



Job Posting - Volunteer Assistant Coach

2025 Team Ontario - Canada Summer Games

The Ontario Amateur Wrestling Association (OAWA) is the recognized governing body for all styles of wrestling in Ontario, as recognized by the Ontario Ministry of Sport, and serves as the official provincial affiliate of Canada Wrestling Lutte (WCL).

We are looking to hire two Assistant Coaches for the 2025 Canada Summer Games Program: a Men's Team Assistant Coach and a Women's Team Assistant Coach. These are volunteer positions; however, coaches will be reimbursed for reasonable expenses as determined by OAWA.

The Canada Summer Games Assistant Coaches will:

- Work closely with the Canada Summer Games Head Coach, supporting either the men's or women's program.
- Assist through the balance of 2024 and through 2025 with the Ontario High Performance Program, with an emphasis on preparation for the 2025 Canada Summer Games.
- Serve as a Canada Summer Games Assistant Coach for Team Ontario in August 2025, including travel to and attendance throughout the Wrestling portion of the Games (August 18 - 24, 2025), St. John's Newfoundland Collaborate with the Canada Games Coaching Staff assigned to their specific program to develop the program budget, oversee talent identification, guide team selection, and manage final preparations leading up to the Games.
- Consult with the Canada Games Head Coach, Team Manager, Ontario High Performance Manager, as well as OAWA staff and Executive members as required.

Requirements:

- Full NCCP Competition Introduction Certification, including up to date Making Ethical Decisions (MED) evaluation.
- A registered member in good standing with the OAWA as a Coach.
- Ability to meet all OAWA Safe Sport Requirements (Background Check, Respect in Sport Training, Rule of Two knowledge, etc.)
- Proven ability to work well with other coaches in a team environment.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills to facilitate information sharing with athletes, coaches, parents, OAWA staff/executive and Canada Games staff.
- Good organizational skills to be able to plan team events.
- Able to commit significant time to the program from December 1, 2024, to August 31, 2025, including being present at the Games in St. John's Newfoundland (plus travel days).
