**Letter for Andry José Hernández Romero, Merwill Gutierrez and others deported without due process.**

**Dear Honorable Justices of the United States Supreme Court,**

I am writing to respectfully urge you to intervene in the case of **Andry José Hernández Romero**, a young man who was **unlawfully deported** despite a federal judge's ruling that should have protected him. His removal defied due process and reflects a dangerous disregard for both the law and human dignity.

Andry was brought to the United States as a child. He graduated high school, contributed to his community, and met all the conditions required to remain while his case was reviewed. But instead of respecting the legal safeguards in place, he was quietly placed on a plane and deported—separated from everything he has known.

This is not an isolated incident. Others, like **Kilmar Abrego García** and **Merwil Gutiérrez and many others** (**please add the other names here**), have also been deported despite legal protections. Each of these cases undermines the trust the American people place in the legal system, and each raises serious constitutional concerns.

This letter is not about politics. It's about precedent, process, and protection under the law. When due process is ignored, when judicial rulings are sidestepped, and when lives are discarded so carelessly—we are not operating under the rule of law. We are operating under something far more dangerous.

Please use your power to investigate this matter and to ensure that no one—regardless of immigration status—is forcibly removed from this country in violation of a court order. And if possible, please help bring Andry and all others wrongly deported without due process back.
