Neo Tokara: Tiered City Structure

A floating, circular cyber-metropolis designed to separate class, power, and protection. Inspired by the wall-based sectors of "Attack on Titan," Neo Tokara is divided into three ring-like tiers — each defined by its wealth, culture, and proximity to AEGIS control.

SKYLINE TIER

Inner City | Tier-1 Zone

Reserved for elite Programmers, high-end streamers, and upper-class civilians. Bright, tranquil, and holographically maintained. Many Data Stream infrastructures are based here.

Sector A: Residential & Spiritual Tech Core

- Miku's Home A high-rise penthouse overlooking the central beacon. Where her transformation began.
- Tokara University The most prestigious academic institution in the region. Known for advanced AI studies, elite Programmer theory, and VR immersion tech.
- Chou-Otaku Plaza A lively district full of figure shops, idol cafes, and cosplay fashion chains.
- Sky Lantern Plaza A peaceful Data Node cemetery where deceased Programmers' emission signatures are memorialized. Quiet and spiritual.

Sector B: Entertainment & Implant Tech

- Club Z A vibrant anime-themed nightclub for elite V-Tubers, performers, and cosplayers. Monarch operatives sometimes appear here incognito.
- VR Arcade A multi-stage mini-game zone with VR battle chambers, puzzle zones, and time-trial simulations.
- Zeta Inpourium A high-end shop selling Zeta Drives (combat-grade Data implants) and Neuro Drives (accessory-grade skill enhancers like earrings, visors, and wrist chips).

Sector C: Neo-Historic District

- Gurren Ramen Classic ramen joint run by a battle-scarred former Programmer. Known for "Debug Fire Ramen."
- Kimono Mayday A traditional kimono shop owned by an eccentric, retired Programmer who insists her kimonos are battle-ready. She crafts EXE-threaded cloth.
- Genryusai Dojo An elite hand-to-hand training hall where field Programmers learn martial emission combat. Some Monarchs once trained here.
- Maihime Herb Shop A quiet EXE-infused herb vendor offering buffs, healing synthesis, and lore insights. Connected to ancient Stream medicine.

MIDLINE TIER

Middle-Class & Cultural Core | Tier-2 Zone

Where the general populace lives and trades. Bustling with V-tuber hopefuls, working-class engineers, mid-rank Programmers, and growing tension between order and decay.

Sector D: Student Sector & Indie Hub

- Akiba Alley A colorful district full of Mangaka, indie V-Tubers, and street EXE vendors. Random flash mobs and AI mascots frequent the alleys.
- Midline Academy A hybrid middle-and-high school mostly populated by low-tier youth. Illegal VR gear and black market Neuro Drives are rumored here. Site of mysterious Data Psychosis events. (NicoMiko's siblings attend this school.)

Sector E: Synthesis & Upgrades District

- Stella's Fusion A reputable EXE alchemist who helps Programmers fuse materials into .EXE Nodes or buff existing gear using raw Data Emission.
- Garcia's Node Shop A friendly node-crafter who offers base-level EXE skills, mods, and skill trees in exchange for gathered data fragments.
- NeoLab Mall Multi-floor tech mall with upgrade terminals, cosmetic shops, and vending machines selling Emission Snacks (combat boosters).

NOKARA (The Streets) - Outer Ring | Tier-3 Zone

Once a thriving residential sector, now a fractured slum where the city's infrastructure leaks Data Emission into corrupted alleys. The Xenoclad thrive here, and Monarch & Razorhiem have carved out zones of influence.

Sector F: Rift Gate & Black Market Strip

- Stream Market A makeshift booth hub where illegal .EXE mods, corrupted skill drives, and one-time Data Emission buffs are sold by roque vendors.
- Xeno Rift Junction A live emission faultline where Tears in Reality frequently open, summoning corrupted VR-life forms or Xenoclad units. Mission hotspot.

Sector G: Dark Tech Territory

- Razorhiem Black Core A fortified underground compound run by DATA, hidden beneath a former EXE refinery. High-level infiltration required.
- Burnstack Alley An industrial zone infested with disguised Monarch sleeper agents posing as food stall vendors and junk dealers. Home of rogue EXE testing.

Sector H: Glitch Zones & Illegal Combat

- Collapse Garden The corrupted ruins of an abandoned AEGIS simulation dome. Now haunted by Data Ghosts and unstable VR flora. Rare node materials can be found here.
- Patchwork Arena A brutal underground EXE combat colosseum where illegal Programmers battle for cash,

clout, and Emission sponsors. Tied to Monarch and local gangs.
