# Snow removal stage planning

## **Stage 1: Dusting to two centimetres**

- Priority 1 and 2 completed
- Priority 3 finished in 24 hours after snowfall has ceased
- This includes all entrances and sidewalks
- See map

### Stage 2: Two to five cm

- Priority 1 and 2 completed depend on the type of snow
- Priorities 3 through 6 finished in 24 hours after snowfall has ceased
- This includes all entrances and sidewalks
- See map

## Stage 3: Five to 10 cm

- Priority 1 completed
- Priority 2 started same day, finished the next
- Priorities 3 through 6 finished in 48 hours after snowfall has ceased
- This includes entrances on Priority 1 routes
- See map

# Stage 4: 10 to 20 cm

- Priority 1 work in progress, could be multiple days
- Recommend informing University of reduced access to the University
- Includes Priority 1 entrances and sidewalks, stairs to be cleared halfway, to return after snowfall has ceased to complete
- Priorities 2 through 6 finished in 48 to 72 hours after snowfall has ceased
- See map

# Stage 5: 20+ cm

- Priority 1 work in progress, will be multiple days
- Recommended limited access to University in consultation with EOC
- Will provide pathway on Priority 1 entrances and sidewalks; stairs to be cleared to allow access, to return after snow has stopped falling
- Priorities 2 through 6 finished in 72 hours after snowfall has ceased
- See map

# Stage 6: Freezing rain

- Salting is in progress
- Will move through priorities throughout the day
- Could recommend reducing access to University in consultation with EOC

#### Note:

- Continuous snowfall through the day will have snow routes begin back at Priority 1's on the next business day
- Extreme cold and /or extreme weather conditions will delay response times
- Reduced staff or equipment issues will also delay response times

# Our priority list:

\*On Thursday and Fridays, prioritization of secondary entrances and emergency exits vary, depending on the level of snowfall, resources available (including staff) and weather conditions.

### Afternoon shift and weekends

Our goal is clear snow to bare concrete in Priority 1 and 2 depending on the amount of snowfall, Please see stages. We will maintain access as per Priority 1 assignments with continuous snowfall, once snow has stopped then we will start to move through the priority list.

### Priority 1

- Accessible access: Maintain access from stalls to entrances in Lot 1, 2, 4,
  5, 6A, 7. Ramps at EC (2), Residence building B (2), EA building (3),
- Main entrance access: EC building (front), EA building, EB building, East Gate, West Gate, Recreation, Wyckham House, Day Care, Library (West and East entrance), Conservatory stairs and Parkade

### • Priority 2

 T-wing Crossover, T-Wing level 1, back of EC building, Gauthier court, Memorial garden and Secondary entrances and emergency exits
