

Help plant perennial milkweed to attract and feed some of the most beautiful insects in our environment!




K - 2 Ornamental Flower Beds

Grades K-3 ELA **Heggerty**

- Phonemic Awareness and Phonics curriculum intended for direct instruction around letter and sound recognition, and language awareness
- Program provides daily lessons that take about 10-15 minutes to work on skills over the course of a week or a few weeks, allowing students to engage with words following patterns and understanding word parts
- Teachers use resources such as letter or sound cards, hand motions, and online videos to engage all learners in the activities around blending, segmenting, substituting and more

Grades 4-8 ELA Amplify

- Digital and print material based on english/language arts standards
- Curriculum provides opportunities for students needing differentiation to access grade level content and extension for students needing higher academic rigor
- The program is designed to align to the Science of Reading which is the most recently released reading research push in education
- Multimedia platforms provide learning with visuals, games, quest inquiry lesson launches, and tools for students to use independently
- Many of the texts in the library are culturally responsive, providing authors and characters from different backgrounds and cultures, in addition to connecting with Social-Emotional learning content aligning well with the CN way and the projects that have been established for ELA content and exploration

Grades K-3 Math Hand2Mind

- Hand 2 Mind guided math kits are structured as 9 units per grade, 20 lessons per unit covering the entire school year
- The kits includes are designed as lessons for the workshop model (which aligns to our CN way of teaching), along with ready to learn resources including task cards, activities, and independent work
- Correlated to the CCSS for data and instructional purposes
- Prioritizes hands on, manipulative based learning from kindergarten to third grade, incorporates a mathematics instructional model which sequences skills for students to build confidence and benefit from scaffolded comprehension and math skills

Grade 4-8 Math Open Up Resources

- Digital and print material based on mathematics standards
- Curriculum provides opportunities for students needing differentiation to access grade level content and extension for students needing higher academic rigor
- The program is designed to be problem based practice, allowing students to explore mathematical concepts and topics based on word and real life problems
- OUR provides learning opportunities through math centers, online resources, student practice and reflection opportunities
