



SUMMER SCHOOL

Welcome to Barrington 220 summer school at the Roslyn Road site!

Our teaching staff is very eager to get started with our extended school year. On Monday, June 1st at 9 AM within the Infinite Campus, parent portal, you will find your child's schedule for summer school by changing to "RR Summer School" in the Enrollment tab. Should you have any questions please contact the Roslyn Road School office at **847-381-4148**. We're looking forward to providing a fun and engaging extension to the traditional school year. For those qualifying for summer school transportation, bus route information will be posted to the My Ride K-12 app on Monday, June 1st as well.

Summer School Walk Through

Roslyn Road will be open for parents and students to walk schedules the evening of Thursday, June 4th from 6-7 PM. The office staff will be on-site that evening and directional signs for summer school classrooms will be posted. Families can come at any time during this hour, however, if we agree that last names A-L try to arrive at 6 and M-Z arrive at 6:30 this will help with congestion. You may park on the back playground blacktop off of Merton Ave. on this night. Take Exmoor Ave. north to Merton. Turn right on Merton. Merton dead ends into Roslyn Road (follow parking flow map).

Drop-Off Procedures

When summer school has been held at Roslyn Road in the past, drop-off has not been a traffic issue for summer school. Parents tend to drop off at slightly different times easing congestion. Please resist the urge to walk your child into school, particularly after the first few days. Kindergarten and 1st grade students may need help identifying their course locations and teachers on the first day but after that they really do get comfortable with the transition. They really *can* do it without you! For our kindergarten students, Mrs. Yonehara (Rm. 6) & Mrs. Roberts (Rm. 7) outside classroom doors are open at 7:50, students may access the classroom directly through the entrance designated as "Entrance 2" and "Entrance 3." If you do choose to walk in, please DO NOT park in the fire lane. This will back up traffic. **Parent**

parking will be available in the **main lot**. Teachers and staff will be designated by wearing the black Barrington 220 lanyards and identification badges. High school helpers will wear a purple lanyard for easy identification.

Pick-up Procedures

To alleviate traffic congestion on Roslyn Road and Rt. 59 **at dismissal (12:00 PM)**, I suggest the following practice:

- Parents of kindergarten through 2nd-grade class students should continue to pick-up their child in the front, main parking lot using the fire lane as a pick-up line. Please stay in your car and pull all the way up as directed by summer school staff. We will get your child to you.
- Parents of 3rd grade and up class students, utilize the back, Merton Ave. parking lot for pick-up. Pick-up will occur on the North side of the building, along the curb. Access to the Merton Ave. lot is available via Exmoor Ave, then turn right on Merton Ave. Merton Ave. dead-ends into the Roslyn Road blacktop. Please be aware that there will be a car lane and a bus lane. **Cars should stay along the playground** curb of the parking lot and follow the cones in the middle of the lot to exit the parking lot.
- If you have children that fall in both age ranges, please have all children go to the Main lot for pick-up with their older siblings. You may have your eldest child leave class a few minutes early and meet your youngest child at his or her classroom or at the front, main lot with the youngest child's teacher.
- If your child is not staying for the entire summer school day (8-12) and is **registered for only one 2-hour class from 8-10**, you should drop off and pick-up at the main entrance.
- Please post a sign in your window with your child's last name, this will help our staff get kids to cars more efficiently at dismissal.
- Please stay with your car and keep pulling all the way up as directed by school staff. We will get your child to you.
- There is a parking flow map posted on the Roslyn Road website to assist you in visualizing these directions:
- If you are parking to meet your child, you must be parked in the lot by 12 PM. You will not be allowed to drive into oncoming, dismissing traffic.

Healthy Snack

Students may bring a "healthy" and "no mess" snack for summer school between sessions or to be eaten at the end of the 8am or beginning of the 10am session. We place an emphasis on fresh fruits and vegetables as snacks in Barrington 220. Students are also encouraged to bring a water bottle filled with water for summer school.

Crossing Guard

There will be a crossing guard available at Rt. 59 and Roslyn Road prior to 8:00 AM and at 12:00 PM dismissal. **If there is a walker who is a 10:00 dismissal, please contact the office.** The crossing guard is there for the convenience and safety of students living across Rt. 59 within walking distance.

Attendance

Attendance will be taken each day of summer school for each class. If your child is marked absent, you will receive an automated call from the Roslyn Road School office. If you believe this call to be in error, contact the main office at 847-381-4148. We strive for accuracy and attempt to double-check attendance prior to the automated message being launched but errors do occur. Please call us before getting worried. Please make an effort to enter **your child late or absent from school** when you know they will not be present. Parents of Barrington 220 students can enter a student's absence into the parent portal, Absence Request, 24/7 any time prior to an absence. The absence may be because of illness but also because of other factors such as family trips or summer plans. It helps our teachers to know who they will be teaching each day. Thank you in advance for your diligence with student attendance. Students may also be called out or late by calling the main number (847-381-4148) and following the recorded prompts 24/7 if the office is not open.

Consolidation of Classes

Unfortunately, there was a need to consolidate and cancel a few classes this summer for enrollment.

- Fourth and Fifth-grade reading have been combined and will be taught by Ms. Gajewski in a workshop model differentiating by skill and level.
- Super Science II lacked enrollment and needed to blend with STEM: Innovators. Mrs. Bielski will teach the class with a science focus.

Popsicle Thursday

It is a summer school tradition to end the school week with a popsicle treat. Teachers in 10-12 am classes will have access to our supply. If this poses a health complexity for your child, please contact our school nurse – Alice Hanusin. The brand is picked with health and allergy considerations in mind. If it is still an issue, we would like to provide an alternate treat so every child is rewarded at week's end. Students leaving at 10 am can get their popsicle as they exit the main doors at 10 am.

If there is anything I can do to make your child's summer school experience more enjoyable and valuable, please let me know. Our goal for summer school is to provide an engaging, yet fun experience throughout the early summer for those students attending.
