2021-22 SUIP Major Improvement Strategies:

- 1) **INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES:** Lesher Students with Disabilities are approaching or do not meet federal, state, and local expectations for growth in math based on 2019 pre-Covid data. Lesher's 1st priority performance challenge is improving academic growth in math for Students with Disabilities.
- 2) **ELA/ELD INSTRUCTION:** Lesher Students with Disabilities (see performance challenge #1), English Learners, Free/Reduced-Price Lunch Eligible students, and Minority Students do not meet or are approaching federal, state, and local expectations in growth for English Language Arts from 2019 pre-Covid. Lesher's 2nd priority performance challenge is improving academic growth for students in 4 of 5 targeted subgroup populations (not including Gifted and Talented).
- 3) **TEACHER-TO-STUDENT & STUDENT-TO-STUDENT CONNECTIONS FOR ALL STUDENTS & STAFF & INTERVENTIONS FOR STUDENTS SCORING UNDER THE 35th PERCENTILE:** The pandemic significantly limited the students and staff connections the past 1.5 years with canceled extracurricular clubs, sports, field trips, etc. Lesher's 3rd priority performance challenge is improving students and staff social-emotional wellbeing and mental health as we return to in-person learning fulltime.

2021-22 The Lesher Difference Deliverables:

- 1) Student Performance via IBMYP Criteria, Strands, & AtL Skills per our IBMYP criterion-referenced gradebook.
- 2) EL Achieve Instruction (English Language Development- ELD) with Building-wide Reading & Writing Framework to improve student thinking & writing.
- 3) MTSS & Progress Monitoring to enhance student academic, behavioral, & social/emotional performance.
- 4) Student/Teacher Emergenetics Program (STEP) Profile & Meeting of the Minds Seminar (3 Behavioral Attributes = Expressiveness, Assertiveness, Flexibility & 4 Thinking Attributes = Analytical, Structural, Social, Conceptual).
- 5) Peer Observations/IB Lesson Study using the 5Ds+ Standards-based Teaching & Learning Framework & IB's Approaches to Teaching.
- 6) Expect Respect schoolwide teaching students to build healthy relationships & prevent violence & abuse.
- 7) Co-teaching Model between our Integrated Services & General Ed. Teachers to improve growth gaps for students with disabilities.
