- Wear Sturdy Shoes
- Wear Scout uniform (No sash)
- Money (\$50-80?) for trading post*
- Pen/pencil/Paper
- 1 Bath Towel
- Modest Swimsuit
- Scout handbook
- MESS KIT
- Water Bottle/Canteen

Clothing (think layers)

- Sweatshirt/sweater
- Sun HAT
- 2 PR Pants
- 3 PR Shorts
- Pajamas/sleepwear?
- 2nd Modest Swimsuit?
- 2nd Bath Towel
- Sandals / Flip-Flops for Showers only
- 2nd Pair of Closed-toed shoes or old tennis shoes for the waterfront
- T-shirts (6 days)
- Troop T-Shirt
- Long-sleeve shirt
- Socks (7 days) *
- Underwear (7 days)*

- Jacket/Poncho/ rain gear

Camping gear

- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping pad
- Pillow?
- COT (recommended)

Toiletries

- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Small Towel - washcloth
- Comb - hairbrush
- Shampoo and soap (with soapdish?)
- Deodorant
- Chapstick / lip balm with SPF rating
- Hair Ties
- Other hygiene products

Camp Necessities

- Flashlight/batteries
- Compass
- Small size 8 ft Rope for clothesline
- Watch/timepiece
- Bug spray
- Sunscreen

- 2 Disposable metal hangers (for uniform)
- Personal first aid kit
- Pocket knife
- (Laundry) Bag for dirty clothes

Advancement Items

- Any \$ for extra cost merit badges such as leatherwork, rifle, or archery
- Print-out of WA state hunting regulations if taking Rifle MB

Optional

- Sunglasses
- Camera
- Portable Camp Chair or small folding stool
- Fleece hat for cold mornings
- Swim Goggles?
- Garden Gloves for service project
- Compass
- Merit Badge Pamphlets?
- Small broom?

- + Swimsuits should be modest. One-piece competitive style, or gym style suits or modest two-piece (not bikini-style) are suitable. No speedo suits, tube tops, or other revealing attire.
- + Scouts should plan to carry their own equipment to the campsite- approximately 50 yards.
- + Items in green should be in a small backpack or small day bag- scouts should keep this on their person until finished setting-up camp on Sunday. Scouts take swim test within 2 hours after arriving. The scouts then use their day pack when attending merit badge classes during the week.
- + Pack clean underwear and socks in 1-gallon plastic bags to prevent getting wet/dirty.
- + NO laundry facilities are available for scouts. LABEL gear as best as possible - especially water bottle, day pack, chair, stuff sacks, scout book etc ("JONES, Troop 299G").
- + DO NOT BRING: Ammo, Fixed-Blade Knives, Firearms, fireworks, tobacco, alcohol, slingshots, bow & arrows, portable stereos/speakers, electronic games.
- + There is usually 1 power source are available in camp for chargers (shared amongst all). Phones NOT recommended. No WIFI for Scouts. Scoutmaster sets Mobile Phone Policy.
