

Previous and upcoming presence in Smart Cities related fairs

Smart City Connect in Washington DC

The [Smart City Connect](#) fair took place September 26-29 in Washington DC.

Main takeaway is that the US market remains still quite underdeveloped. This is not a real surprise, but the event helped to confirm that the situation hasn't progressed that much since the last time we were here, 3-4 years ago. This is probably partly because of the pandemic, during which cities may have to face some concrete challenges, partly because the change in the administration (NIST got big cuts in their budget apparently in what referred to their activities in Smart Cities).

Most of the sessions were structured as panels which were very focused either on a) specific verticals or b) open data (the "traditional" way), in many cases involving a particular vendor and perhaps a representative of the city where the solution of that vendor has been deployed/piloted.

In the exhibition area, most of the booths were linked to a particular vertical application/solution from a vendor. No booths from cities and, very significant, no booths from smart city platform

integrators (with perhaps the exception of our booth run by AWS/RedHat and the booth of NIVID). This reinforced the idea that the concept of smart city system of systems architecture is still not developed in many cities. That means there is a great opportunity, while at the same time there is a lot to do in terms of “evangelization”.

We had a very good conversation with the new responsible of Smart Cities in NIST. It looks like there may be a good opportunity to revamp the collaboration we had years ago.

Smart City Expo Miami

FIWARE will host a cocktail and panel as well as business meetings during the Smart City expo Miami 12-14 December. Smart city leaders from around the world will converge on Miami for the upcoming [Smart City Expo Miami 2022](#). **The theme of the event is “sustainable is the new smart,”** underscoring the importance of acting to ensure future generations have the natural resources available to enjoy an equal

Smart Country Convention

The [Smart Country Convention](#) fair will take place October 18-20 in Berlin. It’s a key event for Smart cities in Germany and now even in all Europe. As Austria is a country partner.

The hosting venue is the innovative space HUB27 at Messe Berlin.

FIWARE will participate in SCCON for the 5th time. First time after COVID event is on site, the last was online only. Event has a hybrid structure with focus on f2f meetings. Framework.

Digital Europe Call: Data space for smart communities (deployment)

A new EU Open Call on [Data Space for Smart Communities \(deployment\)](#) has been launched under the Digital Europe Program.

Deadline is January 24, 2023.

Note that funding is 50%. Companies headquartered outside the EU are not eligible.

FIWARE position papers

Conductor: Pierre Golz / Juanjo Hierro

Status:

We need new volunteers to help pushing the finalization of the existing position papers.

Background info on position paper for Smart Cities:

We aim at creating a first version of a position paper during 1Q2021. There was a [first draft](#) which will work as a starting point.

As a first step, a [mind map](#) was created by Arjen to make sure everything we want to tell in the position paper will be covered. Once completed, a revised ToC will be proposed and circulated for gathering feedback among members of the Domain Committee. Then work on development of the different sections will be assigned to volunteers.

Whenever the paper starts to get good shape, we shall engage the marketing team to get involved in the final process and also plan for dissemination.

Arjen indicates it is important to talk about replication escalation and reuse. Many are still in early phases on a small scale. When the promise of FIWARE is easy to replicate and after 5 or 6 years. Arjen : ". For example there is still not much scaling up of solutions or cross border use of good examples" we need to see more on this on the paper, perhaps we can say more on barriers to tackle there.

Luis indicated that he has seen a lot of replication in Santander and around. He has a different impression in this process. Precisely on the example of HOPU, Medellin also saw what could be done with FIWARE.. He showcased his solution and this helped the city of Medellin. They have applied in terms of nutrition. Luis suggests doing more on the benefits of being part of the city.

Juanjo suggested populating solutions at the marketplace. We are also convincing cities to see

more out of their comfort zone.

For November 8th Juanjo suggests creating a topic on how we do the next step and reaching on adoption of the platform at a lower level. What Arjen suggests is the conversation now not only about the platform, not only on the technology but about the challenges that they have (Urban challenges, applications of scaling up, because if you see how easy it is to put it together, but not only promoting open source he sees is not enough. Juanjo says: Marketplace. Arjen tries to bring something to move forward.
