

## 2022-23 CCP Registration Information 12th Grade

### Important Info:

- Students who successfully passed all offered 2021-22 college courses will need a minimum of **28 credit hours** (maximum 30 hours) to complete the Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) degree. (**Must select from Option 1, 2, or 3**).
- If you do not wish to complete the degree, you can choose from **1-4 groups**.
- Each group below will be taught during *one class period* in either spring or fall (courses will be taught consecutively).
- Can have a maximum of 2 pathways:
  - Either CTP (college transfer pathway) for associates degree + CTE pathway
  - Or two CTE pathways.

### CTP (College transfer) courses offered at PCA for 2022-23:

The following groupings will be offered based on student interest:

<b>Group 1 Required</b>	PSY 241 - Developmental Psychology PSY 281 - Abnormal Psychology SOC 213 - Sociology of the Family	9 hours
<b>Group 2 Required</b>	Online course - of student's choosing PED 110 - Physical Fitness (online)	3 or 4 hours 1 hour
<b>Group 3</b>	MAT 152 - Statistical Methods I BUS 110 - Introduction to Business	7 hours
<b>Group 4</b>	BIO 112 - General Biology II HEA 110 - Personal Health & Wellness	7 hours
<b>Group 5</b>	SPA 111/181 - Elementary Spanish I and lab SPA 112/182 - Elementary Spanish II and lab	8 hours

These groupings may be subject to change based on:

- 1) CCC staffing and scheduling capabilities
- 2) Student demand (a minimum of 10 students is required to be able to offer each group)

## Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) degree

Rising seniors who **wish to complete the associate's degree while at PCA** must choose one of the following 3 options:

### **Option 1 (to complete AA only)**

PSY 241, PSY 281, SOC 213	Group 1	9 hours
Online course/PED 110 online	Group 2	4 or 5 hours
MAT 152/BUS 110	Group 3	7 hours
SPA 111/112	Group 5	8 hours

Total hours for senior year: 28 or 29 hours

### **Option 2 (to complete AA or AS)**

PSY 241, PSY 281, SOC 213	Group 1	9 hours
Online course/PED 110 online	Group 2	5 hours
MAT 152/BUS 110	Group 3	7 hours
BIO 112/HEA 110	Group 4	7 hours

**\*\***Online course must be a 4-hour course to have enough hours to complete the degree; options are:

- CHM 151 - General Chemistry I
- BIO 168 - Anatomy & Physiology I
- MAT 172 - Pre-Calculus Trigonometry
- ACC 120 - Principles of Accounting I

Total hours for senior year: 28 hours

### **Option 3 (to complete AA or AS)**

PSY 241, PSY 281, SOC 213	Group 1	9 hours
Online course/PED 110 online	Group 2	4 or 5 hours
BIO 112/HEA 110	Group 4	7 hours
SPA 111/112	Group 5	8 hours

Total hours for senior year: 28 or 29 hours

## A La Carte College Transfer Credits (will not complete the AA or AS degree)

Rising seniors who *do not wish to complete the AA or AS while at PCA* can select up to four (4) of the groups on page 1.

## Changing to the Associate in Science (AS) Pathway:

- All rising seniors are currently on the Associate in Arts pathway.
- If you wish to change from the AA to the AS pathway for senior year:
  - Let Mrs. McDaniel know ASAP; there is paperwork you must complete.
  - Let Dr. Martin know so she is aware.
- You must successfully pass with a C or better the following courses in Fall 2022. You cannot register for other CCC courses until this is complete.
  - BIO 112 - General Biology II, MAT 172 - PreCalculus Trigonometry (online only)

## **CTE (Career and Technical Education Courses) for 2022-23:**

Students must select a CTE pathway and may take courses that are being offered in that pathway. Students will work with Mrs. McDaniel from CCC to select pathways/courses.
