This could also be used for a gentle nudge to students about upcoming events, coursework, etc. Remind can also achieve two-way communication so that the families and the students have a secure open line of communication with the staff. Some of the communication mediums that can be utilized are text, call, email, or for more features such as built-in translation, the Remind App. This platform connects directly into PowerSchool to import courses, students, and parent/ guardian contact information to eliminate the burden of staff tracking down all of this information.

It is used in conjunction with Google slides and assists teachers with designing engaging learning experiences and embedding formative assessments into online classrooms, and is designed to integrate with your district's existing tools including both Google or Microsoft applications.</p>
