

Roundtable

- Halla: Last week was bad -- I really spent a couple of days in bed, just too exhausted to get up. On Friday I was a bit better, and today I closed nearly a dozen bugs
- Emmet: This week we fixed (kind of) a bug regarding animation export and cleaning up unwanted files in order to prevent ffmpeg from getting confused. Kind of hard to explain but, it's basically worked around as much as possible for now without changing the exporter significantly. Other than that we updated a little side thing called "Krita Devbox" that we posted about on the mailing list last week with a bunch of new features. If you're interested in another option for containerized krita dev or building personal appimages, I think it's pretty good so try it out. :) https://invent.kde.org/eoinoneill/krita-devbox

- **Dmitry**: I worked on lager on monday, then fixed some bugs on tuesday, and then got drowned in the memory leak report. I've added an AOB point about that.
- Wolthera: my week consisted over panicking about getting the gsoc stuff done, and after that I was out of juice.
- Reinold: Last week I took @wolthera's advice and just tried to make the export create an empty file. That was easier to diagnose and after some experimentation I got that working. Then I tried making the export create a base svg file. I think that almost works as I saw that base svg file code being executed but it didn't actually write to the file. This week I should have the svg export pushing a base file. After that I plan to add support for including vector layers. I also plan to do a blog post this week (I think I can have enough progress to talk about something biweekly:))
- Ivan:My week was pretty much 3 things, GSoC evals, reinstalling glouc services configuring stuff and falling through the rabbit hole of web APIs. halla: about sandboxing I was fighting over minor things, I think I will only ask for permission on first time open and then all should work without rewriting the whole thing.
- Sharaf: Last week I looked into several things, initially I completed my MR for Bug 456922, which I've backported. Then I looked into some pings from KA, where I saw users asking why they can't import photos from Google Photos in Krita. Turns out because we have ask for read-write access, Google Photos doesn't list itself. After that I worked on updating targetSdk and testing if everything works on a few devices. While doing this, I noticed that our billing library is going to be outdated (google doesn't allow uploading these) too. So, I updated this to use the newer API. And did testing with my test email address. Finally, I responded to the comments I got on my MRs (1525, 1533) and did some fixes for it. That's all!

AOB

- [Dmitry] Policy about releasing memory to the system. It looks like some tools, e.g. Gradient reserves a lot of memory, which is rarely used.
- [Amyspark] Do we (outside of Dmitry, who I think wrote it) actually know how Krita manages its memory? I couldn't find any docs on the system, and the usage of Boost classes makes it... difficult to follow from the source.
