

While we're not required to do so, we may access, review, screen, and delete your content at any time and for any reason, including if we think your content violates these Terms. You alone though remain responsible for the content you create, upload, post, send or store through the Service.

The Services may contain advertisements. In consideration for GoOut4 letting you access and use the Services, you agree that GoOut4, its affiliates, and third-party partners may place advertising on the Services.

We always love to hear from our users. But if you volunteer feedback or suggestions, just know that we can use your ideas without compensating you.

Safety

We try hard to keep our Services a safe place for all users. But we can't guarantee it. That's where you come in. By using the Services, you agree that:

- You will not use the Services for any purpose that is illegal or prohibited by these Terms.
- You will not use any robot, spider, crawler, scraper, or other automated means or interface to access the Services or extract other user's information.
- You will not use or develop any third-party applications that interact with the Services or other users' content or information without our written consent.
- You will not use the Services in a way that could interfere with, disrupt, negatively affect, or inhibit other users from fully enjoying the Services, or that could damage, disable, overburden, or impair the functioning of the Services.
- You will not use or attempt to use another user's account, username, or password without their permission.
- You will not solicit login credentials from another user.
- You will not post content that contains or links to pornography, graphic violence, threats, hate speech, or incitements to violence.
- You will not upload viruses or other malicious code or otherwise compromise the security of the Services.
- You will not attempt to circumvent any content-filtering techniques we employ or attempt to access areas or features of the Services that you are not authorized to access.

- You will not probe, scan, or test the vulnerability of our Services or any system or network.
- You will not encourage or promote any activity that violates these Terms.

Even though we are doing our best to offer you the best and safest experience, we want you to be aware that you use the Service at your own risk, including the risk that you might be exposed to Content that is offensive, indecent, inaccurate, objectionable, incomplete, fails to provide adequate warning about potential risks or hazards, or is otherwise inappropriate.

We also care about your safety while using our Services. So do not use our Services in a way that would distract you from obeying traffic or safety laws. For example, never use GoOut4 and drive. And never put yourself or others in harm's way just to capture a good picture.

Your Account

You are responsible for any activity that occurs in your GoOut4 account. So it's important that you keep your account secure. One way to do that is to select a strong password that you don't use for any other account.

By using the Services, you agree that in addition to exercising common sense:

- You will not create more than one account for yourself.
- You will not create another account if we have already disabled your account unless you have our written permission to do so.
- You will not buy, sell, rent, or lease access to your GoOut4 account, a GoOut4 username, or a friend link without our written permission.
- You will not share your password.
- You will not log in or attempt to access the Services through unauthorized third-party applications or clients.

If you think that someone has gained access to your account, please immediately reach out to GoOut4 Support.

Your Content

Your Content means Content that you submit or transmit to, through, or in connection with the Service, such as ratings, reviews, photos, videos, compliments, invitations, check-ins, votes, friending, and following activity, direct messages, and information that you contribute to your user profile or any other content.

- You alone are responsible for Your Content, and once posted to GoOut4, it cannot always be withdrawn;
- You assume all risks associated with Your Content, including anyone's reliance on its quality, accuracy, or reliability, and any risks associated with the personal information you disclose.
- You represent that you own or have the necessary permissions to use and authorize the use of Your Content as described herein.
- You may not imply that Your Content is in any way sponsored or endorsed by GoOut4

You may expose yourself to liability if, for example, Your Content contains material that is false, intentionally misleading, or defamatory; violates any third-party right, including any copyright, trademark, patent, trade secret, moral right, privacy right, right of publicity, or any other intellectual property or proprietary right; contains material that is unlawful, including illegal hate speech or pornography; exploits or otherwise harms minors; violates or advocates the violation of any law or regulation, or violates these Terms.

Please note that you also irrevocably grant the users of the Service the right to access Your Content in connection with their use of the Service. Finally, you irrevocably waive, and cause to be waived, against GoOut4 and its users any claims and assertions of moral rights or attribution with respect to Your Content. By "use" we mean use, copy, publicly perform and display, reproduce, distribute, modify, translate, remove, analyze, commercialize, and prepare derivative works of Your Content.

The Content of Others

Much of the content on our Services is produced by users, publishers, and other third parties. Whether that content is posted publicly or sent privately, the content is the sole responsibility of the person or organization that submitted it. Although GoOut4 reserves the right to review all content that appears on the Services and to remove any content that violates these Terms, we do not necessarily review all of it. So we cannot—and do not—take responsibility for any content that others provide through the Services.

Through these Terms and our Community Guidelines, we make clear that we do not want the Services put to bad uses. But because we do not review all content, we cannot guarantee that content on the Services will always conform to our Terms or Guidelines.

Intro

In this document, the "Data Controller", the "Company", "we", "us", "our" refers to the above legal entity.

Data Protection Policies (or Data Policies, Privacy Policies) seem to be created by the people paid per word. They are long and full of legalese due to legal compliance requirements.

We did our best to make our Data Protection Policy short, easy to access, easy to understand, and in clear and plain language, especially for our young users. However, we couldn't avoid all legal terms, but we created a Glossary of Terms to help you to better understand the terms.

Even though worldwide, there are various privacy legislation (So many countries, so many customs), we voluntarily choose to apply the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) standards to all our users regardless if they are a GDPR subject or they are users outside of the European Union jurisdiction. One application, one Data Protection Policy!

We want you to read our entire Data Protection Policy and all the other documents that govern the relationship between us and you, and we want you to do it before creating an account, in order to have a good understanding of what, how, and more importantly why we are doing things as we do.

However, if you are like us, you are eager to use the application not to read legal documents. That's why we've started this policy with a short summary followed by our core beliefs, our principles, and a detailed explanation of the Data Protection Policy.

This Data Protection Policy and a Glossary of Terms are accessible to you at any time on our website. Moreover, if you have questions about this policy and our privacy practices we want to hear from you. Our Core Beliefs

We do everything (designing, developing, creating, managing our services) having in mind that our Personal Data and Personal Data of our families, our friends, and our fellow human beings are on the line!

We acknowledge that you trust us with your Personal Data and that is a huge responsibility for us. We promise you that we do our best to keep your and our data safe, to process your and our data only for the purpose(s) for which it has been provided, and never abuse your data and your trust.

We hope you will help us to protect all Personal Data!

Our Data Protection Principles

- OK!** We design with privacy in mind.
- OK!** We communicate honestly and openly.
- OK!** You control your information.
- OK!** You choose what data you share with us.

Your Rights!

Your rights are important to us, and we want to inform you about your rights before anything else.

OK! You have the right to know if we are processing your personal data.

OK! You have the right to know what personal data we are processing and the purposes of the processing.

OK! You have the right to request from us access to your personal data.

OK! You have the right to obtain from us the rectification of inaccurate personal data.

OK! You have the right to obtain from us the erasure of your personal data.

OK! You have the right to obtain from us restriction of processing of your personal data.

OK! You have the right to object at any time to processing of your personal data.

OK! You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling.

OK! You have the right to receive your personal data and to transmit that data to another controller (data portability right).

GoOut4 will respond to your request only where this is not inconsistent with our Terms of Use and other legal and regulatory obligations. Within 30 days of receipt of your written request, we will provide you with your Personal Data, including the purposes for which it was used and to whom it was disclosed in accordance with your Subject Access Request rights under the applicable

regulation.

What we do

At GoOut4 our goal is to offer you a better way to present and represent yourself while creating the perfect circumstances and occasions to discover new people, new experiences and strengthen your connections with your favorite fashion brands in a flawless and easy journey.

In order to achieve our goals and to provide you better services, we are relying on the data that you share with us. For example, you share with us personal data when you are posting on GoOut4, but also, when you just use the app even though you do not post (e.g. the type of device you are using, the IP address of your device, your geolocation).

Based on the data that you give us when you attend an event, we are able to activate Public Posts and Live Chat. Moreover, your interaction with the app will help us to personalize promotions for you from your favorite brands or brands and products that you might be interested in them.

What We Don't Do

X We DO NOT SELL your personal data!

X We DO NOT PROCESS any 'Special categories' of personal data (sensitive personal data) related to racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data, data concerning health or data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation.

What Personal Data We Process

Basically, we process your personal data from two main sources that share your data with us: you and third parties (e.g. login with Google, Facebook, Twitter etc)

Personal Data You Actively Share With Us

In the GoOut4 application, there aren't mandatory Personal Data that you have to give us, but if you want to get GoOut4's full experience, it's better to share with us some data. For example:

- When you authenticate in GoOut4, we will ask you to give us access to your address book to help you and your friends to connect with each other. You can "Don't allow" us to access your address book, but if you do, we have to upload your data on our servers in order to be able to connect you with your friends. However, we do not share this data with anyone and we do not use this data in other scopes than matching you with your friends.
- When you want to post publicly you have to attend an event and we have to verify that you are at the event location, at the event time. Thus, sharing your location with us is essential.
- When you search for a location and the GoOut4 displays a suggestion, GoOut4 is using Google Places Autocomplete. Therefore, you must acknowledge, agree, and accept to be bound by [Google Privacy Policy](#).
- When you provide some information about you (e.g. name, where you live, occupation), your friends will be able to find you easier.
- Also, that will allow us to activate Live Chat for you.

Personal Data That You Share With Us When You Use GoOut4

When you use GoOut4, you automatically share with us certain data about which services and features you use and how you've used them, and we process these data. These data may include:

- **Usage data.** Your interaction with the
- **Content data**
- **Device data.** When you use our services, your phone share

- **Camera and photos**
- **Location data**
- **Data collected by Cookies and other technologies**
- **Log information**

Your Personal Data Shared With Us by Third Parties

We know you have too many accounts and passwords to keep in mind and we don't want to be another one. However, to access GoOut4, we will ask you to authenticate using your Google or Facebook account. We rely on these third parties that manage your identity to know you are who you say you are.

Also, we might process your personal data provided by other users. For example, a member of your family or a friend uploaded a picture of you, or mentioned you in a post. If and when we process your data provided by these third parties we will inform you.

Use of Cookies and Similar Technology

The GoOut4 site is using cookies. Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Cookies are typically stored on your computer's hard drive. Information collected from cookies is used by us to evaluate the effectiveness of our Site, analyze trends, and administer the Platform. The information collected from cookies allows us to determine such things as which parts of our Site are most visited and difficulties our visitors may experience in accessing our Site. With this knowledge, we can improve the quality of your experience on the Platform by recognizing and delivering more of the most desired features and information, as well as by resolving access difficulties. We also use cookies and/or a technology known as web bugs or clear gifs, which are typically stored in emails to help us confirm your receipt of, and response to, our emails and to provide you with a more personalized experience when using our Site.

We use a third-party service provider(s), to assist us in better understanding the use of our Site. Our service provider(s) will place cookies on the hard drive of your computer and will receive information that we select that will educate us on such things as how visitors navigate around our site, what products are browsed, and general transaction information. Our service provider(s) analyses this information and provides us with aggregate reports. The information and analysis

provided by our service provider(s) will be used to assist us in better understanding our visitors' interests in our Site and how to better serve those interests. The information collected by our service provider(s) may be linked to and combined with information that we collect about you while you are using the Platform. Our service provider(s) is/are contractually restricted from using information they receive from our Site other than to assist us.

How We Use Personal Data

Your information will be used for the following purposes:

- Complying with applicable regulations
- We will process your Personal Data only for the purpose(s) for which it has been provided to us.
- Providing operational information
- Personalize your GoOut4 Services experience
- Analyze GoOut4 website usage, and improve our website and website offerings.
- Help us respond to your customer service requests and support needs.
- Preventing and detecting crime
- Carrying out research and statistical analysis
- The data will not be used to make automated decisions.
- Contact you about GoOut4. The email address you provide may be used to communicate information and updates related to your use of the GoOut4. We may also occasionally communicate company news, updates, promotions, and related information relating to similar products and services provided by GoOut4.
- Promoting our services. Administer a contest, promotion, survey, or other site features as will be more explained on the website.

We do not perform behavioral tracking of a customer's activities on our Website or across different Websites, nor do we allow third-party data collection through our Service.

What Is Our Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

We are processing your personal data because is necessary for:

1. Compliance with a legal obligation such as KYC (Know Your Customer) and AML (Anti-Money Laundry) regulations;
2. The performance of the contract with you;

In addition to the above cases, we are processing your personal data when you consented, in an unequivocal way. For example, we need your free and express consent for promoting our services.

1. If you give your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
2. If you do not give us your consent on a specific case, we will not use your personal data for that specific case.
3. If you withdraw your consent or if you do not consent that will not affect your access to our services.

However, we do not need your consent when processing your personal data is necessary for compliance with legal obligations and for the performance of the contract with you.

Disclosing and Transferring Personal Data

We may disclose your Personal Data to third parties and legal and regulatory authorities, and transfer your Personal Data outside the EEA, as described below.

A. Disclosures to Third Parties

In processing your transactions, we may share some of your Personal Data with third-party service providers who help with our business operations. Your information will not be sold, exchanged, or shared with any third parties without your consent, except to provide GoOut4 or as required by law. By using our Services and accepting our Terms of Use, you consent to the disclosure of your Personal Data as described in this Data Protection Policy.

Non-personally identifiable visitor information may be provided to third parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

GoOut4's third-party service providers are contractually bound to protect and use such information only for the purposes for which it was disclosed, except as otherwise required or permitted by law. We ensure that such third parties will be bound by terms no less protective than those described in this Data Protection Policy, or those we are subject to under applicable data protection laws.

B. Disclosures to Legal Authorities

We may share your Personal Data with law enforcement, data protection authorities, government officials, and other authorities when:

- Compelled by subpoena, court order, or other legal procedure.
- We believe that disclosure is necessary to prevent physical harm or financial loss.
- Disclosure is necessary to report suspected illegal activity.
- Disclosure is necessary to investigate violations of this Data Protection Policy or our Terms of Use.

However, if we have to reveal your personal data, we will inform you when the personal data is first disclosed to the recipient.

C. International Transfer of Personal Data

We store and process your Personal Data in data centers around the world, wherever GoOut4 facilities or service providers are located. As such, we may transfer your Personal Data outside of the EEA. Such transfers are undertaken in accordance with our legal and regulatory obligations. Where such transfers take place from the European Economic Area (EEA) or United Kingdom (UK), they will be in accordance with the GDPR and all relevant Data Protection Laws, including through the execution of standard contractual clauses as approved by the European Commission or the UK international data transfer addendum to the standard contractual clauses, or the UK International Data Transfer Agreement issued by the ICO or Swiss Addendum to the EU Commission Standard Contractual Clauses or where we are entitled to rely on one of the other safeguards permitted by applicable law..

External Websites

Occasionally, the GoOut4 website may provide references or links to other websites ("External Websites"). We do not control these External Websites' third-party sites or any of the content contained therein. You agree that we are in no way responsible or liable for External Websites referenced or linked from the GoOut4 website, including, but not limited to, website content, policies, failures, promotions, products, services or actions, and/or any damages, losses, failures or problems caused by, related to, or arising from those sites.

External Websites have separate and independent privacy policies. We encourage you to review the policies, rules, terms, and regulations of each site that you visit. We seek to protect the integrity of our site and welcome any feedback about External Website information provided on the GoOut4 website.

Security of Personal Data

We use a variety of security measures to ensure the confidentiality of your Personal Data, and to protect your Personal Data from loss, theft, unauthorized access, misuse, alteration, or destruction. These security measures include, but are not limited to:

- Randomly created passwords protect accounts, directories, and databases.
- Encrypted and processed on secure infrastructure
- Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) technology to ensure that your information is fully encrypted and sent across the Internet securely.
- PCI Scanning to actively protect our servers from hackers and other vulnerabilities.
- A very limited number of trained personnel have access to sensitive data

All financially sensitive and/or credit information is transmitted via SSL technology and encrypted in our database. Only authorized GoOut4 personnel are permitted access to your Personal Data, and this personnel is required to treat the information as highly confidential. The security measures will be reviewed regularly in light of new and relevant legal and technical developments.

Retention of Personal Data

We retain Personal Data for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this Data Protection Policy, subject to our own legal and regulatory obligations. In accordance with our record-keeping obligations, we will retain Account and other Personal Data for 7 years after an Account is closed.

Updates to this Data Protection Policy

This Data Protection Policy may be revised, modified, updated, and/or supplemented at any time, without prior notice, at the sole discretion of the GoOut4. When we make changes to this Data Protection Policy, we will notify all users on our website, and make the amended Data Protection Policy available on our website.

How to Make a Complaint

If you are unhappy with the way in which your personal data has been processed you may in the first instance contact the Data Protection Officer (DPO) - email: dpo@ilinmurgu.com

If you remain dissatisfied then you have the right to apply directly to the Supervisory Authority for a decision. If you are based in the UK and you have concerns about our handling of your personal data, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office ("ICO") (www.ico.org.uk), which is the UK's supervisory authority for data protection issues. If you are based in the EU, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority, details of which are on the European Data Protection Board (EDPB) website, depending on the country in which you are based (https://www.edpb.europa.eu/about-edpb/about-edpb/members_en). If you are based in Switzerland, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Federal Data Protection and Information Commissioner (FDPIC)(<https://www.edoeb.admin.ch/en/contact-2>).

Community Rules

Intro

Liv'in both worlds! is our motto because GoOut4 is about living our lives in the real world and in the virtual world at the same time at our highest potential. Unlike traditional online social platforms that alienate us from the real world, GoOut4 allows us to engage in the virtual world in connection with real-time events.

GoOut4 facilitates communications with people we care about, people we admire, brands, and places that we love.

We allow users to contribute different kinds of content, including photos, videos, events, votes, tips, direct messages, reviews, and more.

Our goal in creating these Community Rules is to accommodate the broadest range of self-expression while balancing the need for fellow users to be able to use our services safely and enjoyably.

Here are some important rules and guidelines for using GoOut4:

Adult Content

1. We prohibit accounts that promote or distribute pornographic content;
2. Nudity or Sexually Suggestive Content Involving Minors;
3. Never post, save, or send nude or sexual content involving people under the age of 18 — even of yourself;
4. This includes adding drawings or captions to a post, image, etc. to make it sexual, even as a joke.

Illegal Content

Invasions of Privacy

1. Don't take any pictures of people in private spaces, like someone's home, a bathroom, dressing room, or locker room, without their knowledge and consent
2. If someone is in your posts and asks you to remove them, please do

Threats & Violence

1. Never threaten to harm a person, group of people, or property
2. Don't post dittys of gratuitous violence

Harassment & Bullying

1. We don't tolerate bullying or harassment on GoOut4. Don't forget harassment is what other people feel, not necessarily what you are doing.
2. Don't post with the intention of making someone feel bad. If someone blocks you, it's not okay to contact them from another account.

Impersonation

1. Don't pretend to be someone you're not — including your friends, celebrities, brands, or other organizations.

Hate Speech

1. Don't post content that demeans, defames, or promotes discrimination on the basis of race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability, or veteran status

Terrorism

1. We prohibit content that promotes terrorism

Spam

1. We have zero tolerance for spam

Violations and Sanctions

If you violate these Guidelines, we may:

1. remove the offending content,
2. terminate your account, or
3. notify law enforcement.

If your account is terminated for violating our Terms of Service or these Guidelines, you may not use GoOut4 again.
