- Dear MEP, I am writing to you directly because we are millions of European and Spanish people who are extremely concerned with the content that was approved on December 19 regarding the European Pact on Migration and Asylum within the framework of the Presidency Spanish of the Council of the EU.
- Dear MEP, I would like to send you this email to express my concern regarding the content that was approved on December 19 regarding the European Pact on Migration and Asylum, within the framework of the Spanish Presidency of the Council of the EU.
- Good morning/ good evening, I am contacting you as a European citizen who is deeply concerned about the upcoming ratification of the European Pact on Migration and Asylum, scheduled for April 10.

This pact reinforces borders, criminalizes human mobility and increases returns. It is an absolute step backwards in our commitment to be a Europe that defends human rights. It is a pact against human rights that will mean a before and after in our history as a European Union and as a Member State.

This pact will imply:

1. That our borders become spaces where legality does not apply.
2. More discrimination and fewer guarantees of access to asylum.
3. It normalizes mass detentions, even of minors.
4. An indiscriminate system of express expulsions.
5. More pressure on EU countries of arrival.
6. An unfair system of solidarity à la carte.
7. A free hand to circumvent international obligations.
8. Increased criminalization of people migrating.
9. Digital tools for mass surveillance.
10. No legal or safe channels and consolidation of border externalization.

In short, the new European Pact on Migration and Asylum does not guarantee the rights and dignity of people arriving in the European Union and worsens the existing regulations. This Pact is not worthy of the European Union of which I am a part, nor can it be a new regulation in the next European period after the European elections on May 9.

That is why I am writing to you as a representative in the European Parliament to share with you my bewilderment and rejection of this Pact of Death, because the European Pact on Migration and Asylum KILLS. And I ask you, strongly, to vote against it in the ratification session that you will have in April in the EP.

The direction of your vote on the PEMA matters to Spanish and European voters, who overwhelmingly demand migration policies that guarantee, first and foremost, the human rights of all people.

I therefore urge you to vote against the text of the European Pact on Migration and Asylum that will be ratified by the European Parliament on April 10th in Brussels.

Millions of people will be attentive to your vote that day, we have a lot at stake.
