We do not share your email addresses with anyone, and we strictly limit our messages to Psalms-related content only. The only exception to this policy is that Rabbi Robbins and Beri Schwitzer at Temple have access, since this is a merged Temple/Lay Psalms mailing list.

While many of us can use the Temple Emanu-El directory (and can be found there), many of our group cannot. We maintain a semi-private, opt-in directory of members of this Psalms group, available only to members of this Psalms group who have opted-in to publishing their contact information.

Where are Rabbi Robbins’s presentations?

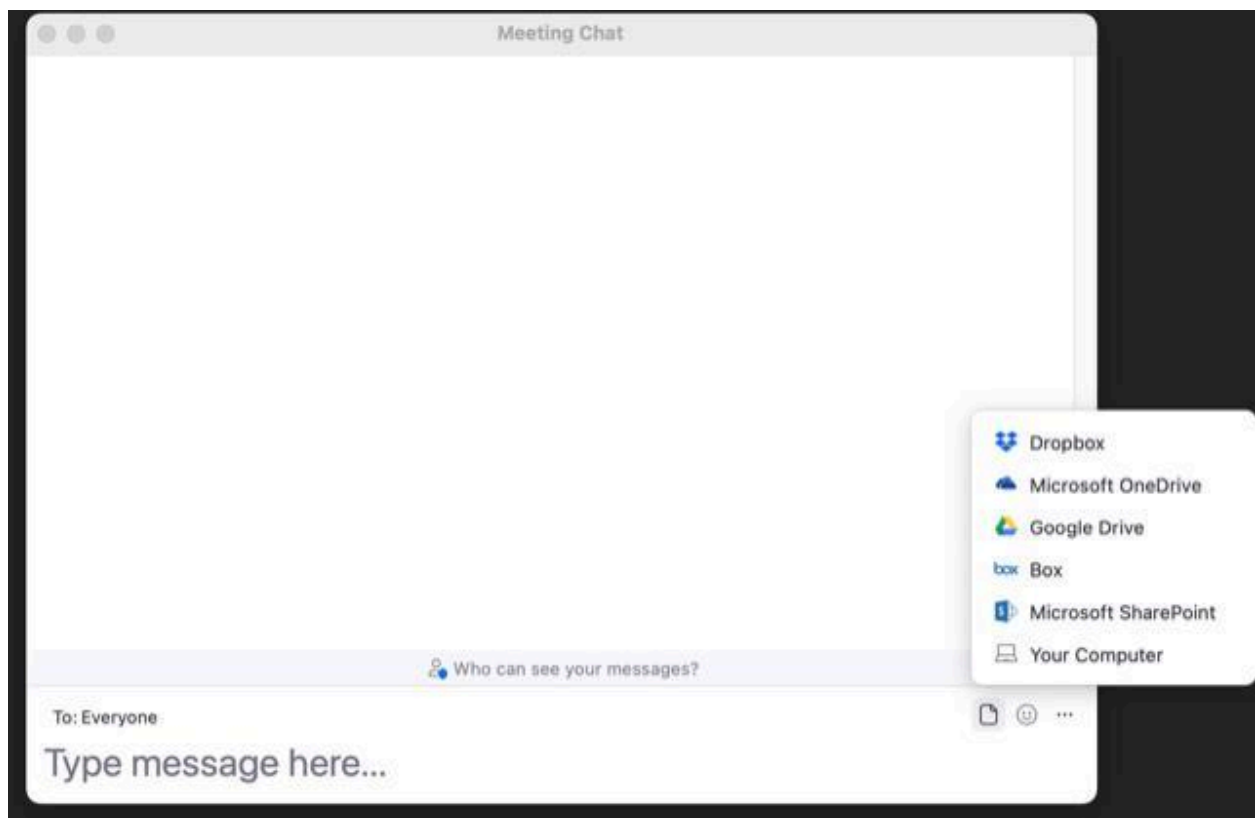
Here are Rabbi Robbins’s [Psalms for the Pandemic](#), Here is a collection of the [slide decks she’s been using for Psalm 104](#).

Which blessings do we use before study, and where are they?

We have a couple of blessings; there may be more. There is the one that Rabbi Robbins put at the beginning of her book on Psalm 27, and that was [one we’ve been using most of the time](#). Rabbi Robbins put up a new one at the beginning of November 2022 (that is also in [her slide deck](#)). There’s also the one we use for Talmud, Chever Torah, general study, etc. (לְעִסוּק בְּדַבְרֵי תוֹרָה).

Can I save the text chat?

You should be able to click on individual chat items to get a menu to save the text. You may have to right-click or click and hold. You can also save the whole text chat. See the graphic below: If you click on the little piece of paper icon in the lower right corner (third from the left in the lower right), you will get a menu. If you select “Your Computer” toward the end of the session, then after the session a window will open up with a .txt (plain text) file with all the chat stuff you could see. Double-click on it and something on your box will open it.



Can I do anything about the size of the text or graphics being shared?
