Southeastern Louisiana University is committed to creating an environment in which student success can be ensured. After reviewing your academic record at the end of Fall 2025 semester, we've noted that your **cumulative GPA** has **dropped below 2.00**. As a result, you've been placed on Academic Probation.

While you're still eligible to continue your studies in the Fall 2025 semester, it's important that you take immediate steps to improve your academic standing. To return to good academic standing, you will need to earn **at least a 2.00 grade point average** next semester and **increase your cumulative grade point average to 2.00 or higher**. If your next semester grade point average **is below 2.00, you will then be placed on academic suspension** and will have to sit out at least one regular semester. We do not want this to happen!

At Southeastern, we value you as a student and want you to succeed in your degree program. The University provides resources to assist students with identifying and overcoming barriers to success. You are encouraged to contact your academic advisor to identify the resources that are aligned with your individual needs and to plan a course of action for academic success going forward.
