# **Hopekids Huddle Time (20 mins)**

Big Point: Go! I can perform miracles.

God's words: Peter heals a lame beggar (Acts 3:1-9)

Memory verse: Silver or gold I do not have, but what I have I give you. In the name of Jesus

Christ of Nazareth, walk. (Acts 3:6)

Life question: What miracles can God help me perform?

# MATERIALS HIGHLIGHTED IN YELLOW ARE PROVIDED Huddle leaders prepare OWN materials, in BLUE

#### Welcome - 2 mins

<Instruct> Each child to turn to the friend sitting on the left, give the friend a smile, together with a pat on the left shoulder, and say "Hi <insert friend's name>. I'm happy to see you here".Welcome NEW kids/ 2nd time kids, address them by names. Make sure NEW kids collect 10 points (explain to new kids, what the point for). Inform NEW kids that you would like to visit him/ her, take a group photo with NEW kids (DO NOT POST in social media, for internal use ONLY)

### **Huddle Activity 1: Pray for Others - 8 mins**

- Pictures 1- 7 (A5 each or smaller is fine and label 1-5) HERE (1 set/ LG)
- Where's Everybody going booklet → Can borrow from kid/UL.

You know you are all still little, but it doesn't mean you cannot do miracles! In fact, you can do miracles, simply by loving and caring for people and praying for them!

## For example,

Show Picture 1: If mummy is sick with fever, what can you do for her?  $\rightarrow$  Pray for her to be healed!

Show picture 2: If your uncle is not working, what can you pray for him?  $\rightarrow$  For him to find a job.

Show picture 3: If your teacher has sore throat and lost her voice, what can you pray for her?  $\rightarrow$  For her to "magically" get her voice back!

Show picture 4: On the news, you saw that children are separated from their mummies and daddies, what can you pray for? → For families to be re-united

Show picture 5: If your friend is sad, what can you do? → Tell him/her the story of Jesus, that Jesus loves him/her. You can even use your Where's Everybody Going booklet! (Show)

Show picture 6: If on the news, you saw that there is war and many people dying, what can you pray for?  $\rightarrow$  For there to be world peace and for them to know the peace of Jesus

Show picture 7: On the news you saw there are many homeless people, what can you pray for? → For the homeless to be given a home and to receive the peace of Jesus

Let's pray together, shall we?

Dear God, we thank You for the Holy Spirit. We pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to give us power to do miracles in the name of Jesus. If the first Christians can do miracles, let us do them too! To heal the sick, to pray for problems to be solved, the world to have peace, for all people to know Your love! In Jesus name, Amen!

For more mature children (E.g. K2s)  $\rightarrow$  Can challenge to pray for the above situations together :)

E.g. tell them that the pictures are troubles of the world that are really happening.

E.g. Ask who in their families are sick  $\rightarrow$  get them to pray for the sick family member/ needs of the family. :)

# Huddle Activity 2 - 10 minutes - Crown of the Holy Spirit (HERE)

To remind us that we can do miracles because we have the Holy Spirit, we are going to put on a crown of the Holy Spirit! :)

#### Materials needed:

- Construction paper bands (A3 size, red)
- Fire cutouts
- Glue
- Colour pencils

# Instructions:

- 1. Give out fire and dove cutout one each for each kid
- 2. Allow the kids to colour
- 3. Give out drawing block band one for each kid
- 4. Kids to write their name on the construction band
- 5. Paste fire and dove right in the middle of band
- 6. Teacher to help put on kids' head to check size and glue accordingly
