
Rudrabhishek Sankalp – FAQs

1. What is the Rudrabhishek Sankalp?

It's a collective spiritual initiative to install Rudraksheshwar Mahadev Shivling using Rudraksha beads offered by 1.25 lakh families.

2. What does “One Family, One Rudraksha” mean?

Each participating family receives one Rudraksha to perform puja at home and later return it to the Mandir for Shivling formation.

3. Why is Rudraksha important in this ritual?

Rudraksha is sacred to Lord Shiva and symbolizes divine energy, protection, and spiritual awakening.

4. Where do the Rudrakshas come from?

They are sourced from the 12 Jyotirlingas, representing the highest spiritual centers of Lord Shiva and from other Temples . Also from Nepal

5. How do I register for the Sankalp?

You can register online via the Mandir's website or contact them directly for participation details.

6. Is there a fee to participate?

Participation is open to all; donations are welcome but not mandatory.

7. What rituals should I perform with the Rudraksha at home?

Chanting Shiva mantras 11 times minimum,, and meditating with devotion are key components.

8. Can I keep the Rudraksha for ever after the puja?

No, the Rudraksha must be returned to the Mandir to be part of the collective Shivling installation.

9. What is Rudraksheshwar Mahadev Shivling?

It's a unique Shivling formed entirely from Rudraksha beads offered by devotees, symbolizing unity and devotion.

10. When is the final installation ceremony?

The Mandir will announce the date for the grand Rudrabhishek and Pran Pratishtha ceremony.

11. Can international devotees participate?

Yes, devotees from around the world can join virtually and receive Rudraksha by mail if available.

12. Is this event open to all religions?

Yes, the Mandir welcomes anyone seeking spiritual connection with Lord Shiva.

13. What are the benefits of participating?

Blessings of peace, prosperity, health, and spiritual growth through Lord Shiva's grace.

14. Can children be involved in the Sankalp?

Absolutely! Families are encouraged to include children to foster cultural and spiritual learning.

15. What happens during the Rudrabhishek ceremony?

Vedic rituals, chanting, and offerings are performed to invoke divine energy and sanctify the Shivling.

16. Will there be live streaming of the event?

The Mandir may offer virtual access for those unable to attend in person—check their website for updates.

17. How is the Shivling constructed from Rudrakshas?

Returned Rudrakshas are carefully assembled into a sacred structure representing Lord Shiva in New Temple

18. Can I volunteer for the event?

Yes, volunteers are welcome to assist with logistics, rituals, and community outreach.

19. Is there a dress code for the ceremony?

Traditional Indian attire is encouraged to honor the sanctity of the event.
