**A DAB Update**

In the April meeting of the DAB, Marlina Gross-Taylor, the district's new Chief Equity and Academic Officer and Jessica Zamora from the school board provided updates. They encouraged members to watch the presentation at the board meeting dated March 22, 2022 about universal preschool, head start, kindergarten programs, hiring and recruitment. Other states are well ahead of Colorado in ensuring preschool education. There will be challenges to work through in shifting to universal preschool. They felt PSD is headed in the right direction. The remainder of the meeting focuses on reflecting on the year and planning for next year. The membership collaborated in table groups to

share takeaways and further wonderings from each of the meetings this year.

### Information about Required Vaccines

Summer is coming! Be sure to get your vaccines scheduled so they are completed before school starts. Please note what is needed for incoming 6th graders.

- Colorado law requires students who attend a public, private, or parochial kindergarten - 12th grade school to be vaccinated against many diseases vaccines can prevent, unless a certificate of exemption is filed. *For more information, [visit the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment required vaccines web page.](#)*

#### **Your student must be vaccinated against:**

- **Diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis (DTaP, DTP, Tdap)**
- **Hepatitis B (HepB)**
- **Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR)**
- **Polio (IPV)**
- **Varicella (chickenpox)**
- Colorado follows recommendations set by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices.
  - Students entering kindergarten must receive their final doses of DTaP, IPV, MMR and varicella.
  - **Students entering 6th grade must receive one dose of Tdap vaccine, even if they are under 11 years of age.**
  - *All recommendations are on the [Centers for Disease Control vaccine schedule web page.](#)*
- Vaccines are recommended for hepatitis A, influenza, meningococcal disease and human papillomavirus, but are not required.
