

STUDENT/PARENT INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2026-27 REGISTRATION

Dear Parents and Students,

Spring 2026

We are excited to begin the registration process for the 2026-27 school year. SVHS counselors shared Registration information to middle school students via a Homeroom Broadcast on February 9th. Students learned about high school grad requirements and course offerings. They also received a registration worksheet with teacher recommendations and learned how to make their course selections for high school courses in Infinite Campus.

Students are bringing home the following: a registration card listing typical 9th grade courses offered at SVHS, this instruction sheet and a registration worksheet to list their choices so they can more easily add them in Infinite Campus. The registration worksheet will also have the SVMS teacher recommendations for core class levels (Foundations, CP, Honors, etc) to guide choices.

Online course selections must be entered into Infinite Campus by Monday, March 2nd. SVHS counselors will begin meeting 1:1 with students the week of March 2nd during ELA classes to review course selections.

STEP ONE: Review available courses using registration card, four year plan document and online Program of Studies (which provides class descriptions and pre-requisite info).

- ✓ You will select 8 first choice classes (Core classes, Health/PE, and 3 primary electives)
- ✓ After you have made your first-choice selections, pick 4 alternate electives in case you don't get your first-choice selections.
- ✓ **COMPLETE REGISTRATION WORKSHEET** with your choices- This was distributed in homeroom and pre-populated with teacher recommendations. Having courses written here will help guide you once you go into Infinite Campus to enter your class selections.

If unsure of the level of class (College Prep, Honors or AP) please discuss this with your teacher.

Consider pre-requisites in choosing classes. This information is found here on the UCPS website: www.ucpsnc.org/academics/handbooks-curriculum-guides

- ❓ Example 1: English I before Mythology; Public Safety before Firefighter 1; Health/PE before Weightlifting or other PE electives
- ❓ Example 2: Visual Art I before Photography and Ceramics; Theatre Arts I before Theatre Arts II
- ❓ Band, ROTC, Journalism & Yearbook are typically yearlong classes, taking up 2 elective blocks.
- ❓ **A separate application is required if selecting Journalism and Yearbook classes.**
 - ❓ Sign up during registration and an application will be sent to complete.

STEP TWO: Choose courses in Infinite Campus. Screenshots showing how to choose courses are in the registration powerpoint and on the SVHS school counseling website under Registration.

IMPORTANT NOTE: At this point, it is NOT possible for students to choose courses in Infinite Campus. When the state makes it available, here are the steps to follow:

1. Student signs into Infinite Campus and selects “Academic Plan” in the left-hand column.
2. Student chooses Post-Grad plans (These are not binding, just choose one and move on).
3. Click the box under each Course Subject listed to see available courses to choose from.
4. * Make sure you register for 8 courses and 4 alternate electives.
 - o Be sure you pick alternates that you are truly interested in- if your first choice electives are unavailable, you will be placed in one of your alternates.
 - o Scroll back to the top of the page and Click SAVE. You should see a message that states “Course Plan Saved”. There may be other pop-up messages but these can be ignored. Counselors will troubleshoot any errors in course selection.
