Firearm Safety Instructional Plan In Compliance with TCA 49-6-1016

In compliance with Tennessee law (TCA 49-6-1016), students in kindergarten through twelfth grades receive firearm safety instruction. The purpose is to prevent accidents with firearms and is not intended to serve as a firearm safety course (such as those provided by TWRA). Our SROs and School Counselors work together to teach students that if they come across a gun, they should 1- stop, 2- don't touch, 3- run away, and 4- tell a grown-up.
