- *Grilled vegetable stack featuring zucchini, squash, eggplant, red pepper, boursin cheese and charred pepper vinaigrette*

While that was already an incredible culinary feat, the night didn't end there. We loved the couple's special touches — the donut wall was so fun! But it was the Cheese Steak Grill everyone was talking about.
