2nd CONDITIONAL - GDYBY, mało realne sytuacje w teraźniejszości/przyszłości

IF	kto? co?	Past Simple (II f. / V+ed), (może być też inny czas przeszły)	kto?co?	would/could/might + I f.
If	I	*were you, *was you, *(obydwie formy są poprawne dla 1 i 3 osoby - I, he, she, it)	I	would buy it. could buy it. wouldn't buy it. might buy it.
If	we	won 5 million dollars, had 5 million dollars, found 5 million dollars,	we	would be very happy. could build a palace. wouldn't have to work.

3rd CONDITIONAL - GDYBY, zmienianie przeszłości (nierealne)

IF	kto? co?	Past Perfect Simple, (może być też Past Perf. Cont.)	kto?co?	would / could / might	have	III f.
If	I	had been more careful,	I	wouldn't	have	hit that tree.
				would/could/might	have	avoided that tree.
If	you	hadn't drunk so much,	you	would/could	have	gone home by car yesterday.
