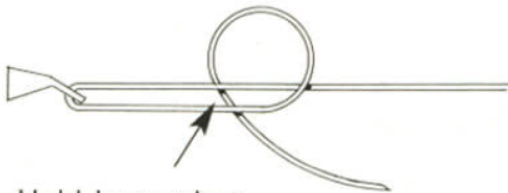


The Fisherman's Knot





GEORGE HARVEY DRY-FLY KNOT



Hold here when
making circles



Hold circles
together



Pull standing end to tighten. The circles
will slide over the hook eye



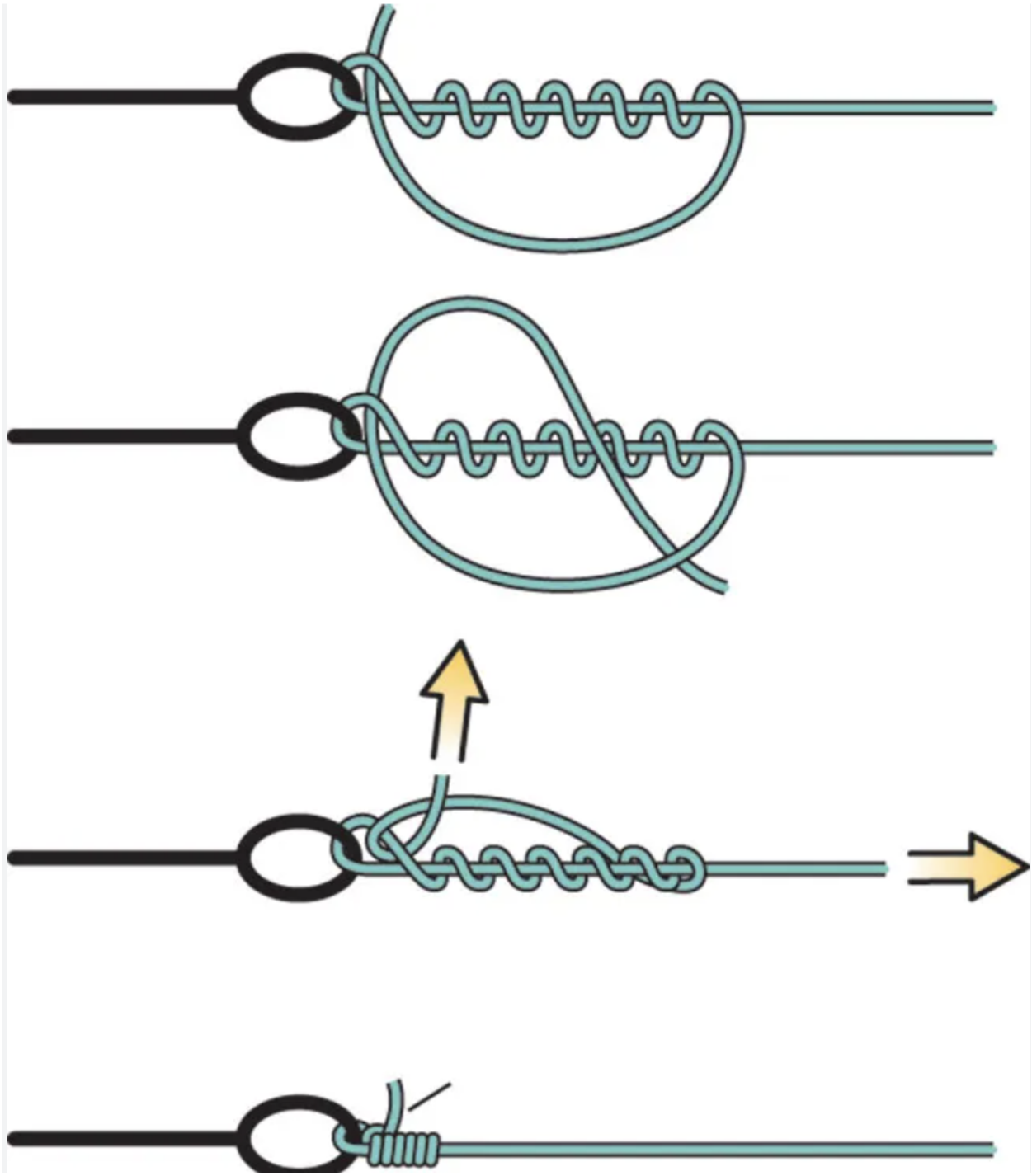
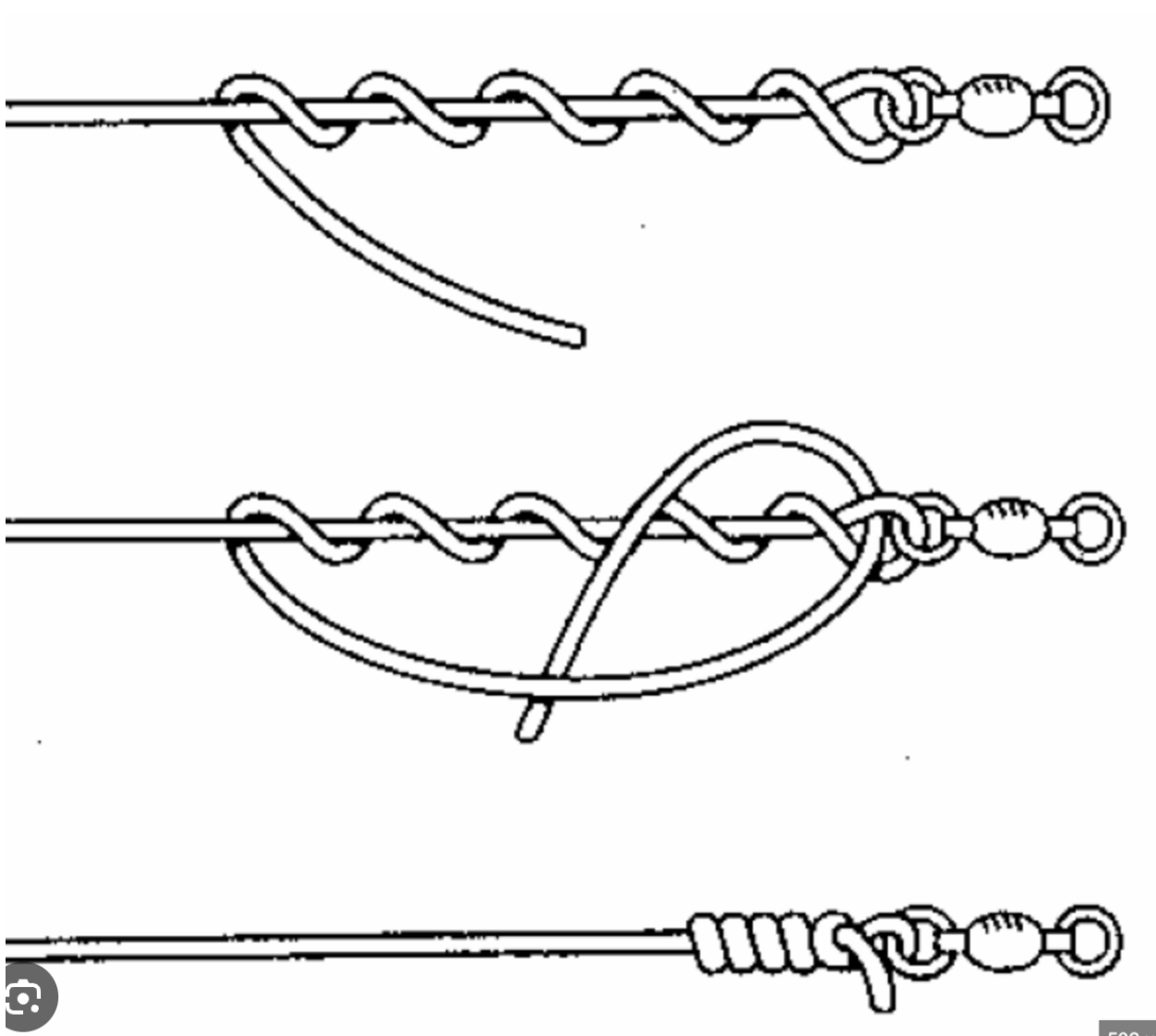
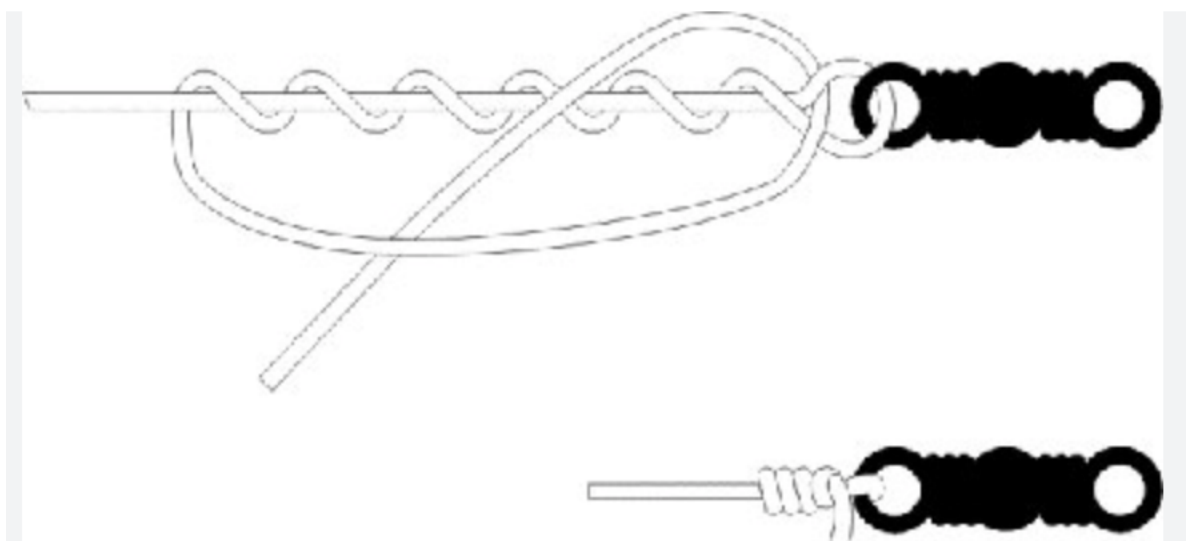


FIGURE 8 KNOT



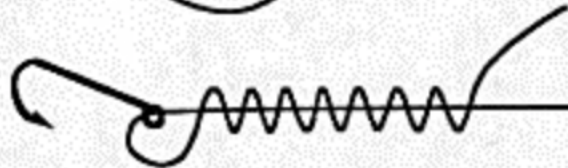


The Clinch Knot

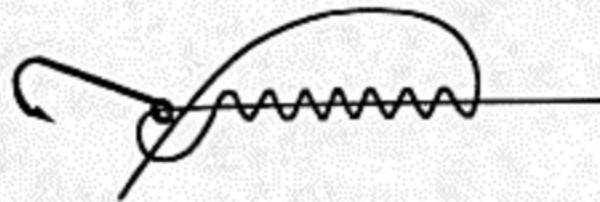
Thread the leader through the eye of the hook



Twist the tag end around the leader 7 times



Thread the tag end back through the opening at the eye of the hook

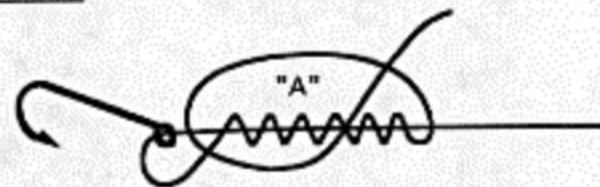


Pull the standing line tight and clip the excess to finish the knot



The Improved Clinch Knot

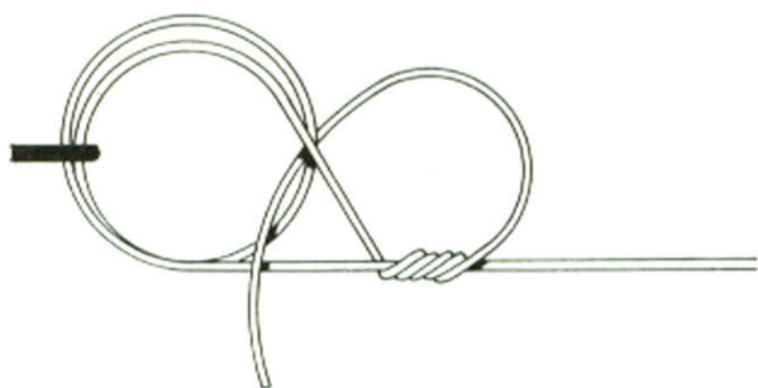
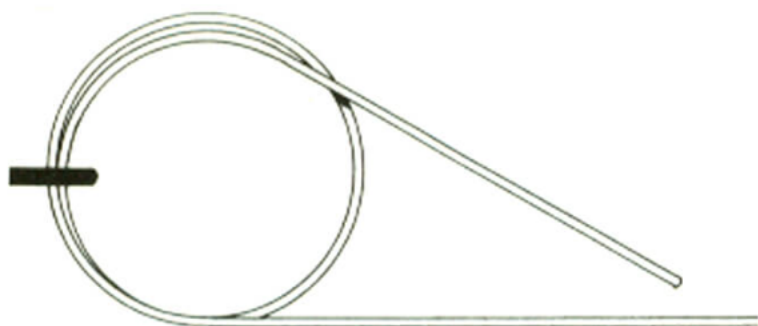
Use 6 turns and bring the tag end back through the large loop opening "A"



Pull the knot tight and clip the excess to finish the knot
