Parent and Volunteer Code of Conduct Agreement

This Parent and Volunteer Code of Conduct Agreement is to remind parents and volunteers of a few important tips designed to help maximize Kelso Players athletic experience.

Parents and guests are encouraged to appropriately cheer for their player as well as all other players. Please keep all comments/cheers positive and encouraging. All spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner at all practices and games.

Criticizing players, teammates, the coach, or the other team can result in coaches, parents, spectators, and/or your child receiving a yellow or red card and potentially dismissal from the game.

Parents are encouraged to offer assistance to the coach by setting up treats for the games, planning a celebration at the end of the season, or picking up left behind items at practices or games and returning the items to the player. All help is appreciated!

Parents should ensure that players are on time to practice and on time and prepared for games. Please contact your coach if your player(s) will be absent or tardy. Communication is key!

Continual failure to attend practices or games without any communication with the coach may result in disciplinary actions of the player as seen fit by the Kelso Soccer Club Disciplinary and CYSA Disciplinary Committee including, but not limited to, reduction in playing time.

The coach has authority for the management of their team and spectators which includes all of the parents, family members and friends who attend a game. It is within the rights of a coach, official, or club representatives to ask parents or guests to leave if their behavior warrants it.

Failure to comply will be handled by the club president and/or disciplinary committee and could lead to additional disciplinary action.

If a parent or guest should have a problem with other players or referees, the parent should address their complaint to the coach or Kelso Soccer Club. Parents and guests are not permitted to interact with the game officials.

If a parent or guest should have a problem with a coach, they should submit a incident report, available on the Kelso Soccer Club website: kelsosoccerclub.com
