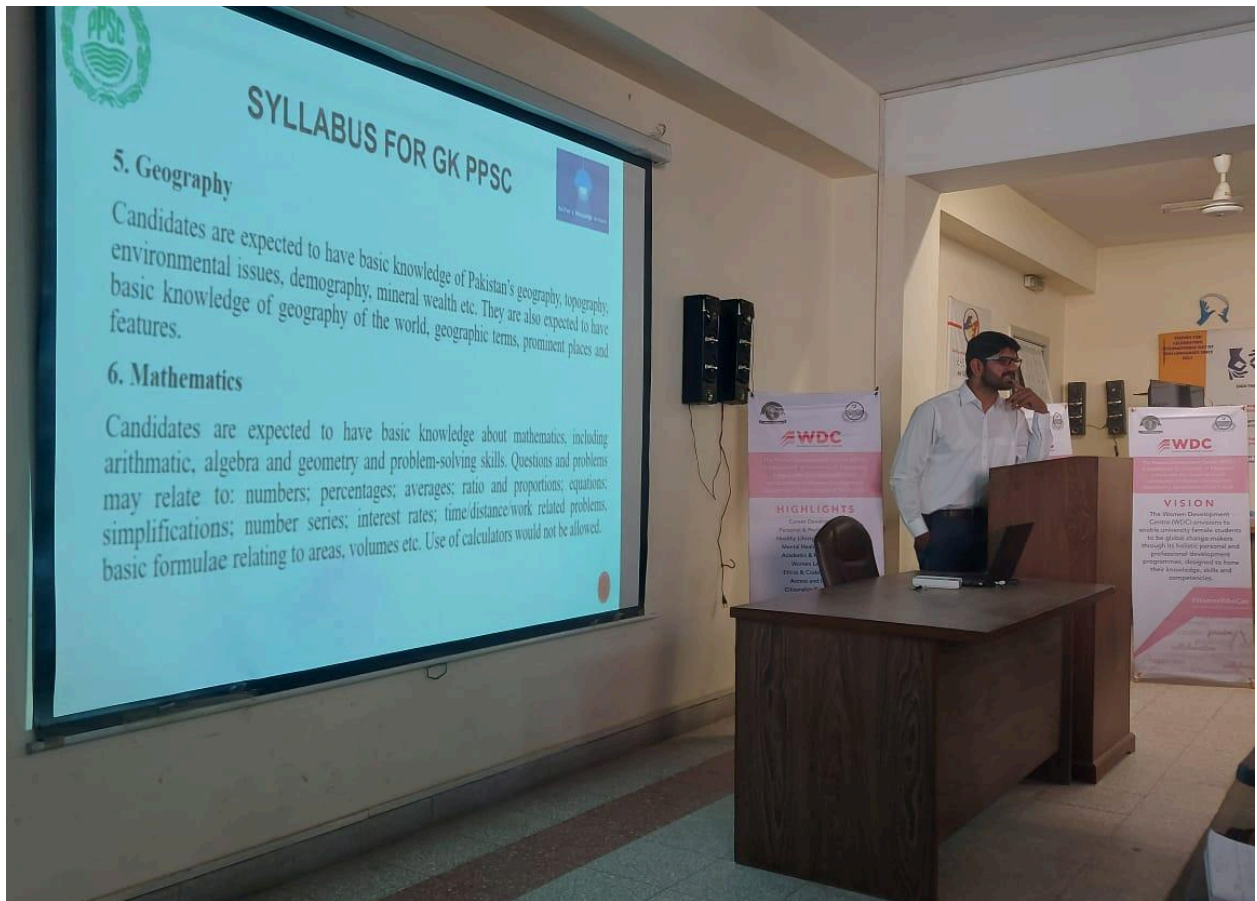
“When you feel like quitting, remember why you started”
