ager, agrī, *m.*: field, plot of land

coquō, coquere, cōxī: to cook

dēns, dentis, *m.*: tooth

dīves, dīvitis: rich, wealthy

dō, dare, dedī, datum: to give

duo, duo, dua: two

edō, esse: to eat

emō, emere, ēmī, emptus: to buy, purchase

flagellum, flagellī, *n.*: whip, rod

habeō, habēre, habuī, habitum: to have

hic, haec, hoc: this, these

ille, illa, illud: that, those

iste, ista, istud: that, those (contemptuously)

lepus, leporis, *m.*: hare, rabbit, bunny, peeling skin.

malō, malle, maluī: to prefer (irregular, like *volō* and *nōlō*)

nihil: nothing

niger, nigra, nigrum: black, dark

negō, negāre, negāvī: to deny, (w/ dat.) to refuse/reject

nisi: except, unless, if... not

niveus, nivea, niveum: white, snow-white

nōn: not

nullus, nullūs, *m.*: no one, nobody

nunc: now

oculus, oculī, *m.*: eye

ops, opis, *f.*: assistance, resources, wealth

pauper, pauperis: poor, lowly

peccans: screw up

pōscō, pōscere, popōscī: to demand

puDET: to cause shame for someone, shame (impersonal verb)

quaerō, quaerere, quaesī, quaestus: to seek, ask

quam: than (only when used with forms of *malō* and comparative adjectives)

quī, quae, quid: who, what, which

-que: and (enclitic)

ratio, ratiōnis, *f.*: reason, account

reddō, reddere, redidī, reditum: to give back, return

saltem: at least

scindō, scindere, scidī, scissum: to cut

sed: but

semper: always

sī: if

sum, esse, fuī: to be

suus, sua, suum: his, her, its, their (always looks back at the subject of the sentence)

unus, una, unum: one

videō, vidēre, vīdī, vīsum: to see
