Site Page	Description / Directions	Key to Lock
Home	Describes the purpose / hook of the breakout. Photo of house will take them to a Gale article on Gothic Literature	Lock # 2 = GOTHIC
The Confession	Full text of story in a journal format. There is a link to an article on the deathwatch beetle. The article contains the Latin name for the beetle. Photo of old man links to a Google form about the plot of the story. When answered correctly, they will be asked about the only line the old man says in the story. Answers: mad, hearing, vulture, dismembers, heartbeat	Lock # 4 = <i>rufovillosum</i> Lock # 6 = "Who's there?"
Language!	The three statements are all similes. SIMILES (but in lower case) is the password for the box. They will be asked to make a copy of the plot diagram. When they put each event in the correct order on the diagram, they will use the box colors to open the color lock using the first letter of each color.	Lock # 3 = RBRGYB (Red, Blue, Red, Yellow, Green, Yellow, Blue)
Visual Overview	Page contains an infographic on the story. One section is labeled "The Tell-Tale Heart by the Numbers" These numbers will open a numerical lock.	Lock # 1 71410
Symbols Everywhere	Students will watch a short video about symbolism. Photo is a link to a presentation on symbolism. When completed, they will get a numerical code.	Lock # 5 = 3132
The Locks	Click on the picture to open the Flippity Locks for the breakout. As students work through the breakout, they will come back to the Flippity tab to open the various locks.	

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
