National Federation of the Blind (NFB)	In collaboration with the Library of Congress, National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled NFB offers free, remote braille transcribing courses in Literary, Mathematics (Nemeth) and Music
UEB Online	Offered through the Next Sense Institute of Australia this free on-line self-paced course offers courses in UEB Literary and Mathematics
Praxis® Certification only	Certification exams in braille are available through the ETS services for a cost to the examiner.
