

FAQ

- **When does the season start? And end?**

We usually have a season kick-off luncheon and membership meeting the first Tuesday of May. We typically end our season at the end of September.

- **How do I sign up?**

Complete a registration form and leave it at the Widgi Creek Golf Pro-shop, Attention: WCWGA membership chair. You may also mail or email your form to WCWGA Membership Chair (information above).

- **How much does it cost?**

WCWGA fees are included in the Widgi Pass fees.

If you are a 5 or 7-day member, you will need to pay \$60 for annual dues, payable to WCWGA. Please reach out to the membership chair for more information on how to pay.

- **How do I get information on reserving a tee time for league play?**

Invitations for weekly golf and/or tournaments will be emailed to you weekly using Golf Genius. You will sign up by clicking on the 'Playing' or 'Not Playing' tab.

- **Do I have to be an experienced golfer to join WCWGA?**

We encourage golfers of all levels of experience to join us. If you are new to golf, please reach out to our Membership Chairperson and she will assist in a more in-depth league orientation and help with coordinating a league mentor for your first few rounds.

GOLF GENIUS LIVE SCORING DIRECTIONS

- Open the Golf Genius app.
- Sign in with the GID Code that is printed on the bottom right corner of each scorecard.
- This will bring up a listing of the players in your group. Tap on your name to begin.
- It will then show the hole that you are starting on.
- Enter the gross scores of all players and then click the "Save Scores" button. Note do not put an "X" with a number if someone picks up or does not complete the round. Golf genius interprets any "X" to mean net double bogey max score.
- Golf Genius will go to the next hole. Repeat for all 18 holes.
- After you have entered scores for all 18 holes, Golf Genius will prompt you to bring up the "Scorecard Summary". Use this screen to check each player's scores against the paper scorecard. Make any necessary changes. Once your group has confirmed all scores, click the "Save Scores" button.
- Do NOT post your own score. The League Day Team will post all scores.
