5. Review 2024-2025 School LAND Trust Plan and Teacher and Student Success Act Plan
TSSA: funds from the state, our district chose the money to be used for instructional coaching, professional development, and a school based initiative. (no voting involved, principal just shares info) For this year's TSSA plan, our goal is to score 92 points on the state accountability measures this academic year. The school leadership team will revise the TSSA plan to update our professional development plans.

Land Trust: tends to be used for personnel for the school and academic improvement. This is the only school improvement plan the council votes on. We reviewed how the money is being spent this year. Alison was interested in how we are communicating our goal for acadience growth. We also discussed why our BTSALP drama classes are not being paid for by Land Trust.
