1. Mission: a religious settlement

2. Jose de Galvez: a special, ambitious official of the Spanish king

3. Junipero Serra: Spanish missionary who founded Franciscan missions in California

4.Convert: to change a person's religious beliefs

5.Fermin Lasuen: Priest who doubled the number of Spanish missions in California after the death of Father Serra in 1784.

6.El Camino Real: Spanish for "the royal road," a route that connected each mission

7.Presidios: Spanish forts built to protect the missions

8.Pueblos: towns for farming

9.Frontier: an edge of an area that a group of people have settled

10.Alcalde: the pueblo's most important official, the mayor and the judge

11.Llavera: keeper of the keys, one important job at the missions

12.Adobe: A brick or building material made of clay and straw.

13.Monjerio: a mission building where girls lived apart from their families
