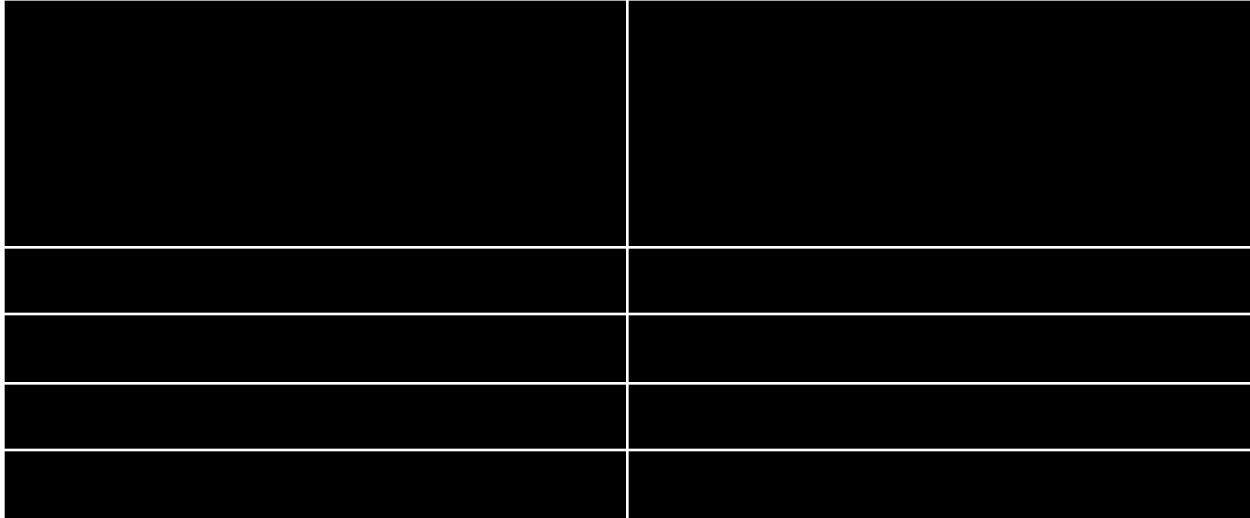

I'm betting that one of the water sisters is getting killed tonight due to this. :P I wonder where the votes on Mist came from, tbh.

*“Ok, so also, I agree with gears that it is in the HI's best interest to accuse a ton of people. For this reason, Mist” - Turtle*

lmao Turtle got Mist's role and alignment already. God tier reads.

Full spoilers I see

Yeah, full spoilers when relevant. I'll probably not throw that much out though.

Also trying to lynch the HI isn't super useful :P

It's actually a pretty good target early on, since it's the only role that's immune from the vote. If you vote for the HI early then you know exactly who the HI is.

Hmm there seems to be quite a lot of inexperience in the thread right now, which has proved to be interesting. Illwei's sorta floundering around xD

Deciphering who the hemalurgists are is proving to be harder than I thought, even with knowing the 6 to choose from. Little things where I'm sure but then someone else says something that's like 'well never mind'

I tried to frame one of these people for being me but it didn't work.

This doc will be more interesting once I have a friend... who will die first and join me here?

On Elk, I personally dislike the idea of using reasoning from a years-old post as grounds for a suspicion.

Holy crap what did I miss today?

Not much, it turns out. :P

Yeah... normal D1 stuff :P

If I were playing this game, I would probably be with Elan in not liking either vote train. Mist because the village really doesn't want to discover the HI early on, it gives like no benefit to them, and Elk because he's done spreadsheets before in both alignments and all other reasoning is based off a five-year-old game where he was an elim- and apparently contradicting that. Wouldn't that mean he'd be village, even if his playstyle didn't change at all in those years? I'd probably vote turtle, if any of the current candidates, for originally voting for their HI suspect.

"Mist because the village really doesn't want to discover the HI early on, it gives like no benefit to them" - Matrim

It does benefit them though?

Hmm I can't really see how... The HI doesn't count for parity, and the sooner the elims know who the HI is the sooner they can reach out/hammer once the Hemalurgists are dead. If the village knows who it is, it doesn't tell them anything except for who not to lynch, and because the HI doesn't know the elims they can't give any tells about them. I think it's more of an elim tell to go looking for the HI, even though turtle defies that.

If Mist is lynched the elims will know who the HI is and can PM her- maybe even group PM her- creating a sort of 'elim doc' in PM form. She can share scan results and figure out who the Hemalurgists are. Then once they're all dead they can hammer Mist and win the game. I view the HI remaining unknown as a far greater village benefit.

1. I think you're underestimating the benefit of the village knowing who the HI is. Even if it's not terribly likely that they'll hit the HI, it's still a huge IKYK for them to deal with later in the game.
2. I think you're also overestimating the value of the HI's scan results, considering how this game is fairly role-light for roles other than Hemalurgist. Fair
3. If they were in a position to hammer the HI, they'd be better off hammering a villager and winning. Hammering the HI if they don't have a majority tells the village exactly who to vote for in the resulting sudden death thing. If they have a majority, they'd just win from their parity win con.

I thought the game ended if the HI dies after the village hemalurgists die?

Nope:

*"One other factor that can affect these two win conditions is the Hemalurgic Intelligence. In addition to not counting towards win conditions, its death will cause an emergency on the ship as many systems shut off. If the HI dies, nights will stop happening, the inactivity filter will stop, and any Loyal Crewmember death will cause the Traitors to win instantly. The Traitors are not allowed to use any kills on the Hemalurgic Intelligence."*

Basically makes it so the village has to consecutively vote out all of the Traitors. So it'd very likely lead to a Traitor win, but if there are very few players or the village has a good idea of who the elims are, there's still a chance that they could win. Yeah okay, for some reason I had it in my head that the Crew was instead the HI in that situation.

## Night One

---

*“SIX???? that's so many.” - Illwei*

Yeah, there are a lot of Hemalurgists in this game. Mainly because the elims have a bit of an advantage on the numbers side, so they have less of an advantage on the HI side. However, the elims just need to take out five Hemalurgists, and the Hemalurgists haven't been all that hard to figure out. Illwei figured out at least one already and she's not even in the doc.

Only one elim in the doc is pretty good.

I guess I should have expected the PM bomb but wow, I was not prepared for that :P SE has shown me the value of PM folders...

Yeah, fortunately this game has actually been fairly PM light. :P

In LG58, I had PMs that had over 200 messages in them, and in LG62, a large portion of the game was conducted in PMs, so it was eleven worse.

Also, it's hilarious how much the Hemalurgists are claiming. Fortunately, they haven't claimed to any elims yet. Yeah they should be more careful about that... Illwei's village then.

Why do I always get lynched at the very end of turns, especially when I'm not online to defend myself? This is like the third or fourth time this has happened... At least I can focus on my Cosmere re-read some more now! That's always good!

And in case you're wondering, no, Elk isn't the HI :P Though he does have a role.

That is almost offensive. Do the elims really think that I wouldn't disguise my identity in an anonymous doc? Honestly. I was practicing my Silber impression just for this occasion. Who are the elims?

Was not expecting those. I probably should have been thinking more about who the elims were.

Fascinating. Interestingly enough, in my PM flurry last night, I didn't message any of them.

I think the Hemalurgist that the elims thought you were is [REDACTED], though I might be wrong.

I want access to all the docs. Will you grant it? Also, ALASTAIR uses it/its pronouns, if you wouldn't mind editing the writeup.

Both of which I'd do, and both of which I can't/shouldn't

*"I somewhat doubt that Gears was killed for hemalurgy suspicion; after mentioning in thread debate activities taking up their time they likely wouldn't have been active enough in the doc for an accurate guess." -H2*

:P Wrong about this apparently.

xD And the elim Hemalurgist still is hanging on the precise language thing... have they not checked the Hemalurgist doc since H5 changed styles?

Why shouldn't you give me access to the docs.

I've edited the writeup. I don't typically give doc access since it confuses the people in the docs when they see people on who they can't talk to. :P

I lament the fact that I have never gotten access to any extra bonus secret things in games with extra bonus secret things. I was a Korathi in that village/half-village/elim game, I wasn't a

Oh Elkanah, your efforts are admirable, as always. I would like to know what you meant by that, so I hope you die soon, if I can say that without implying any animosity between us. 'Twould be an honour to be buried at your side.

I can tell you what he meant by that... and also give it Straw to handle xD

Elkanah said in his GM PM that it was his understanding that Condensation saw Mist in a doc.

I'm not sure how he reached this conclusion, especially considering Mist isn't in a doc :P

Anyway, because of that (and because there are no kandras in this game, as Elk also suggested as a possibility) I'm leaving this over to Straw to decide what to do. Yay!

So

H2 said that they were, at one point (if not now) the rep level of Artifabrian. Only problem is the only Hemalurgists to have reached that are [REDACTED], both of which I have confirmed are not H2 :P So I guess they lied, or misspoke, or something. I'm almost certain H2 is [REDACTED] anyway, and the other questions that H1 asked back and forth support that. That wasn't a lie, I just saw that the people who had that role had much fewer posts than me and assumed it was a lower rank than bloodsealer.

Whysper, Araris, my reads are almost always completely utterly wrong. I am not a good player. Never trust my reads.

I hope I end up elim one of these days. Just another 5 games and I'll [possibly, I don't remember exact quantities] beat the record.[17 is the record] If TJ keeps getting village he'd beat it before you did :P

*"Hey, I may have just forced something illicit and I don't know if you want to do any damage control. Letting it play out is probably the best answer, but my current understanding of things as they are is that Condensation saw Mist in a doc on her computer. I'm really good at forgetting things if that is actually what happened and I will just continue to pursue the things I have seen in the thread.*

*Of course I could be waayyy off and Connie is like a kandra or something and that's why she would tell Turtle that Mist is an HI or something. There could be any number of reasons for what just happened in thread. I just want to check with you that I am not going to break the game if I do anything else." - Elkanah*

Well this is not exactly what I wanted to see this morning. I'm very confused because:

based off turtle-Connie Hemalurgist trust, since they know who each other is in the doc? But yeah. I dunno what you should tell Elk, though...

Dear players, could you please explain your votes in detail at all times and never vote without reasoning? Sincerely, a confused ghost.

What does Condensation think Illwei is? For that matter, what is Illwei? A regular crew :P

Do you know why Illwei and Condensation are at each others' throats? Also, could I have everyone's roles? Thank you very much.

*"I think that Illwei is the HI and they seem suspicious to me." - Condensation*

Okay, so Condensation definitely didn't see Mist's role.

Hmm, no vote manip. I almost used vote manip but decided not to.

Did we just get another tie xD

Sorry Elandera, but I hope turtle survives for the sake of the Hemalurgist doc :P No harm done xD

Wait is it a tie? No, Ash moved off... hmm idk. Ok no tie.

Not close to a tie, it was 4 v 2. I was going off Illwei's vote count (which was wrong) and saw Elk switch from Elan to turtle, which would have made a 3-3 :P

Nah. It's only night two in a rather large game. I doubt they'll be doomed soon, and maybe not at all.

The elim team and Hemalurgists are spoiled above. Are you surprised by the team? [I know they probably won't be doomed for a bit, but the atmosphere is one of doom and gloom. After all, they have been wrong twice in a row because of perfectly reasonable [not in your case] suspicions. That can be awfully demoralising.]

I'm on my phone (dark mode) and it's surprisingly difficult to find what's been spoiled. I'll have to look at it later.

Illwei is the PM Master this game.

PM with everyone in the game, including all possible group configurations? They're in a lot of them, and using info from others to confront other people and so on. They've already figured out half the Hemalurgists, and I think have convinced Connie that they're one as well. It's... lucky for the village they're not an elim :P

On a related note, I 100% know the identities of each Hemalurgist, and my predictions were correct. (My most recent set)

So why is Supreme protecting Illwei? What would that do? Like- if they're doing a WGG, at least target an *elim*. :P My patented wounded buffalo gambit, where you attack and protect a villager to frame them as being evil, or probably the HI in this case.

Ok I understand it a bit more now, but it still makes more sense to me to just kill someone.



Lots of PMs! :P

### Day Three

---

Huzzah! Illwei lives, no kill!

Guess what: the elims put both the kill **and** the protect on him. :P Which I still barely understand (And it looks like Araris requested it to be taken off :P) What can I say, we had a healer, we use the healer. Probably should have killed Illwei here, though.


Re: PM happenings, there's mainly just a lot of info sharing. People are *not* practicing PM safety, but it's actually benefiting the village. Yeah 90% of the PM's are v/v

Does Illwei know that the elims protected them? (By that, do they now trust their protector?)

Illwei doesn't know who protected her, so no. The elim that did should probably claim that they did to get trust, though.

Elkanah claimed Elantrian to somebody, who I forget. I wonder what they think. (Elk is not an Elantrian, btw. He's the Surgebinder who's been sending the messages)

Yeah, I've been confused about what Elkanah's trying to do there.



Gears, I'll infodump you things if it's fine with Straw.

Yeah, sure.

Also, I still can't figure out what the elims were trying to accomplish with the kill and protect on Illwei. I think they said their goal was to make him lose trust with the village, but I don't think that's more valuable than killing him.

I'm actually pretty surprised at how many of those I can (arguably) say I've completed.

I have technically completed a few of them (survival and victory), but I don't count that survival because I singlehandedly lost the game (you probably wouldn't have won anyway?) (I know, let me wallow in despair), and those victories don't count because I died so early that I had no part in it.

How did you become a co-GM? Just ask? If so, I put in a request to be a co-GM some time over winter holidays. I was originally gonna co-GM Straw's MR but there weren't enough players so I ended up playing. But yeah, I just asked. Are you in the GM PM, where they determine who is running the next game?

The winter holidays might not be the best time to co-GM, since that's around when the AG happens.

I am not in the GM PM. Another alternate time would be the Thanksgiving holidays, but that's only a week, so depending on the length of the game, I may be busy with school at the beginning/end.

By claiming, turtle might have saved themselves from the lynch, but they signed their death warrant for the elim kill.

Turtle is *not* good at practicing PM safety :P It's very fortunate she hasn't contacted any elims....

Scratch that, no one is good at practicing PM safety. At least with Illwei.

Windrunner claimed Elantrian to Illwei. This will be interesting.

Funny the kill ends up on Devotary for being a Hemalurgist suspect. Just the wrong Hemalurgist.

Did Araris guess H2 for me? H3 :P

Looks like two Hemalurgists will be going down tonight. The two active ones as well...

Our poor doc.

So we have TJ PMing Whysper saying he's near certain the vote manip was from an elim.

Whysper agrees with him.

## Day Four

---

Two village hemalurgists down, and the two ones that were actually active. :P I bet the elims are pretty happy about that...

Also, clarification: Devotary was elim killed, turtle was killed by a village Mistborn.

Yep.

Was I killed for reasons other than being a hemalurgy suspect? What were the reasons they thought it was me? They thought you were H5, iirc That would fit my sporadic posting activity, but now or soon they'll know that I'm much more willing to participate in a doc than the thread. Who do they think is H2?

Interesting that both Feruchemists claimed to Whysper.

This character lasted a lot longer than the previous one I actually had a story for. Largely stolen from book characters sure, but did have a unique personality. Orchid's a double gold and definitely would have survived a bomb, even one with aluminum shrapnel, so they might show up again in another game. (AraRaash could probably have made a record of the death/"death". He'd see it as poetically morbid.)

Gears, would you want to be added to the GM PM? There's 50 people in it now and I don't remember what the limit is but we could put you in if you wanted.

Let's go Illwei. Yeah those reads are on point.

We'll see how it goes.

Hemalurgist doc is at 33 pages but I think we can beat it by the end of the game unless the other four hemalurgists pick up the slack.

BTW, their specific reason for killing you was because Araris went through past docs and saw that you'd used purple a lot. :P That's why I didn't use purple in the hemalurgist doc.

Condensation killed me I guess. Very interested to hear how Condensation thought Illwei was a hemalurgist when she was repeating misinformation about the doc.

However, later on, Araris said that he thought you were H3.

So two wrong guesses, and yet still hit a correct target.

None of the other hemalurgists have commented on losing two of their number yet. Maybe it will happen now. I guess Araris did think I was H3 or H6.

Looks like Ashbringer might have gotten it?

Why would that have happened? I have no idea.

Now Araris and TJ have commented on the doc. I doubt Whysper will. Connie probably will if she sees it. Also, Araris still thinks you were H3. At some point they'll realize that H1 and H2 aren't responding. Well I'm here. Hello

*"We voted for the same person, why would there have been a cancellation?" - Devotary*

You two tried to move Ventyl's vote, but the other Feruchemist just tried to cancel it.

I assumed a cancellation would beat a transferral.

Nope.

It's probably unnecessary to tell people that moving a vote increases its weight from zero I guess, even though it did cause confusion.

The Mistborn who killed Turtle probably should claim, as they don't have any kills left and being a Mistborn doesn't mean not a hemalurgist.

Araris aggressive distancing with Ash. Looks more like a bus at this point.

Where did everyone go? There were people around D3.

Don't think there's a way to tell when all the village hemalurgists are dead unless the HI dies.

Go Danex! Stand up for your playstyle! Yay!

I personally play more of a Neutral Until Proven Either One, I think. Neutral leaning either way depending on the game/the player/my mood.

I think the big thing against Danex's playstyle is that voting forces connections between players to appear, which benefits the village a lot. Also, I'd say that the burden of every player is to prove that someone else is more guilty than them. Danex hasn't really proved that anyone is more guilty than she is, so she's a valid vote target. Danex additionally seems to be missing that not doing anything can be suspicious in itself. Ex: Danex has provided almost no reads, which is suspicious given that it's D4.

Unrelated sidenote: I would indeed like to be added to the GM PM. I'll put a note in the mod discord. It looks like 50 members is the maximum and I can't remove members.

Danex appears to be arguing semantics. While insisting a burden of proof is necessary may eventually garner some response, it only worsens public opinion of them. They should definitely do things to lessen suspicion of themselves.

Things are getting too personally aggressive here and it's distracting from previous reasoning.

Yeah, I think Danex is annoyed that Illwei and Araris are going after them for what they perceive as logically bad reasoning, and Illwei is annoyed that Danex won't do anything.

Given that Danex's only read is Condensation as elim, this doesn't look that great. Also, I don't think the burden of proof argument is going anywhere.

Danex is also kind of forgetting that the burden of proof goes both ways, and it's up to them to prove that they're village.

Also, I'm kind of surprised that people are just letting Silber coast on so few posts.

I think that happens relatively often. And I'm usually the one who goes after him for it.

Time sensitive murder investigations don't really have room for proof unfortunately.

Hemalurgists are finally starting to figure out their two most active members are dead.

You've been added to the PM Gears.

I thank you.

The discussion was almost going somewhere today before its derailment. I think we still have a good chance of getting an elim today.

If Danex actually was an elim, the "burden of proof" stratagem would actually be a good derailment tactic. Garners some unwanted suspicion, but gets some pressure off teammates. If Danex was an elim, next they should keep pressing the "burden of proof" while giving some reads and helpful information so they look good. Some people(like me) don't really give comprehensive reads lists or analyzable votes, but even one opinion about someone else would be good.

Yes. If only Danex was an elim so this plan would be good for them. Alas, they are merely a villager, a villagante even so they are putting suspicion on themselves for no purpose. Only one vote so far, which is good.

Do you know where ALASTAIR's arc would have gone?

Continued attempts to try and meld with the HI (combined with efforts on my part to find that player Who was your best HI guess at death? Probably actually Mist, though they were only slightly higher than everyone else), Sherlock Holmes hats (because hats are fun), ALASTAIR did have an actual robot body, right? I put that in an RP but I might have been wrong about that.

Yeah they did. They could "leave" it at will to investigate other things though. if I was doing good on analysis, some success on the investigation, if not, lamenting the poor programming, if it lived, deviation from primary objective, if died, lots of lamenting. Hopefully deviation from primary objective wouldn't involve losing any original sense of morality. Well, I do need some way to imply an elim claim next game. But probably not, just less of an obsession with solving murder mysteries and going into recursive loops. Does that mean ALASTAIR is coming back? I might do a "reconstructed from backups" plotline, but probably not, even though I really liked it. If we do another future scifi game, maybe. Advanced AI does indeed limit the time period availability. Especially since Brandon said no backwards time travel. (Faleast says hi) Maybe I could do proto-ALASTAIR. Do you think Aons could be used as code? Aons can probably do a

lot of things since they can be chained together. I personally highly doubt any reasonable person's ability to draw aon chains in the air without stencil equivalents, but Elantris takes place pretty early in the timeline and they could probably develop some kind of mechanized process. The location dependency would become the limiting factor at that point. Identity/connection storage a la era 2 translation metalminds could probably fix that. I could do proto-ALASTAIR in an Elantris game, or I could do it in a Scadrial game with some stored Connection to Elantris. Or maybe I could do some hand-wavey excuse that means ALASTAIR can go anywhere. Just make ALASTAIR like Faleast, since backups exist so it would never be fully deceased. Is Faleast not specific bones? (I mean make ALASTAIR a recurring character.) I'm considering making Orchid a recurring character, but also feel like I've exhausted most of the interesting things.

Awakener/gold compounder who travels around to paint conflicts and violence without actually bothering to help people could get some recurrence I guess. Make them go through a crisis of faith/morality and try being a good person for a bit? I could do that. They've lived long enough to not really care about individual lives, but probably there's some point where they'd intervene. Make them a speculative future buff and know that this specific group of characters must survive? "The Ghostbloods must beat the Diagrammists here so the future will survive!" Or perhaps indulge in murder should I roll elim. Orchid hasn't actually bothered to murder many people since Catholan. Exactly! Perfect plot. Maybe you'll also get to be evil one of these days. Maybe... We have one more MR and then I think we'll go right to the AG after this game ends. Maybe one more LG. Alright then. What are AGs like? Significantly higher player count than a normal game. The player cap gets filled very quickly so you'll want to sign up immediately if you want to play. I look forward to it. Are they typically anonymous or is that just a coincidence? The last game was anonymous on purpose because a lot of hiatus players came back and anonymity hid that fact, so I'd assume this AG will also be anonymous. Chances are good it will also have the standard AG ruleset, but I'm not involved with planning. I've always wanted to play an anonymous game. A perfect opportunity to get out of strategies that have inexplicably trapped me. You'll avoid claiming elim to hide your identity and coincidentally end up being an elim for the first time. The elims have still always won after pulling out an impressive lone elim win last year, so there's a lot of (fake) pressure on whoever ends up being evil. One can only hope. I sincerely hope that I am moderately alright as elim, but who knows? You should be fine unless people find it suspicious that you aren't elim killed within the first couple cycles. At this point an elim team would avoid killing you early, so you should be able to get out of this and it's irrelevant anyway in an anonymous game. I hope we have the drawn versions of the anonymous animals by the time the AG goes up. Wonderful. One moment, the new QF cycle was posted and I have a statement to post.

It's kind of funny and sad how much the Hemalurgist doc activity has plummeted.

I know Condensation can talk a lot more in the doc if she wanted to, and since she's claimed in thread there's no reason to hide her identity.

People should talk when they have no fear of being revealed.

Hmm, Books/Ash vote. Good job village!

Looks like it may lead to people clearing Books though.

*"My reasoning isn't good on Ash, and people hopped on anyways.*

*The reasoning isn't very good on Books either, and people hopped on that!" - Illwei*

Oh no is Illwei going to go for the last minute vote swing?

*"Mist is still a possible HI." - Ashbringer*

It's legitimately so funny and weird how everyone has been able to nail Mist as HI

---

*Faleast was An Impostor. (Again) How many Impostors remain? I see Lifeless captain made it into canon. Yup, and apparently Faleast is now a space terrorist. He also essentially swallowed a bucket of Cadmium Medallions before his stunt, so he'll be back as usual.*

... yup. Thanks for that... at least I wasn't a Diagrammist in Elk's game. That would have been slightly insane.

Oh - since I can talk know... sorry for killing you Gears. TJ hit it on the head, we thought one of the Hemalurgists was you thanks to their formal speak. Do you know why TJ hit the nail on the head? xD Apparently, yes... hopefully the Elims pay attention to me saying TJ was very very Village. I had no real idea on the remaining Hemalurgists, but Whysper's on the kill docket eventually. TJ and Whysper are the only unknown village hemalurgists left. Yeah, but Araris wants Whysper dead for being a scary analyzer...

... is this doc spoiled? I'm going on a no from seeing Books grouped with me and Mist apparently... actually being the HI? It's not really spoiled :P

Yeah, not really spoiled. There's an infodump that's spoiled but if I have some spoilery comment I don't put it in spoiler text. Gears and I have read all the spoilers and right now we're the ones saying things.

What's really funny is that this would still be very similar if he *did* switch to Books. :P

That's why I didn't fight it as much. There's two Elims voting on me and I'm hoping someone can swing suspicion towards Lotus's vote. We'll see what happens.

And yeah Ash, Mist is the HI. She'll probably be more relevant when more Hemalurgists die and the player pool decreases. The only PMing at night makes it difficult to get in contact with doomed elims.

Also, I have gotten 8 upvotes in as many minutes... that only happens on Sanderson Memes... I should have written something for Orchid but I was lazy and didn't actually expect to die. If you want, AraRaash could retroactively document Orchid's death/"death". I feel like that's something he'd do. Morbidly poetic. It's only fair since Orchid noted everyone else's death. That's the idea xD Technically Orchid and Faleast could have interacted in the past however many centuries, but I already said that wasn't the case. They didn't know what two lives stuffed in the same body meant, and I don't know if that's how Faleast/AraRaash would register to life sense. Hmm. Chaotic would be my best guess. Faleast's a Cognitive Shadow, so he's not technically alive. AraRaash is, but their combined souls are a mess even without the several extra spikes they have. Orchid only has the one spike. What spikes do they have beyond the blessing ones, F-gold, A-nicrosil, and F-duralumin? It's not F-Duralumin, it's just Duralumin. And I think the current total is 2 as the Faleast Blessing / Blessing of Identity, 1 A-Nicrosil, 2 F-Gold, and thematically 4 giving Fjordish Connection. Plus AraRaash's original Blessing of Potency, but he doesn't use that as much. So currently 9 spikes... which is 2 short of an Inquisitor.

NO! NO DANEX! Books must survive!

Or we could go Books suspicious and Araris suspicious.

I'm kind of curious if Danex will use his kill tonight.

I'm guessing not.

Didn't the Elantrian already claim to Illwei?

I believe so. I think so.

Sidenote: I might make ALASTAIR a recurring character. Option 1: Backups/proto versions.

Option 2: Cognitive Shadow using an empty body. Option 3: No excuse at all. Any of those could work. I like Option 1

Are people actually roleclaiming to Illwei? Yes. TJ did. As hemalurgist+feruchemist? Hopefully that stops him from being voted for. Yeah, both. Araris fended her off. I think someone else might have that I'm forgetting, but maybe not. Mist was considering, actually. Lying or actually claiming HI? I dunno. In their PM she said she had been considering claiming. She hasn't said anything yet.

Oh yeah, it's all coming together...

Soon we'll all have permanent characters and we all just RP as... I don't even know. "Oh, hi again! How's your face?" How many people have permanent characters in this game? Let's see. We have Faleast, Fade, Lafay Etteax, Locke Tekiel at one point, Philico is watching from... somewhere. Sunwalker is there too. All of Silber's characters have been related I think. They're all 'Lord Silberfarben' but he never RPs so it counts less. I don't think I've had a character appear more than twice.

I'm not sure what about Illwei thinking Araris is a Hemalurgist makes her one as well :P How did she guess hemalurgist! Araris? Well technically Illwei PMd almost everyone saying she thought they were a Hemalurgist, but Araris doesn't know that. That seems like a suspicious thing to do. Why wouldn't Araris know that, were the other elims not messaged? Now that I think about it, no. She only messaged Araris a few hours ago. Supreme had PMd her claiming the Elantrian who saved her, and the others just... not. Silb has barely been around, but Books should become more important now. On that note, when does Silb get replaced? At the end of the night, right? No, last post was D3 so end of D5. Maybe she accused Ash, but he didn't say anything about it in the doc. Anyway, that's the line of thinking Araris went with in the elim doc. Illwei dying wouldn't lose a hemalurgist, but would be unhelpful in other ways. Illwei knows basically everything, so yeah. Everything as in roles, not alignment...

Araris thinks that either Whysper or TJ could be the HI... oh dear. I don't think anyone seriously suspects Mist.

Less accurate suspicions so far this cycle.

Just... *why* is Araris not even *considering* that Devotary was H2? Like- not even a little bit. I guess it could be good for the elims that they are thinking Mist is H2. They could discover their teammate. I guess the others could too, though.

Cycle 5 for Silberfarben right on schedule.

Hey all. Aman here. Sorry I went inactive this past week. Internet went out while my fiance was away visiting family, and I don't have phone data here :(

I'm fairly surprised I was the kill choice last night. I suspect Araris was a factor in that.

Yeah, Araris thought you were a Hemalurgist and pushed for your kill.

Araris is making me nervous...

As a dead Elim, would it be illegal sabotage to upvote Illwei's post that says "If you're the Elantrian that saved me, upvote this post?" Because I really want to. I mean, Supreme kinda already claimed to Illwei :P

... actually, what are the rules on doing that in any case? Using upvotes as communications? I'm pretty sure you aren't allowed to do that, even if most people can't tell who upvoted their posts.

Yeah, I personally don't really upvote posts if I'm dead/spec/GM unless it's RP or something. I'll then just go back after the game and upvote stuff.

Gotcha. I'll upvote if I find something funny when dead - I think one game I upvoted every post in a cycle after I died... or something...

Early role claim from Danex, and it's provable as well!

Way too early in the cycle to claim, but not too bad for a roleclaim since the elims can't stop it. Although that's bad since the most likely target at this point is TJ. Killing Books today would be the ideal, as that would help TJ's case.

Yeah, Danex is kind of tunneled on TJ.

Yep, Books kill would be good.

Hmm, does Illwei know TJ's role? If so, she could let Danex know. Might not change her mind though.

Whysper knows the Feruchemist part at least.

Yeah, TJ has fully claimed to Illwei and Whysper. Condensation knows that they're a Hemalurgist, but not anything else.

I was bored tonight, so I read the entire elim doc from MR42, which was my first game. You know, the one that's like 115 pages?...

I skimmed a *little* bit, but... yeah.

What's the page count on this game's elim doc? Seventeen :P

Looks like Lotus is going to die.

Hello everyone. You know, if you are already in the cognitive realm, what happens when you die? That... is a very good question. Hmm... Faleast would probably know. Why don't you ask him, then? :P I said probably xD technically he hasn't died twice Likely someone who died in the CR would go Beyond.

TJ claimed fast. We'll see how Danex reacts to that... A pretty reasonable place to make a claim though. Avoiding the elim kill means nothing if you die to a Mistborn.

Well, he claimed Feruchemist. No Hemalurgist claim yet. I'm curious if he'll PM Danex about that, or if someone else will. I don't think TJ trusts Danex enough to do that. Yeah, I was thinking more that someone else he's claimed to might tell Danex, in an attempt to save him.

Hmm...

I really like playing Sunwalker. I should put who he is in my signature. (:

I'm still somewhat surprised that Condensation hasn't died to the elim kill. Araris seems content to target other suspects. I still don't know why he hasn't figured out Devotary was H2. TJ specifically said it was me in the doc, although he didn't actually know for sure.

He might be hitting TJ tonight for the Feruchemist half. Or maybe he'll assume Danex will. Maybe. If he does, Illwei's probably dying tonight. It's kind of funny - we all decided that Whysper and TJ were important kills because they were playing very village, not because they were Hemalurgists. They still have no idea xD Araris now said in the elim doc that he doubts Danex will kill TJ now, so he isn't going to rely on that.

Straw, Danex has a question for you in his PM :P I answered one but didn't want to take a stab at the other. Ooh, secret things. He asked if his kill was used up if it was roleblocked :P Often one use abilities aren't used up to roleblocks I believe. They are in this case (Which of course can only happen through his target being healed, because there are no Awakeners.) We really could have stood to have Awakened the corpses as Lifeless. Do people think it would be possible to order a Lifeless to obey any commands following a secondary code phrase? Why not just a normal code phrase? It could be feasible but might need more breath The idea is that you have a master code phrase that you use for standing orders like 'don't kill me' and 'don't steer the ship into the sun' and 'obey commands given with the secondary phrase' and then have a secondary code phrase for everyday tasks as they come up. Hmm, that way if someone learned the secondary phrase they couldn't alter the standing orders. I made up that Orchid could do this and it seems potentially workable depending on how 'smart'/receptive Lifeless are. That could be useful.

1. Hopes he can be useful
2. Avoiding filter, won't post until later
3. Won't contribute until cycle five
4. Can't contribute

Kind of surprised people haven't been calling him out. No one is because he does that in literally 95% of the games he plays in :P I'm pretty sure you're not the only annoyed GM.

I honestly forgot he was there

No kill from Danex so far.

Also, pretty much no PMs still. Weird.

Still not sure what Araris is going at with the list of players with over 10 games.

No kill from Danex tonight.

Windrunner *is* a surgebinder haha. I love how everyone missed his roleclaim D1. :P. Claiming Windrunner isn't quite the same thing, but it's close. Eh, Windrunner is a surgebinder :P. I was unsure about him though after Elk claimed to me, but now I see there were three surgebinders lol.

I think Elims are going to win this one. People got off of Mist, People softcleared Books, supreme and Silber are overlooked.

Yeah I'm kinda proud how much chaos getting killed has caused the village. First Lotus falls, Danex and TJ are attacking each other, Books is softclear, Silber is Silber.

Haha I was going to point out my suspicion of Silber, because he seems to be posting right when he would be replaced by inactivity filter, but the more I thought about it, if there was a replacement then the Elims would probably want him replaced possible. Or not. Idk. Maybe I should trust by gut more and my brain less.

Speaking of inactivity filters... four people are on the docket, including Books.

I think that if books gets filtered off then the Village stands a better chance...unless...They go after...tj for some reason...and as long...as the other people come back...oh right. Are there replacements?

Well, they should be replaced and not killed, but scrounging up 4 people may be difficult. I know we have one :P Hentient hasn't checked in, so they're potentially a second. I'd also look into the people who joined SE since this popped up, either in QF 48 or MR 46.

Man I really wished I just posted it. Did I not post anything? Nothing about how Araris trying to get us to assume it's all inexperienced players makes little sense? I really thought I posted something. It happens to be mostly inexperienced players but there wasn't necessarily a reason to believe that. Which is why I was confused that Araris seemed to be pushing that :p.

Okay I know that this is what I wanted to create but why is everyone so confused that I'm female?

The main thing is probably that you had a "male" profile pic, if I'm remembering your last one correctly.

Someone might have also assumed you were male and referred to you as male, and then other people just assumed they were correct.

I mean that definitely did happen :P. Ah i guess the profile pic...makes sense...it was just a ..well, it was *supposed* to be a monkey in a hat and tie :P. Whysper being confused based on my profile pic doesn't make sense though :P.

There's also the fact that you can just get a random feeling of gender from someone. :P

Are you usually right about this?

IDK, it's hard to say since I mostly remember the times when I had someone as the opposite gender in my head. Whereas if it's the same then I don't really remember.

Yeah, I definitely read XP as female at first, but that's because for some reason I read informality as female... interesting. I think it's also due to the fact you didn't correct anyone :P

Killing a villager at night is not suspicious.

Eh danex thinks it is because sraris set that up, no? I think Araris is saying that it's suspicious to claim Mistborn and then not kill anyone despite having suspects.

I love how the whole elim team is attacking danex lol

Going after the known hemalurgist is risky. Meant Feruchemist, but similar.

TJ is getting bandwagoned right now. Not exactly the best way to end the first half of the day.

Village/elim/HI numbers are currently 8/4/1.

So just two incorrect votes for an elim win vs four correct votes for a village win (with Danex's vig shot possibly helping).

Danex's shot can only really help the village ATM, since even if it hit a villager it wouldn't change when the elims win.

Ex:

D7: 6 - 4 - 1 (no shot)

N8: 5 - 4 - 1 (vote on village)

D8: 4 - 4 - 1 (no shot) (elims win)

vs

D7: 5 - 4 - 1 (shot)

N8: 4 - 4 - 1 (vote on village) (elims win)

Since the village can't really do anything to stop an elim kill, the days are the only thing that matters to look at, and either way the village gets the same number of day turns.

*"I'm really sorry everyone, I won't be able to post on here very often, because life. I'm putting my vote on Shade. The vote getting moved off of them last day just makes them even more suspicious."* - Experience

Why would the vote being moved make TJ more suspicious? The vote was between him and another player, and he'd want the other person to die instead of him regardless of alignment.

If Araris dies the elim team wins easily with all this bussing.

Araris fishing in the hem doc.

TJ thinking araris isn't pushing him like - araris is too busy bussing the elim team like usual

I like how Whysper off-handedly mentions the entire elim team (except Araris) in a single line.

Araris be doing a good job then :P

Voting XP though, so we'll be losing a villager.

## Night Six

---

Too late for your favorite color Experience.

Let's see if Danex can hit an elim tonight.

*"COUGHCOUGH*

*12 alive and we have only killed one elim*

*is this when i start analyzing?*

*nothing to analyze yet though"* - Silber

Did he really just say that? Like AHAhauHAhKFJHKASDJhfKAH

I just came here to post that. Someone had better get him on that. I honestly can't believe how much Silber has been able to get away with so far. Silber often gets away with a lot.

As I outlined above, it doesn't really matter that much if it hits village. TJ would be pretty bad though, but a TJ mskill might be worth it if it saved Danex from getting voted out.

I was getting a bad gut from Silber but he never posts, so there's not a lot of reason to suspect him. I was almost about to try and get Silber killed instead of Lotus because the main reason was low posting suspicion. Man. no point kicking myself now though. :P

Eep that first Silber post is so suspicious

xD Danex submitted a kill on Mist

Not the best choice but it might narrow down the elim list without killing a villager. Won't look any different from Voidbringer/Elantrian though.

On Mist? Wow, this is.. Interesting. Can someone tell me who H4 is in the hemalurgist doc, if anyone knows?

H4 is Araris.

Will a Mist kill say they were the HI?

No, kills aren't distinguished. It will just be blocked, so it'll appear the exact same as the kill attempt on Illwei.

Danex and Mist targeting each other is interesting. Bit of a waste from Mist though, considering as waiting would confirm if Danex was a Mistborn. One might even say it was a mist opportunity. Confirms non-hemalurgist at least.

Hmm, not a mist opportunity. :P She has switched to Books. He's(They're) just a regular though. Was there no elim kill? I need to double check.

Yep, RIP elims.

Araris should have been around and Silber posted, but I guess there wasn't good enough doc communication.

## Day Seven

---

Still 7-4-1 then?

Yep.

No new inhabitants for the doc unless Experience shows up. Are we still beating the elim doc?

Yeah, they're at 19 pages right now. Silber, Books, and Windrunner Supreme aren't the most loquacious of Elims. Hemalurgist doc still has the most pages, though it's growth hasn't been very rapid.

Books tried to put the kill on TJ through the Doc... :/ I was wondering what had happened :P Apparently I need to catch up on the docs.

Well, I am happy that I figured out Araris. Didn't even think of shade as a hem though.

Voidbringer probably should have claimed because it's only one use. Eventually, people will stop waiting for an Awakener to claim, and probably look at the inactives for not submitting a kill.

That or they'll kill Danex.

Does mist have a do not lie moral code or something? Or to get people to trust her always for somereason?

It seems like it. Would there have been any repercussions if she had just claimed voidbringer? Because that was one of the most sus things I've seen in SE. Because this seems like the most suspicious thing she could have done.

Sort of unrelated, but that wolfia bot on discord? I've caught Mist as the wolf multiple times just by asking 'are you the wolf?' :)

(Whaaaat)\

I- the fact that araris seems like hes actually going to succeed in getting ppl to waste a cycle on voting mist???. Shes an "elim voidbringer" ??? How is that the most likely option lol.

Yeeahhh I dunno. What happened seems so obvious to me... Araris said last cycle he suspected Books, Silber, Lotus, and Supreme, and this cycle said completely different things after basically nothing has changed. People should be more suspicious of him. And stop giving him slack for the Ash lynch. Araris is definitely known to bus teammates to an extreme. :P

Burnt and Connie see to have become sort of suspicious of Araris, which is good (I think). Hey we're close to beating the hemalurgists in number of pages! Also, what would happen if someone straight up asked mistm 'are you the HI?'

I think she wouldnt admit to it but not explicitly dent it.

Also, can the elims attack themselves??? Because in what world does it ever make sense that danex is an elim and used the elim kill, and mist is an elim voidbringer

There are so many holes here i hate being dead :P

Just saw whyspers post and was hoping she was going to point out things. Why do people think that wasting a kill on mist is a good idea? Thats basically throwing the game??? (okay, not really, but still...) i would be extremely suspicious of whysper rn if i was alive

Cmon connie lets go lets get them to see that killing mist is a terrible move

If i was alive i would be suspicious of everyone wanting a mist kill, because info killa are only good imo d1 or 2, and especially not this late.

Same, and there was already a conversation about how bad an idea it is to lynch the HI.

Yeah, which everyone agreed on.

Mist is also essentially unkillable since the village pretty much can't lose three village hemalurgists before the game ends.

You also have to think about that the elims know that Mist is probably the HI better than everyone, and they'd be more willing to waste a daykill. Then uh i lost my thought...uh...right pushing this whole elim voidbringer os a wierd thing, and for people wondering why mist is acting sus? If you were an elim voidbringer you would claim vil and just the fact that Mist is seemingly wanting to appear sus to waste a cycle should be enough.

Yeah, wasting a lynch is also good for the elims, right? Because, no one dies?

Yeah, no info and no chance in an elim dying. I think when it gets closer to the end no kill is good, when it's in the beginning kills are good because they're basically all low info.

Any thoughts on vapors reads?

I don't understand at all how she got them but I'm glad she's getting more comfortable posting.

How new is she? Is this her first game?

No. Not sure when she started, i could look it up.

QF 45 according to the stat sheet.

Shes just usually mostly inactive, didnt really post reads before, mostly filler stuff

huh. And who might be the other person here?

Is there a third person on the doc?

Yeah, there is.

Im on mobile i cant see those things :P

Also, on mobile you can click the three dots, I think it works on phones too.

Three...dots?

Top left, next to the comment button. (I think, I have an iPad.)

Aaaaah i see it. Yes. I can technology. :P

I mean... I'm not really good at it either, I just happen to like clicking random stuff.

Okay this is the vapor 11th game.

It feels weird to be called 'he' to me, but for some reason online I'm more used to being called 'they' than anything else.

Personally I try to use they when talking about ppl

i dont know, so yeah. I mean, I sometimes just assign people genders :P i know straw a bit ago said something similar. I definitely got a female feel off of devotary, araris, and xp at first :P.

~~Initially thought male on all of those~~

I just try to say they unless I'm sure, but by accident I say he or she sometimes. (On a completely unrelated note I feel like no one says they in among us.)

Haha in my experience people use colors in place of pronouns :P

Some people assume gender based on color, which I find ridiculous.

Haha. I mean, maybe xp picking pink text is a reason i saw him as female, but i think it was his speech mostly. Of course the colors could be...unconscious bias? \*struggles to apply things from psychology class to real life\*

I feel like this is what happens in every doc I go in. In the hemalurgist doc we had a conversation about dancing awakened skeletons, who sadly was not canonized and now I'm having one about assuming gender and colors. I have to go because I need lunch.

Haha oki. Its almost 10 where i am lol.

Its 12:30 for me. Bye! (Oh my gosh I hate spelling)

Iiiiiii'mmmmmmmmm back! Horah! Connie, defend yourself!

Interesting that Mist would claim when the EoD vote count does not have her getting voted out.

Matrim is now going to get to experience the Burnt PMing phenomenon. Severity will likely depend on how many people are willing to talk. :P And I thought Illwei PM'd a lot :P  
Whats going on in the elim doc? This is... interesting.

*“Mist is definitely the HI.” - Books*

Well yes :P

For the best that Mist was hit again, otherwise killing TJ would have brought the elims to voting parity by D8. TJ's probably going to die anyway.

I assume the elims reached out to Mist?

Haha Mist claimed lol I didn't see that before.

Hm. If TJ doesn't die tonight, then I assume Araris is going to try and turn him using vote manip onto Mist as proof that Vapor is an Elim? Do the Elims know that he is a hemalurgist?

So I've been thinking more, and what was the point of the Elims protecting me? To make the village think I was HI? To see if I reached out to the people I thought were Elims and claimed HI?

The purpose was to make people suspicious of you later on, I believe. I didn't really get their reasoning. It also got TWS cleared by you.

*“Oh and id be cautious of claims- don't believe it till they confirm it, it would be very easy for me to go. Oh hey, so I'm an Elim and Araris danex and silber are my buddies how's it going.” - Burnt*

I kind of wonder if this will freak Mist out given that Araris and Silber are elims. It's kind of inevitable with so few players left though. :P It would probably also freak the elims out.

Technically got TWS cleared by me, but I don't know if he ever would have actually claimed it if I didn't reach out to him first. Did you tell anyone else he was the Elantrian though? No. I also tried to get the thread to think he was a hemalurgist.

Yeah, killing off Danex should be easy. There is basically no way that village unites on an elim.

They'll unite on someone because they have no choice, but it will probably not be an elim.

Big games with a lot of inactives are annoying. I mean, smaller games too, but I don't understand how people find it fun to join a game but not say anything. You never know if the reason the inactives aren't dying is because they are elims or they are inactive. And when they are village it makes lylo start early basically because you know they aren't going to vote.

Okay *why* is there almost 200 replies in the MR and it's still on Signups? *GOOD* question :P I am not going to read all of it but I'm slightly scared of it. Don't bother. I have no clue what's going on. It started from a question of how the Inquisitors were gonna hide in the midst of the Obligators with huge eye spikes that were a huge giveaway. It evolved into the 'canon' that the game is happening over mail, and that when someone is voted out trained killer hornet hive-mind bees come out of the envelopes, and when someone is killed they step on a lego. They decided to try to lynch me pre-game when I declined this, and we finally settled on an agreement that they could RP whatever the heck they wanted as long as I didn't have to comply. And that they wouldn't try to lynch the GM again. So yeah. My writeups will *not* be from that canon :P haha. Yeah. I love how that agreement settled on something that they were already allowed to do :P Works for me. As long as they don't try to lynch me again xD

I'll have to take a look at that after I finish the writeup :p

I mean, I wish connie answered the questions. She might be able to figure out that it's araris...Idk Burnt. It's the same thing Turtle did. There's no point in not answering the questions. The Elims have an Elim, and that elim can tell them anything they need to know. It doesn't matter if the person asking is an Elim or not. If it was more along the lines of "who do you think it is" I understand though. Idk. shoulda told whysper before I died. AGH. Wait no, I didn't trust whysper. Uh...connie? Maybe I coulda told connie. Who else was I PMing with....I mean, It doesn't matter now. I already told Whysper that I thought Araris was the last one. She just needs to go look through her PM with me again and notice that. I guess she might wanna kill connie though. She might still think connie is the Elim, because no one knows about Araris.

Current village/elim/HI distribution: 6/4/1

If a villager is voted out today, the elims will win. Oh. Didn't know it was that close :P

I think people should be more sus of Araris than they actually are. That's because you have TMI :P. I think I was the only one expressing suspicion of Araris out loud. (er, I did, no?) but I also think that people should be more suspicious. Man.

I think that what Mist is doing will hopefully clear Connie. I mean, it seems like something someone would do to throw suspicion on someone, too WIFOM to think otherwise imo.

I think Whysper comes from a place where they announce Mylo/Lylo, so idk if she is going to notice. No one seems to have noticed, and I would have hoped that someone would put out a long post pointing that out. I mean, I know I would do that. Maybe that's why people aren't. And it's a lot of new people right now. New people and Inactives. It is only two hours into it at this point though, so...I...I just need to wait. A bit. People were expecting five person elim team so they should realize at some point.

Wait, yeah, I didn't even realize- It's just Burnt. And burnt hasn't played for a while. Technically whysper, but FoL is very different I guess. Though technically I would expect her to be wary of both Books and Araris because of the last FoL game I played with her where the Elims were all bussing each other basically.

~~It's probably just the time that I joined, but it was also bugging me in the past two games when people were pure RPing, because I was used to the actual posts with longer RP bits, or just longer RP bits, not people taking up multiple pages with small RP posts :P~~ That actually did bug me as well. Which is why I'm not *especially* looking forward to some of the posts my game will likely receive. Like- on one hand it'd be nice to have a game where we only let 'experienced' players join so it can run smoothly, but on the other hand that's not very nice. It'd still be refreshing, though :P Haha yeah. I'm debating deleting that paragraph I wrote (uhh is that legal in the spec doc? :P) I just don't want to seem rude or discouraging to the people who like doing that. Yeah

I would understand if they were close to getting all the Hemalurgists, and then everyone would think that I was the HI and not worry about killing Mist, but...they killed me? That is even if people thought you were an HI. I didn't because Elantrian protected

I mean, I wasn't inactive as in not reading things, but- Idk. Not very memorable to me. I remember that I almost squired Pyro but was too scared, I thought Matrim? Was a Healer squire, and that I healed an Elim basically every cycle. :P. I remember that game. I tunneled on Gears soooo hard lol and then was killed right as I started figuring out who the elims *actually* were.

But yeah I agree with that. I was getting bad vibes from Araris, and I had a Post I was *planning* to write just before rollover N7, but I got...caught up...playing MC...

:). Sometimes that happens to me, I want to put out a post in case I die, but I just think "Ehh, I don't think I'll die this turn" and postpone and then end up dying the very same turn. Well, In my case I thought I was going to die, but I was too scared of you and Whysper being Elims together to just say it to Whysper.

Why were you scared of me? I literally wasn't doing anything malicious. Lol, It's that I was theorizing who the Hemalurgists were out loud to Whysper, and right after I told her that I think the last two are Araris and TJ, you PM'd me Claiming Hema. That felt like too much of a coinqydink. I was going to claim to you anyway, but she did ask me to claim to you because she trusted me. I was thinking about starting a PM with Whysper and Elk like...D2? But decided against it bc I didn't know how she would feel. I kinda wanted to make a New PM each cycle, adding more people that I trusted :P. Terrible Idea, but whatever. Still want to do it :P. I rarely use PMs. My first PM was the one to Whysper claiming Feruchemist in like N4? And for some

reason, no one PMs me either. :P N3 I think because that's when I died and she knew about you D4.

Haha, you kinda scare me. I remember thinking of PMing you in the FFA, but I was too scared. :P. Whyyy? The only times I think I'm scary is when I'm defending myself. Haha, no I'm just generally scared of everyone who started playing before me (er, even if it's by 1 or 2 games). Pretty sure you've played more games than me at this point. :P *completely* irrelevant :P. It's very out of my comfort zone to PM people, I didn't send one to Orlok, Araris, er....who else...I think the only people I feel comfortable PMing totally are the newer players (minus a few) and people I've been Elims with (mostly because I've heard how they sound when they're relaxed and trusting, so it's easier to judge them) Hmm, yeah I don't think I've ever PM'd Araris. I did PM wilson in my first game about some plan, but I did not know she was one of the first SE players. Haha that would scare me. Ahhh :P. Kas PM'd me in LG...68... and that was helpful for me, but I never would have reached out. PMs are scary, man :P. Ahh, the game I'm pretty sure I had more word count in the PM with Kas than in thread. We spoke a *lot*. Haha, we didn't talk that much. I think my PM with...Whysper might be the longest I've had so far? Yeah definitely.

People should stop thinking I'm an elim. At this point, it's a fact that I'll never be an elim. Move over, Straw. :P Next game it'll be exclusively people who've never been elims before.

I.. sort of want to break the 17 games record xD

How involved were you in the Hemalurgist doc? Were you frequently reading what was going on? Like, after you died? I was frequently reading it, yes.

Did you guess who we were? I tried to claim you at one point but I don't think anyone noted that. What! Whenn? The maze with letters spelled out HADES -> SHADE. It initially was RAGES -> GEARS but I changed it because I didn't want Gears to die. I solved and I was very nervous lol. But how was I supposed to know your identity. And how did you know mine? I thought I did well to hide it. I didn't know you were a Hem, I just picked someone with no duplicate letters in their name. I did briefly think H1 was you when all the other H1 candidates had been crossed off. Turtle didn't respond to the half-quote I looked up just for you though. I even said good morning when it was evening here for me xD. I did try. I knew about Turtle and Condensation. I thought H2 was Illwei, then Whysper. YOU THOUGHT H2 WAS ME TOO? Turtle thought I was H2. I didn't think Devotary was a Hem at all. Bahh, I remember thinking only Aman and Araris were experienced enough to find out Devotary among the elims. Araris didn't even pick me as H2. Whatever happened to that thought, it just disappeared lol. Yeah, well I didn't know that xD. Wait then why did they kill Devotary? They thought she was H1? H6 I think because of the color. H3 apparently, although Araris has to have seen me in enough docs to know I would be the type to say things..Some other H. Ohh. I mean, I immediately thought that...Wait...H6 was Purple? Man, glad I had Whysper, because connie lied to me at every turn :P We actually had a good group of trusted villagers. Sadly the elims all went under-scrutinized. The Ash/Books split turned out really well for the elims. Yeah, I was under suspicion and I was

right all the time! If only we had spoken at the same time. I thought to start a group PM with Illwei, Connie and Whysper, but ehh Idk Haha yeah. I woulda put Elk in there too, but that wouldn't have mattered since Burnt's here now :P. Burnt seems to be wary of Araris. I really hope someone votes out someone like Silber or TWS. Connie has some decent suspicions of the elims. Unfortunately, she's also a target. If only Danex stopped tunnelling gahh. I meant to send a PM to them because I wanted to apologize as I felt I was unfairly aggressive towards them when defending myself. But I forgot. I hope Danex sees this.

Man, I woulda been such a good Elim this game, Smh :P. I'm actually surprised that the Elims didn't try to kill Turtle N1, but I guess the things she said wasn't solid enough. Man, I really thought I screwed it up by attempting to vote out Mist. I still think it was a bad move, but I seem somewhat okay now that I know Vapor is village. Yeah, I mean that was the best course of action unless you last minute put two votes on Silber or something. Moving a vote to TWS would have worked, but that would be an odd choice considering the only vote was self-inflicted. Haha self-votes the best defense :P. There were only like 4 people voting though, even though- I can't believe everyone was just okay with the Idea of testing for the HI when they were so adamantly against it in the beginning. I feel like I remember the consensus being that it was okay if we happened to hit the HI early game, but not on purpose. Yes, and this attempt was on purpose :P. If they were an Elim Voidbringer, then there would have been much more defence- from them and from the elims trying to switch the vote. The fact that everyone was okay with it should have been a red flag. Unfortunately the moment someone (me) points out something like that, it immediately gets turned that I am defending them, therefore my point is meaningless :P. If I was alive I would be screaming. Alas, I Screamed only in the doc. Bahh, I feel bad now. I definitely was not okay with Vapor lynch because Araris and Whysper were voting together a lot. Probably should have chosen TWS or Silber. Eh nothing to do now :P. We did what we could with the info we had :P. We're still alive at least. Still need four successes in a row to win. Surprised at how Whysper dropped the attack on Silber, especially since Silber did not reply to her post asking him to name a suspect. Still time.

Is LG72 the Anniversary game? Anniversary games are ANs AGs.

Unlikely, since those usually start late December. We should have time to squeeze it in. It will be the rerun of LG2 and 32.

Ahh yeah I saw that. Okay. Someone was counting down the games until the...AG? Is that anniversary or anon? AG? AG is anniversary, AN is anonymous. I do think the AG will also be anonymous, but I am not involved in that. I don't actually know who will be in charge. It would be El/Wilson if they're available.

Ah. I hope so- that it will be anon. Very excited for an anon game. :P.

Is Orlok free to run LG72? He didn't show up for this game. Sort of excited for the conversion game too.

Conversion game? Like a cult game? Ahh. Maybe I should go read that game :P.

LG 72 has one Inquisitor who gives up spikes to make new elims. The first game had a confirmed safe role as a mistborn who claimed, got roleclaims from everyone, and fell victim to Uber Tin spike which let the Inquisitor see someone's PMs. I believe LG32 had the Inquisitor go inactive. 11 full turns and they died to the filter. Like.. D11? Died over N11 so it never got to D12. So there was no conversion in the game?

Haha wonderful. Less wonderful. Elim teams like this one with over 50% inactives is not fun to play against. Yeahh, there's barely anything to catch the likes of TWS, Books and Silber. Would have pushed a lynch on Silber if I was alive this cycle. Haha I woulda pushed Silber last cycle if I was alive :P. If we were willing to kill lotus- I almost tried to push Silber that cycle.

Mist, Mist is another person who scares me. In what way? Idk. Honestly people who are popular on the GenDis side of things :P It is somewhat offputting to see new players with so many posts. Haha. Connie has close to five times as many posts as I do in less than a third of the time. I think it's very ~~amoying~~ interesting to see those people come over, and then post like they do on the other side of the Shard.

There's a lot more people signed up for the MR than I realized. Oh wow. Just checked. 21. 22 now :P And most of them are new? Honestly considering dropping out of it...but...it's less than 24 hours til it starts and that wouldn't be too kind to Mat. Haha yeah please don't :P Changing up the role distribution isn't that difficult, especially because he has a Co-GM. No IM yet, though it's probably going to be me since no other mods have claimed it. I had a character planned solely to say one specific thing but it looks like vaguely treasonous steel inquisitor will not be showing up. Haha. I kinda thought it was funny that you kept ending up being the IM for all the more recent games, and then you finally got to play in a game and then you were instantly killed off. I had a stretch where I died N1 repeatedly, but this game I made it through N3. I've actually died N1 a lot but it's not as bad as Gears. :P. Poor Gears. I mean- He *kinda* did it to himself my starting to claim Elim...but still.

I'm very scared for the MR post count. A lot of people that I expect to see RPing in small posts. Or speaking in small posts. :P. College apps are due in like two weeks. Woot. I have multiple games I want to play. I'll have fun with that, and the PM's... Actually, I think to spare you guys who are... less inclined to RP I'll 'suggest' that if you're planning on RPing a lot it should be in a PM. That way only I have to deal with it xD

Which ones? MR and LG 72? Not exactly a top priority should be though. I mean, yeah, and one on another Forum. I also want to play another game on FoL soon-ish because I kinda...left a pretty...bad impression....okay not really not really but I Hammered myself barely 6 hours into the cycle because of events, and while people tell me that it's fine and no one really cares I still feel terrible about it because maybe I coulda gotten those people to see reason instead of giving up and playing third imposter :P

Is FoL a big tunnel site where they pick a player and immediately pile lots of votes? As in? The players tunnel? Yeah. Yeah it is. From what I experienced, yes. No necessarily all at once, but I had 4/6 votes on my 4 hours in, and I had been trying to explain things for multiple cycles, and nobody barely acknowledged my reads :P. So I figured it was a lost cause. And didn;t want to suffer for more time than I needed to :P. Being mislynched is *very* annoying. xD I also tend to just give up when I'm a doomed villager, but here it lasts longer without the majority cycle termination. Yeah. Something I wasn't used to at all. What, the cycle terminates when more than 50% of alive players vote for the same player? Yeah. I was kinda confused reading over the site rules (not FoL, the other site I play on rn) and it said like "Before you hammer, state intent and ask for a roleclaim to prevent Elims from hammering and to be nice" and "Don't forget to put L-x (x=number of votes left to hammer) when voting" because I was just thinking: Why? But then I played and it was interesting. People demand a role-claim for them to stop voting on them? Asking for a roleclaim makes sense when only a villager could have a certain role. Huh? No, just, if you're going to hammer someone- which immediately ends the cycle and kills them, then it's just courteous to let the person know :P.

We have a lot fewer confirmed safe roles than other sites I think, so roleclaiming is much less likely to save you here. I don't actually know specifically for FoL. h, I know that the games I've played in have had basically 0 confirmable roles. Idk the game I played on FoL was a Marson :P. 0 confirmable roles :P. I've contemplated playing on other sites before, but I guess it's the Sanderson flavor that makes SE more.. interesting? than the others. Haha yeah. I agree with that. Also other sites tend to use 'normal' roles :P. Like...roles you'd find in MU wiki and things :P. Like Townie, sounds lame. :P And I also don't like the fact that they know the role-distribution of the game beforehand. Not always.

I don't think my playstyle would fit other sites. Yeah. xD Ah. I was very surprised when it was D1 and we were on 1000 posts :P. Scary scary scary. 16 person game. People tend to post less more often, if that makes sense. I am only capable of conglomerate posts made over the course of several hours or spitting out every errant thought into a doc. It would also be helpful if I was capable of independent thought instead of just replying to other people. Haha. I mean, when people post small things to address every one of their thoughts, it's pretty easy to reply to them :P. Makes you difficult to read though which is helpful as an elim. I still think there are bits people could pick up from your posts to judge you're village, There are differences but it's hard for me to change my playstyle as seen by the fact that I keep voting in the last hour. but since I do not have anything to compare to (don't think I've been in a game you've been an elim I think you were in LG 68 yeah.) Were you not in LG 68? (oh yeah, I forgot about that. It was the mechanism that caught Devotary (unfairly I think I was suspicious enough for Sart to scan me, so that is kind of my fault. I kind of dared him to do it and then submitted the kill anyway.))How so? I remember it being Kas being nitpicky? He did catch the wrong wording of confirmed evil or whatever, but I do maintain that it was reasonable for me to have guessed your vote manip ability. Well, I mean, I thought that he was operating under the assumption that we were Elims

together? Or that you had my ability. I think that it was reasonable for you to guess...as...I thought I had outright...claimed...it...:P.Ohh. right., I almost always read you village. I think people like Devotary would always be read as Elim Elsewhere because of site meta (oops, sorry. *Scum* they'd be *scumread*)I don't get the scum wording as well. Just because they are elims, doesn't mean they're scum. Sometimes elims are the good guys and village are the bad ones (like MR42). ~~I-I think Fura would disagree~~ Why, the elims were the police - good guys. Village - corrupt politicians. Bad. I Help im stuck on the wrong keyboard:P anyways, I mean the people who are trying to kill the people- those are scum. Whether it be mafia faction or neutrals or whatever.. *Scum does sound meaner than elim. Apparently elim is a technical term elsewhere for something else.* Also yeah, on FoL when I used "Elim" like...okay, two? People were confused and were unsure If i meant the Eliminators (mafia) or the Eliminators (the village, who is trying to eliminate people during the day) which...okay? I think Town and Scum are easier to say sometimes than Elim. I don't like saying scum tbh :P but like, Elimm-y v. scummy, Read as Elim/Elim read/...other things people say vs. Scumread/Scumlean/Nullscum...things like that. Those sound so weird lol. Definitely prefer elim/elim-lean. Haha. syllables. I People here I notice are more inclined to wait a bit and then compile a lot of stuff together, and then wait a bit. My playstyle has definitely changed since playing elsewhere- good thing I didn't have much of a playstyle when I started :P.

I was kinda wanting to do the MU Hydra event (glad I didn't sign up though, With college apps not done :P) but Fura didn't wanna Hydra with me and I was too scared of anyone else (and kinda unsure that anyone else who might say yes would be up for reading and posting enough) :P. MU is insanely active as well, right? Yeaah. I haven't been keeping up with it, but I think...hold on...Idk. I just know that someone in the Hydra event said that something had...a lot of posts. I checked Elbereth's game from MU Championship, and then I saw a few other games from the same tournament and they all have around 100 pages. Yeah, Honestly I would assume more? I know that they have a minimum post requirement. On Hypixel mafia I was probably doing...more than 50 posts a cycle- I had 50 posts this game D1. more than 50 posts, and everyone else was probably as well. Last game had over 150 pages. On FoL the forum doesn't have pages, but there were...more than 1000 posts in total? I don't remember the count-had to be a lot more than that I would think. 4000 posts? 3-4k I think for the game. People talk a lot :P. The thing is on both sites a lot of the people don't say a lot in most of their posts

(slightly how I was surprised I had 50 posts that were game related on D1. of course, as I said, someone has to make up for the lack of Matrim :P)(Why can't everyone just be active? :P) Matrim is fun to play with. You'll have to make up in his game too. :P Yeah, but how do you navigate on a forum without pages?? VERY DIFFICULTLY. (there is ISO, so it makes it easier to navigate people's individual posts) but you just read everything. I keep a spreadsheet (because I don't know if you can bookmark posts on there....) of things I find important, but It's hard :P. Especially when it doesn't update great (for the most part it updates immediately though unlike The hypixel forums or these forums)

Is it something better than endless scroll? ....no. It's endless scroll. I was kinda used to it because the first? One of the first forums I was ever on (not for Mafia) switched over to the same...forum? Format? So it wasn't...terrible. But still. Being able to mark page numbers was something I didn't realize I liked so much. :P. Sounds horrible. xD Haha. (shhh don't let whysper hear you) Scrolling through 4000 posts to find things sounds horrible.

Also- apparently a problem on FoL is *alt accounts*????? Like, people make alt accounts to test out different playstyles or trolly playstyles or whatnot??? When I joined everyone thought I was an Alt- even when I denied it, even when Whysper and the other person I know spoke up for me not being an alt??? It was weird. Apparently there is a mafia player who has been around to a few sites with the name "bepwei" and they thought I was them :P. I find that funny lol. "Let's lynch Illwei cause she's an alt account!" Did they do that? I mean. A lot of players made assumptions about my playstyle because of bepwei's meta? But no not really. They ended up- I really shouldn't get into this but hey you *technically* asked :P. I'm taking it

I had hardcore defended this one person who I thought was town because they were acting...very suspicious, but it was all both TWTBAW and they were a new player, so it felt more like what a new player would do. BUT! D1 they seemd to be more knowledgeable than I thought a new player would be, even one who had spectated a few games. I pointed this out and asked them a few times if they were actually a new player or not (people sussed me for this- why would it matter if they're new or not?) I eventually laid off but (hello tunnelling) people never forgot about that. After I had determined that they were probably just new town, talking a lot and saying things to try and be helpful, (they had been up for the vote 3 days in a row and each time the counter was killed, each time the counter was village, but three of my top suspects kept voting on them so I didn't trust it) then they finally get killed (on a day where it was a e/e votes, this person and another elim) people turned on me because 1) I was hardcore defending them 2) because I was too focused on players being new on D1, and 3) because people didn't like my reads and my reads were too wall-post-y so ew :P. Why would people complain about this??

Well, basically they already didn't like me, and me giving my opinions in long thought out posts was obviously a sign that I was to prepared and thoughtful, instead of being reckless and thoughtless like most villagers(?), because villagers don't care what people think of them :P. Me posting long post might have come off as too overly analytical (to them?)- Like Aman's post in here about Elandera: Too perfectly crafted to actually be a genuine thought. Well, villagers can definitely be analytical, and that's definitely not a reason to be suspicious.

Eh, site meta: it is what it is :P. Here it isn't suspicious, but there they have a way that they play and determine things that isn't the same. Anyways, it was a stressful game :P. Yeah, that's another thing slightly annoying. People should be more open to players coming from outside and understand not everyone plays like their site. I mean, if someone came here and played like they do from their site- even if you told yourself it might be their site meta: if it matched up with something that elims to frequently over here then we would still probably want to kill them :P. Yeah, true. But we give a lot of leeway to new players here. That is something I noticed. On

Hypixel when making reads I'll give leeway to the newer players, and then most of the people will just say things like "why? Just because they're new doesn't mean that they're village" which doesn't totally make sense, but they are definitely not against NKing new players N1 :P. With that I have an assignment due in 40 minutes that I haven't started. o/ Alright, bai.

Sorry that's the long way around

I still have many feelings about this game, as you can tell :P.

Doesn't help that two of my top three suspicions that were voting on this elim every time were actually elims trying so hard to bus the last Elim :P.

Burst RP doesn't usually last past C1.

Also can I be upset that Elk put a whole FIVE elims in his QF? Like- 5??? And a TOUGH??? 5/18 isn't past the realm of reasonability, but having a tough was a bit much. Lol which was Why I was so sure it was 4 with tough :P. Which is why I *always* assume +1 elims more than the worst case scenario. :P WHO PUTS FIVE ELIMS AND WITH A PROTECT FROM THE DAYKILL IN AN 18 PERSON GAME? Hehe that was fun My worst worst-case scenario is (33% - 1) so yeah, always assume the worst xD. That's way too worst case! (well, okay, maybe not, but still) 5/18 is 33%-1. It's kind of ingrained in me. The first game had 9 elims out of 30 players, so when I see the total number of players now, my brain immediately calculates (33%-1). Okay how the heck does your brain *immediately* calculate 33% -1? Can I download the app? xD I don't know lol, I've been doing it every game, and I'm.. just conditioned to it? xD Huh, the game has been going on for so long that I forgot I did indeed have a spreadsheet, although only for figuring out the Hems. These were my D1 guesses, after which I forgot about the sheet. xD

I felt you definitely would do such a thing if you were a Hem and claim "someone told me". H3 was because they asked if Mist was new, so they

That's what it says in the players list. 22 shouldn't be much, but with a majority of them being new players, yeah I'd be nervous as well. :P Oh I'm smart never mind

Illwei (and any others who aren't too keen about what seems to be happening with the MR) I plan on enforcing/suggesting straight RP and random conversations to be in PMs only. That should keep the thread mildly focused :P Oh so only you and me have to witness the insanity? Yep I'll be there too. Haha Hive mind hornets Haha. Anywayyyys, why hasn't Connie died yet???

I have not been following the past couple days. Did we beat the hemalurgist doc?!?!?!?! TJ showing up put us way over the edge. \*Looks up\* Oh yeah... The hemalurgist doc is eally sad. The only person there is elim.

TJ could have been putting this effort into the hema doc at the expense of getting killed way earlier. I hope Whysper stays inactive in the doc, but we'reat LyLo anyways.

The game ends if the village is wrong today, since there's nothing to block an elim kill. I guess the elims could forget to submit a kill again but I assume Straw would call it at the end of the day. I think elims are going to win unless they notice Araris.

We're at lylo rn turtle. Oop. :)))) yeah, i think honestly if anyone gets killed this cycle it would be silber (of the elims. If an elim dies). Araris *really* likes to buss teammates. Whysper i think knows Araris Is the hast hema- at least I told her that i thought it had to be araris or elk, so she will Pull out that card if people try (the card that ive been pulling)

How did you know that?

Uhhh ill need to check my notes, but PoE....hold on...and i didnt know it, i just suspected :P i was going off of what whysper had told me (learned i couldnt trust turtle :P HEY! You did tell Illwei several lies But... Me and connie had this plan...It was still lying to me, and I couldn't trust you after :P. Good thing I had Whysper :P. Connie I also couldn't trust + she wasn't on a lot.) so uh let me see...

So N1 I suspected Turtle of being a Hema, PM'd her (turned out she PM'd me) got her to claim H1 to me. She told me connie was a Hema (though the wrong hema, still a Hema :P) though then I thought she was H4.

N2 I PM'd Whysper because she also said that a Hema PM'd her and I found that unlikely, she tried to deny being a Hema but..yeah... Did you get anything useful from your PM with me? I kind of left you hanging on that one. Haha not really no, you were giving off Elim vibes to me though, and it felt like you were trying to take down turtle (Honestly because I thought everyone would think she was a Hemalurgist, so everyone coming after her seemed pretty suspicious to me Would have been easier as an elim to just use the kill Eh, but see, I was under the assumption

that the Elims were trying to...Pocket...Turtle....somehow....through PMs...) Illwei asked me to tell you to PM her. I didnt, because... I honestly have no idea.

Ah okay, here we are. Whysper told me that H4 thought H2 would know who they are (is that true) and Whysper also said that H4 and H2 referenced certain past games, (and past games in general) which helped narrow it down, H5 knew people, so they were also semi-experienced, and I had narrowed down H5 and 4 to TJ and Araris (Elk and Mist kinda but they were inactive and Elk had another role- doesn't mean it would be less likely though) after you died. Then TJ claimed to me so all was left was Araris.

I did not guess Araris as H4. He had two thoughts in the first two cycles and was only a little more active after that. He said I might know who he was and I denied it. This happened the night I died yes, but I wasn't killed as an H2 suspect.

Was this right before you died? Did he figure out- I mean if you were specifically referencing the games that people started in that would lean me towards thinking it's you. Ah. interesting :P.

That's funny. Riiight you were killed as an H3 suspect.

I'm not the only one who can look at the player spreadsheet. It's not always up to date, but it does a good job of noting people's first game.

Yeah, but you're one of the only people who actually does :P. Spreadsheet? SE player and game stats spreadsheet in Wilson's signature, has a list of every player and some statistics. Games played, alignment, win and survival%, etc. I've played the 7th most games apparently despite only being around half the time. 3/7 of the time apparently. Haha, 1/2 wasn't accurate enough? :P. The first game was 2013 and I'd thought it was 2014.seeing my start game at 67 is depressing to me, mostly because I know I could have started like 20 games earlier :P (...17? games?) :P. What was the first live game you were around for? Uh, What's a live game? OH, like, a game happening? LG67 :P. If you could have started much earlier, which one would it have been?

The first game i kinda watched was when I watched Fura play...LG49, and he tried to get me to play after that. ~~I just...didn't...because I thought Forum Mafia was kinda stupid.~~ LG 49 was very unrepresentative of how the typical game works. Haha yeah I noticed that :P.

Oh well, but that's my notes somewhat. Bad job of explaining them, as I didn't write them in my spreadsheet, just the PM with Whysper :P.

*That should keep the thread mildly focused :P Oh so only you and me have to witness the insanity? Yep I'll be there too.* Devotary, are you my IM? If so I had no idea :P Yes. I sent messages to the mod discord when new games go up and nobody responded so I guess it's me. So I guess I should add you to all the stuff Sure. Do you have a role distribution? Yeah, that's all ready. I do like to be in PMs since PM folders make it manageable. As long as nobody else signs up in the next half an hour anyway :P

How the heck to folders work? I put things in folders, but they still appear in my main inbox?

You just have to reload the page after you do anything. It's the same though every time I open PMS. I have put all previous game stuff in folders, but it's still in my main inbox when I go there. Not sure why that's happening. You make a new folder, check all the PMs you want to move, move to the new folder, reload the page and it should be removed from your inbox. You have to manually move them with the little checkboxes I- yeah, that's what I do. Are you moving back into your inbox after creating a new folder? Yeah, is that wrong? No, I just don't know where it's going wrong for you. Okay...I'm actually beyond confused now...As...It seems to be working now.... Maybe next time I open my PMs it'll all be back to normal though :P. Magic! I think it doesn't auto-update, but reloading the page solidifies the change. Ah, yeah. It goes back to normal every time I open PMs, and When I refresh it goes to folders.

End of MR signups. Yep. Wooooo

*"Okay...I'm actually beyond confused now...As...It seems to be working now...." - Illwei*

PMs are one of those weird things on the Shard that often act unpredictably.

There was one time where I told connie she had accidentally doubled her message but in reality it just showed up that way for me because we sent a message at the same time. PMs are weird sometimes.

I just read up on the doc so:

*"I thought to start a group PM with Illwei, Connie and Whysper" - TJ*

Fun fact of the day is that there's only been one group PM this game.

*"Is Orlok free to run LG72? He didn't show up for this game. Sort of excited for the conversion game too." - TJ*

Yeah, I've been wondering about that. I'll probably ask about LG72 in the GM PM after this day turn ends, since then there will be only 10 players left.

*"I think it's very annoying interesting to see those people come over, and then post like they do on the other side of the Shard." - Illwei*

It certainly makes it very difficult to look through their posts for game info. :P

*"I also don't like the fact that they know the role-distribution of the game beforehand." - TJ*

Hmm, I've been thinking about doing a game with a pre-determined distribution (specifically, running the setup that was used in the Mafia championships this year.

*"I just know that someone in the Hydra event said that something had...a lot of posts." - Illwei*  
Hydra games do have a lot of posts, since there are two people, but you can also split the work of reading between two people.

*"I checked Elbereth's game from MU Championship, and then I saw a few other games from the same tournament and they all have around 100 pages." - TJ*

That's more of a champs thing than anything. There's a posting requirement + people who are more active tend to get chosen as site reps + people want to advance, and taking a more active role in the game makes them more likely to get advanced.

"Also can I be upset that Elk put a whole FIVE elims in his QF? Like- 5???" - Illwei  
5/18 is above average, but it's roughly 27.78%, so it's not too extreme. It does depend heavily on distribution though, and QFs tend to favor elims anyway.

"The game ends if the village is wrong today, since there's nothing to block an elim kill. I guess the elims could forget to submit a kill again but I assume Straw would call it at the end of the day." - Devotary

Yeah, I'm not sure. I'll decide whether or not to call it when the day ends. Any kill wins for them but they don't know that for sure.

"I've played the 7th most games apparently despite only being around half the time. 3/7 of the time apparently." - Devotary

Huh, yeah, and I've apparently played the 5th most and GMed the 4th most. Weird that I've played more than Mailliw, considering that he used to be known as the guy who'd played a lot of games.

The 2 year break really didn't help.

Yeah, and he hasn't been around that much since then. Probably since a lot of the people who he knew don't play much SE anymore. Now that I think about it, a surprising amount of old SE players don't play much anymore. Maybe we'll see some of them in the AG.

Orlok is signed up for the LG in the spreadsheet, but Sart's list doesn't include him.

Oh BTW @Matrim if you see this could I get a MR spec doc link?

I can give you the link if you want.

I guess this'll be the game.

I'm so confused- people keep talking like there's going to be later cycled- DO they not realize it's lylo??? This is what happens when the only vet you have left is a pinch hitter :))))))

It's fairly reasonable to think there could be one more cycle left, but yeah people just don't seem to realize how close they are to losing.

I mean, it's new players/inactives left with whysper and Burnt. And I'm pretty sure whysper is used to the GMs announcing lylo?. And Burnt probably...well she wasn't around for the discussion about numbers :P. So- the Elims really killed off all the...veteran players....

Haha mist not wanting to vote because of??? I would just vote trying to cause confusion. I guess she might not want to lead people to the Elims?

Mist is probably just trying to play it safe. Voting might spark discussion, and the status quo is good for her.

This doc beat the Hemalurgists, but it looks like the thread is the overall winner, which is pretty rare.

Yep, thread was pretty active.
