assessment of current and final controls at the department in the discipline "neurosurgery" for students studying in specialties 221 "Dentistry"

Control methods: oral, written, test, practical.

The regulations for the assessment of current and final control of the discipline (developed in accordance with the Regulation "On the procedure for assessing students' knowledge during the current and final control of the discipline at the O.O. Bogomolets State University" dated September 5, 2019)

When organizing training under the credit-transfer system of training, session-module control is used, which provides for the following types of control:

Evaluation system of knowledge students includes current and final control of knowledge .

Initial knowledge control involves determining the initial level of students' knowledge of related disciplines, which is necessary for mastering the discipline the student is studying. The results of the initial knowledge control are not taken into account in the student's current education, as they are only informative for the teacher.

The current control involves a 100% survey of students of the group in a practical session with mandatory evaluation of all components of the session - test control, oral survey, solving situational problems, description of drugs, etc. Each subject of the lesson also involves the control of practical skills.

For each stage of the lesson and element of current control, the student receives a traditional "5-4-3-2" grade, from which the teacher forms an average arithmetic grade for the lesson, which is converted into points according to the scale (distribution) provided by the working curriculum, which was drawn up and approved before the start of studying the discipline. If the student receives a "2", then this grade is converted into 0 points.

The student has the right to improve his knowledge and skills on the topic for which he received an overall grade of "2" and, accordingly, 0 points, during the next

training session, during the current control, according to the department's regulations, without receiving points.

Students have the right to familiarize themselves with the written work checked by the teacher and, in case of disagreement, appeal to the assistant head of academic work at the department, or to the head of the department.

Written academic works, the writing of which is provided for by the curriculum in the discipline, and academic topics that are submitted as independent work outside of classroom time are also subject to evaluation .

The department also calculates additional points for participation and receiving prizes in all-Ukrainian and other academic discipline olympiads. After the lesson, the teacher announces to the students their average grade. The sum of points accumulated by the student as a result of the current study is a component of the overall grade in the discipline according to the types of final control of knowledge.

The maximum number of points for the current study is 80 points.

The current control consists of all points that the student has accumulated during all classroom classes. Missed material from practical classes is processed by the student independently without scoring in accordance with the Regulation "On the procedure for assessing students' knowledge during the current and final control of the discipline at O.O. Bogomolets NMU ". Accordingly, the minimum score for admission to the final discipline control is not established for the current control. Individual work is allocated points from the current control according to the decision of the department.

The procedure for calculating points in the discipline

During the evaluation of mastery of each topic of the module, the student is given grades on a 4-point (traditional) scale and on a multi-point scale using accepted and approved evaluation criteria for the discipline. At the same time, all types of works provided for by methodical development for studying the topic are taken into account. The student must receive a grade in each topic. Estimates given on a traditional scale are converted into points.

Grades given on a traditional scale are converted into points depending on the number of topics in the module. The number of points corresponding to the grade "5"

is calculated by dividing the maximum number of points for the current educational activity, namely 80, by the number of practical classes. To calculate the grade "3", the number of points is calculated, which is 60% of the maximum number of points for the current educational activity, i.e. 48-50 points, which is divided by the number of practical classes.

The weight of each topic within the same module in points should be the same.

Assessment forms for current educational activities should be standardized and include control of theoretical and practical training.

Final score for the current activity is defined as the arithmetic sum of points for each lesson. The head of the department constantly monitors the ongoing training of students in the discipline, paying special attention to students from the risk group (a significant number of "nb", unsatisfactory ratings). At methodical meetings, the department discusses the results of current student training. For students of the risk group, if desired, it is offered in time, in advance, before the final control or after the last one, the possibility of providing in-depth study, in accordance with the procedure for providing educational services at the University.

Final control

Final control involves determining the level of formed knowledge and skills. It is conducted after the completion of the study of the discipline. It includes control of theoretical and practical training. The final control is carried out in the form of a final control.

Students are admitted to the final control of the discipline if they attend at least 75% of classroom classes (lectures, practical classes) with the entire accumulated amount of points during the study of the discipline.

If a student attended less than 75% (missed more than 25% of classes) of classroom classes, he is considered to have failed the curriculum and curriculum of the discipline, and therefore must re-learn the discipline.

Educational classes that were missed by the student for any reason, including due to illness, are mastered by him independently in extra-auditory time according to the department's regulations (by writing an outline of the educational topic, medical history, distance education, consultations, demonstration of practical skills, etc).

Synopsis of the missed topic the student demonstrates to the teacher of the group during the next study session or after the beginning of visits to study sessions, and the teacher of the group makes a mark in the form of the letter "K" in the journal of attendance and success of students in the column of the missed topic, based on the fact that there is a synopsis, without assigning a grade. The presence of a synopsis of the missed lesson is confirmation of the student's completion of the educational program.

The teacher returns the summary of the missed lesson to the student. The teacher of the department maintains a register of notes for missed classes according to the form, which is an appendix to the academic journal and shows the dynamics of students' mastery of missed educational topics. Such Register is subject to weekly control by the head of the department.

The department does not establish a separate schedule indicating the hours for accepting abstracts of missed classes. Students do not make up for missed lectures, at the same time, missed lectures are included in the total number of missed classroom classes in the academic discipline.

Assessment of discipline:

Final control (PC) is a form of final control of identifying the skills and knowledge formed by the student in a separate academic discipline for the entire period of studying the discipline, which is carried out after the end of the study of the discipline in the last class. When assigning a grade for the discipline, the number of points accumulated by the student for the current study (maximum number of points 80) and the result of passing the PC in points (maximum number of points 120) are taken into account. The student completes the PC with the number of points he has accumulated during the current study. The form of PC and the type of tasks are determined by the educational (work) program of the discipline and the department's regulations. Enrollment of credit for the studied discipline is carried out under the condition of accumulation of the total number of points received by the student, which must not be less than the minimum, which is determined by the working training program for the discipline and corresponds to the minimum value of the grade E, and therefore is 111 points.

- Admission to the PC examination on the condition of 75% attendance at classroom classes, including lectures. Admission in terms of points is not established.
- The student's ability to complete a PC in a discipline is not affected by the results of other disciplines.

Procedure for liquidation of academic debt

When receiving an unsatisfactory grade in a discipline within the range of 60-110 points (FX) the student has the right to retake it 2 times: once - by the cathedral commission with the participation of the head. department, and the last time - a commission with the participation of the head of the department and the dean.

Retaking subjects with unsatisfactory grades is carried out according to a schedule drawn up by the department and coordinated with the dean (the interval between attempts or subjects is at least 3 days). The subjects studied in the

corresponding course must be completed before the beginning of the new academic year. The presence of academic debt before the beginning of the new academic year is the basis for expelling a student from the university for failure to fulfill the requirements of the curriculum (or registration of an academic leave and a repeated course of study due to health).

When receiving an unsatisfactory grade in a discipline within the range of 1-59 points (F), the student is obliged to re-study it outside the classroom on a paid basis. Repeated receipt of an unsatisfactory grade by a student based on the result of repeated study taking into account two rescheduling of a discipline or unsatisfactory grades from 3 disciplines, as well as the presence of missed classroom training classes without valid reasons, the sum of which is 120 hours or more, determines his expulsion from the university for non-fulfillment of the curriculum.

The student's ability to pass the final exam in a discipline is not affected by the results of other disciplines.

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
